GENERAL:

C Johnson was delayed due to transport difficulties and was replaced in Race 1 by Apprentice E Farr as there was no suitable senior rider available.

Pre race blood testing was conducted.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 STORAGE & EQUIPMENT HIRE/ 1600

POROTENE MHIA (D Turner) – Slow away.

RASCALLION (E Farr) – Over raced in the early stages. Apprentice rider E Farr could offer no excuses for the disappointing performance.

MARSHAL (M Du Plessis) – Over raced early and had to be steadied off heels near the 1200 metres.

VENCEDORA (R Myers) – Steadied when pace eased near the 1200 metres.

MISS DEJAVU (D Hirini) – Steadied when pace eased near the 1200 metres.

GARCON DEUX (R Goldsbury) – Steadied when pace eased near the 1200 metres, shifted wide to avoid heels and then raced wide for the remainder of the race.

SHOWYOUHOW (J Riddell) – When questioned regarding the performance of SHOWYOUHOW rider J Riddell could offer no excuse with the gelding undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 2 ANDERSONS PIES 1600

CARLOW (T Johnson) – Was slow away.

SILVER COURT (D Turner) – Shifted out when racing ungenerously passing the 1000 metres placing AMUN RA in restricted room for a short distance who had improved on to heels.

AMUN RA (E Farr) - Raced in restricted room 1000 metres.

LETSGETITON (J Parkes) – Was inconvenienced passing the 700 metres by SILVER COURT which shifted out to obtain clear running. When questioned rider J Parkes advised that the mare had not been suited by today's track conditions. LETSGETITON under-went a veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality

CENTRE ATTENTION (H Andrew) – Went off stride passing the 350 metres.

FIVE TO MIDNIGHT (D Bradley) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area and was found to have a small laceration to the right nostril.

Race 3 MOLLER JOHNSON ISUZU 1400

COOL MOON (L Hemi) – Was inclined to lug outwards in the home straight.

FREDRICK WILLIAM (H Tinsley) – Bumped at the start and got back.

BANNOCKBURN (R Hannam) – Bumped at the start and got back.

Race 4 AITKEN TRANSPORT 1200M

SCAMP (J Riddell) – When questioned into the disappointing performance rider J Riddell could offer no tangible excuse. Scamp underwent a veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

WHISPERING (A Chan) – Dipped near the 400 metres. Shifted in abruptly when placed under pressure passing the 300 metres.

Race 5 EGMONT TYRES 2100

BEAU ZED (V Gatu) – Slow away.

BLAZING OPAL (J Riddell) – Over raced in the early stages.

KEANDRA (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned into the run of KEANDRA rider S McKay stated the mare failed to handle the existing track conditions.

KING OF ROCK (R Goldsbury) – **R Goldsbury** was reprimanded regarding the use of the whip inside the final 200 metres.

Race 6 KAPONGA HOTEL EGMONT CUP 2100

FRANCIS DRAKE (C Johnson) – Removed from the barrier after becoming fractious, then undergoing a veterinary examination which cleared the gelding fit to race.

BALHAM (M Du Plessis) – Tightened at the start and got back.

ZARTAN (K McCulloch) – Raced wide in the early stages in search of better footing.

SAMPSON (J Parkes) – Raced keenly early, steadies off heels near the post on the first occasion. Bumped on home turn.

PUMP UP THE VOLUME (E Farr) – Had to be straightened when inclined to run in under pressure in the final straight bumping SAMPSON near the 350 metres. **E Farr** was reprimanded regarding the whip use prior to the 200 metres.

I SUGGEST (L Hemi) – Failed to respond when placed under pressure approaching the home turn and dropped out finishing last. Rider L Hemi was of the opinion the mare was unsuited to the holding conditions under-foot.

Race 7 RICH HILL STUD TARANAKI BREEDERS 1400

ILLUMANATI (V Gatu) – Shifted out abruptly leaving barrier.

ROCKNROLLA (J Parkes) – Bumped and unbalanced start by UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT which was dictated out abruptly by ILLUMANATI.

HONEY RIDER (R Myers) – Over raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages. R Myers advising the filly had not been suited by the holding track conditions, with co trainer A Forsman to report the progress of HONEY RIDER in days subsequent.

BONNIE GIRL (J Riddell) – Over raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

HOTSHOTLASS (C Johnson) – C Johnson was unable to offer any explanation for the poor performance of the mare.

Race 8 SOUTH TARANAKI CLUB 1400

NOM DE BOSS (L Hemi) – Ducked outwards abruptly near the 100 metres prior to being straightened.

HE KNOWS (Z Moki) – Apprentice rider Z Moki was of the opinion that the gelding may have held its breath.

WAI WHARE (J Riddell) – When questioned J Riddell could offer no tangible excuses for the gelding's performance.

MENDIP (S McKay) – Apprentice rider S McKay dropped his whip near the 250 metres. Apprentice rider S McKay stated the gelding had not been entirely happy in today's track conditions which he described as holding.
