<u>Race 3 – COUNTRY JEWEL/ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN 1600</u>	
Trainer L Vaughan advised Stewards that SHIRLEY MAUDE has recovered well following its disappointing performance, adding that the filly may not have been entirely suited by the heavy track conditions over its first attempt at a mile. Mrs Vaughan advised it would be her intention to continue with the filly's preparation at the Gore RC meeting on 28 October 2016.	

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JJ LTD RATING 65 (1400m)
The start was delayed 5 minutes when rider R Black was required to return to the jockeys' room to retrieve her approved body protector after proceeding to the barriers without it. R Black admitted a breach of Rule 610(2)(a) and after hearing all relevant submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$300.	
CZARISTA (M McNab) – Slow to begin, held up momentarily early in the home straight and shifted ground inwards.	

MANUIA (H Bennet) – Slow to begin.

MINUTES TO MIDNITE (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly.

STEADFAST (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly.

ROC CITY (C Johnson) – Over raced early and middle stages, held up in the early stages of run home.

RESIDENTIAL (G Jogoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 | **BRAND FAMILY RATING 75 (1400m)**

The start was delayed when **DOCKET** proved difficult to load.

NATKINGCOLE (A McKay) – Began awkwardly.

DYNAMIC (H Bennet) – Shifted outwards on jumping, held up passing the 300 metres and then raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

DO UNO WHOIAM (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly in the early stages and became awkwardly placed when in restricted room near the 1200 metres.

THE REAL DEAL (M Du Plessis) – Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

DOCKET (R Myers) – Raced wide throughout. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be in a distressed condition. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is needed prior to racing next.

GALLANT RUBY (J Lowry) – Held up passing the 200 metres only obtaining clear running near the 100 metres.

BOOTS 'N' ALL (S Wynne) – Held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

Race 3 | **VICTORY LIME MAIDEN (1200m)**

SAMMI LOU (J Morris) – Hampered at start.

PIPPI REA (S Collett) – Hampered early stages, forced over extra ground 900 metres. Rider S Collett reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout and got further back than intended, and in her opinion would take benefit from today's race.

ELLERSTINA (S Muniandy) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards, lay outwards rounding home turn, shifted inwards near the 200 metres. Rider S Muniandy reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

MACKTAVISH (C Johnson) – Shifted out at the start, raced keenly early stages.

DRESSED TOKILL (C Barnes) – Raced keenly early stages, made the bend near 900 metres awkwardly shifting out abruptly forcing **PIPPI REA** over extra ground.

DISTURBANCE (R Cuneen) – Got head up when making the bend near 900 metres awkwardly and continued to over race for a short distance, raced wide throughout.

RICHIE ROX (K Williams) – Steadied 900 metres when awkwardly placed on heels getting its head up on a number of occasions, steadied near 250 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

VICAR'S DAUGHTER (G Jogoo) – Raced in restricted room near 200 metres and made contact with **ELLERSTINA**. Rider **G Jogoo** reminded of obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race.

