RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TE AROHA LIQUOR HURDLE
OLD COUNTESS (W Gordon) - Began very awkwardly.	
PADDY JO (M Gillies) - Put in poor jumps at the first two fences. Was under pressure passing the 600 meters, and was retired from the race prior to jumping the third to last fence.	

FINNS HALO (C Studd) – Was contacted heavily when jumping the first fence by IZZANORANGE with **FINNS HALO** becoming unbalanced when landing. Lay in when jumping the second fence making contact with the hind quarters of COLONEL CARRERA.

IZZANORANGE (E Goodinson) – Was crowded jumping the second fence.

ROCKY (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the fourth fence, and ran down the fifth fence. **ROCKY** landed awkwardly after jumping the third to last and last fences with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced.

COLONEL CARRERA (M Mitchell) – Was under pressure passing the 600 metres, and was retired from the race prior to jumping the third to last fence.

HAVATASTE (M Cropp) – Jumped the second to last fence poorly.

Race 2	TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT HURDLE
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MARQUATEER (M Cropp) – Lost momentum jumping the first fence. Misjudged the second to last fence. Shifted in under pressure prior to jumping the final fence.

PERRY MASON (W Gordon) – Misjudged the seventh fence and second to last fence stumbling badly on landing.

CABALLO NOIR (S Karnicnik) – Raced wide without cover in the early to middle stages. Held up for a distance between the 900 metres and the 600 metres. Was inconvenienced prior to jumping the final fence by MARQUATEER which lay in under pressure.

RUNNY HONEY (A Kuru) – Stumbled badly after jumping the second to last fence.

WHO CAN TELL (M Gillies) – Hit the second to last fence landing awkwardly.

ARMANDO (M Mitchell) – Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence when well beaten.

Race 3	MAKE-A-WISH NEW ZEALAND HURDLE
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YARDSTICK (E Goodinson) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence and also at the second fence with rider E Goodinson becoming unbalanced and being dislodged. E Goodinson was attended to by ambulance personnel and transferred to hospital for further evaluation.

KENTUCKY SON (W Gordon) – Hit the fifth fence and also the final fence landing awkwardly.

DANZA LAD (M Cropp) – Was hampered by the riderless horse at the fence near the 1200 metres, and also prior to jumping the third to last fence.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (M Gillies) – Was hampered by the riderless horse at the fence near the 1200 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence when well back.

SECOND INNINGS (A Kuru) – Was hampered by the riderless horse prior to jumping the third to last fence. Ran down the second to last fence inconveniencing DANZA LAD. **Rider A Kuru** was spoken to regarding making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.

OEEE (S Karnicnik) – Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence when well back.

TOP CHOICE (M Mitchell) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence when in fourth position. When questioned into the reason that rider M Mitchell pulled the gelding up prior to jumping the final fence his explanation was that the

gelding had tired jumping the previous two fences and commenced to choke down prior to the final fence where he retired the gelding.

Race 4	GEOFF BRINDLEY MEMORIAL 2200
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INTO THE MYSTIC (L Calitz) – Knuckled leaving the barrier with the rider becoming unbalanced, and losing ground.

CARTRIDGE (M Simons) – Raced ungenerously leaving the straight on the first occasion shifting out and making contact with **COPPER COATED** which became briefly unbalanced.

COPPER COATED (L Wheeler) – Bumped and unbalanced 1800 metres.

LAEKEEPER (S Wenn) – **Rider S Wenn** dropped his whip near the 400 metres.

BOSTON HAVOC (M Roustoby) – **Rider M Roustoby** was issued with a warning for making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.

Race 5	CAPISTRANO LODGE 2200
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ROYAL SCEPTRE (J McIlroy) – Became awkwardly placed soon after leaving the barrier and was steadied.

HEISTHEONE (L Wheeler) – Was a little slow to begin. When questioned as to the reason the gelding had raced wide throughout rider L Wheeler advised that she had believed that there was better footing wider on the track.

