Race 1	GORDON HANDY MACHINERY LTD R65 2200M
<p>LADY LINDAUER (K Kalychurun) - Momentarily held up early in the run home having to change ground inwards to find clear racing room.</p> <p>SHOW MACCOOL (D Hirini) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer P Corbett advised the gelding had been unlucky in its fresh up run in Ashburton last week and a better showing had been expected in today's smaller field.</p> <p>ODABELLA (S Wynne) – When questioned regarding the performance of the favourite runner rider S Wynne advised when placed under pressure the mare had been flat a long way from home and had been very disappointing. Stewards ordered a post-race vet examination, which revealed the horse had suffered a tendon injury to the right fore, with the connections being advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to ODABELLA racing again.</p>	
Race 2	GARDEN FRESH OAMARU R85 1200M
MELS EVIE (L Callaway) - Raced wide from the 900 metres.	

NIPPIN (C Kwo) – Lost racing plate passing the 500 metres.	
Race 3	CROMBIE AND PRICE R75 1600M
<p>ZAH CHAMP (K Kalychurun) – Crowded shortly after the start and got back.</p> <p>KOLAMAN (L Callaway) - Raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>BACK IN THE DAY (C Johnson) - Raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>HANDSOME DAX (D Hirini) - Held up rounding final bend and early in the run home.</p> <p>VELUTO (S Wynne) – When spoken to regarding the disappointing performance rider S Wynne advised that the gelding had been left flat footed when the pace of the race increased in the middle stages and in her opinion would be better suited to further distance.</p> <p>GOTTAGETMYWOOHOO (C Barnes) – When spoken to regarding the improved performance co-trainer Mrs P Hughes advised that the gelding had been freshened and a bold showing had been expected.</p>	
Race 4	EASY MADE MARMALADE MAIDEN 2200M
<p>DARCI INN (K Mudhoo) - Was slow away.</p> <p>PINNACLE BAY (K Williams) – Began awkwardly losing ground, further hampered when BLACK IZIAH shifted out just after the start. Held up by a tiring runner passing the 450 metres until early in the run home.</p> <p>BLACK IZIAH (S Wahab) – Began awkwardly shifting in and bumping heavily with inside runner with the rider becoming unbalanced and losing the use of his right iron for several strides.</p> <p>ASOMA (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly when leading through the early to middle stages.</p> <p>AVIATE (S Muniandy) - Raced disappointingly, Stewards ordered a post-race vet examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>SWEET INDULGENCE (S Wynne) – Had to steady at the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the runner in front.</p>	
Race 5	SPORTS CENTRAL BREWHOUSE MAIDEN 1200M
<p>The start was delayed when several runners proved difficult to load.</p> <p>SEATHEPOWER (D Hirini) - Slow to begin. Hung outwards and raced very wide on the track throughout placing rider D Hirini in difficulty. The connections were advised SEATHEPOWER must barrier trial prior to racing next.</p> <p>UNICO (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>GALISINI (K Mudhoo) - Momentarily crowded and had to steady at 900 metres.</p> <p>ELLERSTINA (C Johnson) – Had to shift ground outwards off heels in the last 50 metres. Rider C Johnson advised to exercise greater care when shifting in at 900 metres and crowding GALISINI.</p>	
Race 6	WINGATUI MELBOURNE CUP DAY 1200M
<p>SMOKE 'EM WILSON (C Johnson) - Was restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p>CARMENIZE (R Cuneen) – Raced wide through the early stages.</p> <p>MIA MAMMA (G Jogoo) – Raced keen early. Lay inward in the early part of the home straight.</p> <p>SILVERMIST (K Williams) - Lay outwards throughout the straight shifting wider on the track.</p>	

OUR STAR ANISE (S Muniandy) – Rider warned under Rule 648(3) in that he weighed in excess of his weight-out weight.

Race 7	NORTH STAR MOTEL RESTAURANT AND BAR R65 1200M

TICKETS ON HER (C Johnson) – Was a late scratching at 3.50 pm after it refused to load into the barriers. Connections were advised that the mare must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction and if passed to resume racing the horse will be loaded early and not be delayed.

DAIFUKU (C Spittles) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.

FASCINATE (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up early in the run home having to change ground inwards passing the 250 metres to find clear racing room in the run home.

KASUNDI (G Jogoo) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

ELVERA (D Hirini) – Slow to begin. Raced wide for the majority of the event.

Race 8	LIQUOR LAND OAMARU MAIDEN 1400M

SON OF ZAC (C Barnes) – Was slow to begin, and then crowded by outside runner shifting out losing further ground. Contacted **DREAM RICH** at the 350 metres. Again crowded by **DREAM RICH** and had to steady at the 200 metres.

ZAWHIP (K Kalychurun) - Raced keenly early stages. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 1100 metres. Raced in restricted room when making final bend awkwardly. Then held up early in the run home.

POWERBALL (C Johnson) – Raced keen early.

JONA MAC (C Kwo) - Raced wide for the majority of the race. Held up for some distance passing the 500 metres.

KEEMAIA (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.

DREAM RICH (T Direen) – Lay inwards at the 350 metres making contact with **SON OF ZAC**. Lay in passing the 200 metres crowding **SON OF ZAC** who had to steady. Rider T Direen reported that the the filly had raced greenly throughout.

EL BEE DANCER (S Muniandy) – Awkward on heels near the 400 metres.

WHATWASTHAT (L Callaway) - Stood flat footed as the start was affected losing ground (5 lengths).

STORMY RAY (K Williams) – Made bend awkwardly near 500 metres and lay out through run home. Rider K Williams reported the mare appeared to have got down on its bumpers during the race. A post-race veterinary inspection of **STORMY RAY** revealed no obvious abnormalities.

BOBBY AL (R Cuneen) - Bumped heavily with **LONDONDERRY AIR** losing ground at the start.

LONDONDERRY AIR (J Lowry) – Bumped heavily with **BOBBY AL** losing ground at the start.

COTTA PIN (S Wynne) - Raced wide throughout.

LETMEGO (C Johnson) – Rider C Johnson was questioned regarding the disappointing performance and he advised that the mare had been flat throughout and had never responded to his urgings throughout the race. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.
