GENERAL:

C Lammas did not attend the meeting as he had been unable to obtain a medical clearance.

Apprentice A Sims did not attend the meeting due to injury and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TOWNLEY TRENCHING & ELECTRICAL 3YO

ICHIBAN (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Briefly held up entering the final straight near the 300 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider M Coleman advised that the gelding had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

MONGOLIANLIGHTNING (L Innes) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered when briefly crowded by IRISH MIST which shifted outwards leaving the barriers. When questioned regarding performance, rider L Innes was unable to offer any excuses.

LADY SHABEEL (B Hutton) – Raced three wide without cover.

Race 2 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

INDIAN MAID (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had to be steadied near the 700 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of JET CHARGED which stepped inwards away from WEE SONYA which was improving to its outside. JET CHARGED was immediately corrected by its rider. When questioned regarding performance rider S Spratt advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

WEE SONYA (B Hutton) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and was steadied.

FIERTE (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly before becoming awkwardly placed being steadied.

AMBER RAYNE (T Thornton) – Over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres continuing to do so into the middle stages. Briefly hampered when weakening near the 300 metres. When questioned, rider T Thornton was of the opinion that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer Mr N Bishara confirmed that it was now his intention to send AMBER RAYNE for a spell.

SALTED CARAMEL (M Hills) – Rider reported had been making abnormal breathing noises once placed under pressure in the final straight. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

JACQUI ICKX (E Farr) – When questioned regarding performance apprentice E Farr was unable to offer any excuses for the mare's disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mrs A Herbert advised that she had been confident of the mare's chances today, was at a loss to explain its poor performance and would be giving consideration to the mare's racing future.

Race 3 LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES INSURANCE BROKERS 1400

BATTLE TIME (V Colgan) – Raced keenly when being steadied in the early to middle stages which its rider electing to further restrain his mount near the 1000 metres when THEE AULD FLOOZIE was improving to his outside. When questioned V Colgan advised that he had been attempting to restrain his mount to take a sit behind THEE AULD FLOOZIE, but when attempting to do so SEVENTH UP had then improved to its inside when racing keenly and shifted outwards slightly to avoid the heels of HE'S CAVALIER placing **BATTLE TIME** in restricted room having to be further steadied. V Colgan further added that with the race having been run at a muddling tempo **BATTLE TIME** had then been unable to fully recover when the tempo had markedly quickened shortly after but had found the line well.

SEVENTH UP (G Cooksley) – Raced keenly when being steadied in the early to middle stages.

SECRET SPIRIT (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding performance rider M Coleman advised the mare had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

THEE AULD FLOOZIE (H Marzuki) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril which was found to be from a small laceration inside the nostril.

Race 4 TW MOORE 1400

TRICKLE DOWN (E Farr) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HAYLEY ANN (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly.

STRAIGHT SETS (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

GEORGETHEFIFTH (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover. Bumped approaching the 400 metres when PACQUIAO (D Johnson) shifted outwards to obtain clear running with HAYLEY ANN also being inconvenienced as a result. **D Johnson** was issued with a warning. Came together and bumped with PACQUIAO entering the final straight near the 300 metres.

PACQUIAO (D Johnson) — Made contact with another runner when shifting outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 400 metres. Came together and bumped with GEORGETHEFIFTH entering the final straight near the 300 metres.

Race 5 JAKKALBERRY CLASSIC

KINDALEICA (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards crowding GENTIL TONTON onto BIG DREAMER which shifted outwards crowding PROMISES which had to steady.

PROMISES (D Johnson) – Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding poor performance rider D Johnson advised that the mare had failed to settle and had then been unable to finish the race off adding that in her opinion PROMISES would be better suited dropping back in distance. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality other than the mare having a slow rate of recovery.

GENTIL TONTON (S Spratt) – Crowded start.

LETMEBY (A Jones) – Crowded start.

ARZAK (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly before racing in restricted room being steadied.

CELEBRITY MISS (T Thornton) – Crowded near the 1800 metres by ADMIRAL which shifted outwards away from I'LLAV BUBBLES (H Marzuki) which was inclined to lay out when crossing the junction onto the course proper. Raced three wide without cover.

KINDALEICA (R Elliot) – Eased down in the final straight when well beaten with apprentice rider R Elliot advising that the gelding had failed to see out the distance of today's race. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mrs K McQuade advised that **KINDALEICA** would now be sent for a spell.

L Satherley (ARZAK) and apprentice **H Marzuki** (I'LLAV BUBBLES) were both issued with warnings for unnecessary use of the whip on a horse out of contention.

Race 6 RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA 1215

MASABIO (H Marzuki) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover. Ran wide when making the final bend near the 300 metres forcing BEAUTY'S ROSE and GOOD LOOKIN' GAL over extra ground. Apprentice Marzuki was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Mentor.

BEAUTY'S ROSE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly and lay out when leaving the barriers. Forced over extra ground 300 metres.

CHACHAR (V Colgan) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages.

GOOD LOOKIN' GAL (S Spratt) – Forced over extra ground 300 metres.

Race 7 SWEYNESSE STAKES

NORTH AND SOUTH (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.

UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT (A Jones) – Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the bend from the 600 metres until obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.

STATHAM (M Hills) – Knuckled leaving the barriers.

SALAMANCA (H Tinsley) – Commenced to over-race approaching the 1000 metres, and continued to do so through the middle stages.

LOS VARGAS (V Colgan) – Rider advised had failed to handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection, including endoscopic examination, did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

PERSUASIVE (D Johnson) – Rider advised had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

FERRANDO (R Elliot) – Apprentice R Elliot advised that the colt had been unable to quicken once placed under pressure in today's track conditions.

Race 8 LANCE LAWSON BARRISTERS & SOLICITORS 1950

DANIECE (T Thornton) – Lay out when leaving the barriers crowding BATTLEFIELD and THIRD TIME LUCKY which were both briefly steadied, and continued to lay out in the early stages.

WHITE DIAMOND (L Innes) - Slow to begin.

WAJA (L Satherley) – Steadied when placed in restricted room between BATTLEFIELD and STOCKTAKE near the 1600 metres.

SINGLE SHOT (V Gatu) – When questioned regarding performance apprentice V Gatu advised that the gelding had never travelled comfortably in today's testing track conditions.