IN A TRANCE (L Calitz) – Was crowded soon after leaving the barrier and steadied.

STEELFIX (J Myers) – Commenced to hang out soon after leaving the barriers making the first bend awkwardly.

Race 6	LANDMARK VETS STEEPLECHASE
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LUCKY CHARM (S Higgins) – Was badly hampered jumping the first fence by **KINGS KITE** which shifted inwards abruptly. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences when well back.

BEVERLEY BECK (C Studd) – Jumped the first fence poorly. **BEVERLEY BECK** and **KINGS KITE** came together heavily when jumping the second fence.

KINGS KITE (M Gillies) – **KINGS KITE** and **BEVERLEY BECK** came together heavily when jumping the second fence.

HUNTERS CREEK (M Mitchell) – Jumped the fence near the 1200 metres poorly on the second occasion.

FAIR SCRIPT (S Karnicnik) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences when well back.

Race 7	BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE STEEPLECHASE
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MR KANTON (W Gordon) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Shortly after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion **MR KANTON** shifted out abruptly hampering **NELLS BELLE**.

STAGEHAND (M Mitchell) – Ran the fifth fence down hampering **REGALO REAAL** on landing. Stumbled badly after jumping the third to last fence.

REGALO REAAL (A Kuru) – Hampered when landing after jumping the fifth fence. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion landing awkwardly. Put in a poor jump at the final fence and stumbled on landing with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced.

IRISHWISE (M Cropp) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1600 metres on the second occasion. Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence when well beaten.

MASTER MICHAEL (S Higgins) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence approaching the 1400 metres on the second occasion. Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence when well beaten.

NELLS BELLE (C Studd) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion landing awkwardly. Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence when well beaten.

MONI NUI (S Karnicnik) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence when well beaten.

Race 8	MIKE FRASER-JONES 1200
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LHOTSE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

SOUL SERENADE (A Schwerin) – Began awkwardly. Shifted out abruptly approaching the 300 metres when struck with the whip.

Race 9	SHACKELL ELECTRICAL 1600
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WHITNEY (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned rider M Coleman advised that the filly failed to handle the extremely heavy track conditions.

MAQUIS (T Thornton) – Stumbled badly on jumping away. Commenced to race ungenerously and lay outwards making contact with COOL CASSIE near the 900 metres.

COOL CASSIE (S Weatherley) – Contacted and briefly unbalanced 900 metres.

BABOONSKI (J Fawcett) – Shifted in abruptly away from COOL CASSIE which was laying in under pressure passing the 350 metres.

Race 10	DIPROSE MILLER 1600
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BETTERBEGOOD (R Scott) – Slow to begin.

BEYOND REACH (A Schwerin) – Began awkwardly. Apprentice **A Schwerin** admitted a breach in that she used the whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres with the JCA imposing a fine of \$300.

PILGRIM (A Jones) – Was crowded leaving the barriers by ALL THE ANSWERS which had begun awkwardly.

ALL THE ANSWERS (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

LAMASON (B Hutton) – Was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

DAHLS DELIGHT (L Satherley) – Hung out under pressure inconveniencing MAREEBA on two occasions in the final straight.

MAREEBA (Z Nor Azman) – Inconvenienced on two occasions in the final straight by DAHLS DELIGHT which hung out under pressure.

Race 11	BIG MICKS UNDERGROUND TAKEAWAYS 1400
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HAPPINESS IS (B R Jones) – Slow to begin.

HERE TO STAY (T Thornton) – Was crowded leaving the barrier.

BOLD WARRIOR (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when in restricted room passing the 1000 metres.

LEICA GLORY (M Hills) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

PLUTONIUM (S Weatherley) – When questioned into the performance of the favourite **PLUTONIUM** apprentice rider S Weatherley advised that the gelding had raced keenly in the early and middle stages, and when placed under pressure failed to respond in the very heavy track conditions.