Race 4	HALF THE ASSET OPEN (1200m)
<p>SUPER TROUPER (M Du Plessis) – Underwent a pre race vet check and cleared to start.</p> <p>LADY ZAFIRA (S Collett) – Late scratched at 2.00 pm on veterinary advice after rearing and falling in the barriers. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. The connections were advised that the mare must barrier trial to Stewards’ satisfaction prior to racing next.</p> <p>RED DIRT GIRL (S Muniandy) – Hampered shortly after the start and got back.</p> <p>KINAGAT (C Johnson) – Raced keenly early stages and continued to over race for some distance, raced in restricted room early in home straight. Rider C Johnson reported that the gelding failed to let down over the concluding stages.</p> <p>SIGNIFY (R Cuneen) – Raced keenly early stages.</p>	
Race 5	MCCREA PAINTERS & DECORATORS MAIDEN (1600m)
<p>PANORAMA (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, heavily restrained near 1300 metres when in restricted room.</p> <p>SHOW LOVER (R Cuneen) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>VICENTE (R Myers) – Raced wide early stages.</p> <p>MOTHER SUPERIOR (S Wynne) – Blundered in behind momentarily passing 1300 metres.</p> <p>SHE ROCKS (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide from 1000 metres.</p> <p>PARANA (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing 250 metres.</p> <p>PRECIOUS PERCY (J Morris) – Held up early stages of run home, held up momentarily 100 metres.</p>	
Race 6	RD PETROLEUM ASHBURTON CUP (1600m)
<p>PLEASE RELEASE ME (C Barnes) – Blundered on jumping and got back, not persevered with in the straight. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>COURT ORDER (T Moseley) – Lay outwards rounding final bend, rider T Moseley momentarily lost his reins passing 200 metres.</p> <p>STOKERS ROCK (S Wynne) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.</p> <p>COULEE (J Lowry) – Rider J Lowry reminded of obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.</p>	
Race 7	HEARTLAND DIGITAL PRINT RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>MISSTEEFLYING (H Bennet) – Began awkwardly losing ground, dislodged rider H Bennet near 300 metres after being unable to avoid the fallen runner. H Bennet was attended to by St John Paramedics and cleared. MISSTEEFYING underwent a post race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>ROYAL ROAD (K Williams) – Raced keenly early stages.</p> <p>HUGO THE BOSS (C Grylls) – Raced wide early and middle stages.</p> <p>NOT AVAILABLE (S Muniandy) – Raced wide from 1000 metres.</p> <p>BUSHIDO (C Johnson) – Held up for a short distance in the early part of the straight.</p>	

MADAM COURTNEY (T Moseley) – Shifted wider near 350 metres ,as a result **RUBY ROW** clipped a heels and fell dislodging its rider. T Moseley admitted a charge under Rule 638(1)(d) with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 4 South Island days effective 16 October to 30 October inclusive.

RUBY ROW (J Morris) – Unable to avoid heels of **MADAM COURTNEY** near 350 metres, clipping a heel and falling. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Rider J Morris was airlifted to Christchurch Hospital for treatment.

Race 8 | **BARNESWOOD FARM STAKES 3YO SW (1400m)**

O'NATURELLE (M McNab) – Bounded as the start was made and began awkwardly.

ZAKYNTHOS (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly, raced keenly near the 1000 metres and made the bend awkwardly at the 900 metres having to be heavily restrained off heels.

STARVOIA (C Johnson) – Got its head up when being steadied in the early stages, raced wide from 800 metres.

SWEET LEADER (C Grylls) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing 200 metres.

Race 9 | **PREMIER EQUINE VETS RATING 65 (2100m)**

KING OF THE TURF (T Moseley) – Badly hampered at start between runners getting back as a result, lay inwards near 50 metres and had to be straightened.

ANCIENT (R Myers) – Hampered at start.

SHOW MACCOOL (S Muniandy) – Hampered at start and got back, held up entering home straight and was not afforded clear running until inside 200 metres.

IMPERIUM (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly and got back.

SWEET TIME (S Wynne) – Got its head up when being restrained off heels passing winning post on first occasion, made the bend awkwardly near 1700 metres, raced wide from 1300 metres, inclined in lay inwards in the early part of the straight and had to be straightened.

LOCALLY SAUCED (C Johnson) – Not afforded clear running early in home straight and again passing 100 metres.

ROSHEEN (K Mudhoo) – Rider **K Mudhoo** reminded of obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

Race 10 | **ASHBURTON MSA LIQUOR CENTRE RATING 85 (2100m)**

CANTINA (M McNab) – Slow to begin.

DELACROIX (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly, lay outwards rounding the bend and continued to lay outwards in the straight. Rider G Jogoo reported that the gelding had not been comfortable in the one cup blinker. **G Jogoo** reminded of obligations when shifting ground near 200metres.

WISE MOVE (C Grylls) – Raced keenly early stages, hampered momentarily when awkwardly placed on heels of **SPEEDY JAX** near 200 metres.

SADLERS ROCK (S Wynne) – Raced wide rounding first bend, placed in restricted room near 200 metres having to steady.

LUCILLE (S Collett) – Raced wide from 1400 metres.
