## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Stella Artois 2400
<b>HEEZA DREIMER</b> (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1400 metres. Forced wide 600 metres.	
<b>IN A TRANCE</b> (D Johnson) – Crowded when leaving the barriers, losing ground.	
<b>SAKHEE'S STAR</b> (A Jones) – Slow to begin.	
<b>BLACK LACE</b> (M Du Plessis) – Over-raced in the early stages.	

**THE ARABIAN DUKE** (A Schwerin) – Raced wide without cover from near the 1400 metres. Bumped and unbalanced passing the 500 metres by **BLACK LACE** which made the bend awkwardly. As a result **HILARIOUS** was forced wider which in turn forced **HEEZA DREIMER** wide on the track.

**HILARIOUS** (S Collett) – Forced wider 600 metres.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Schweppes Two Year Old (880 metres)</b>

**STAR TREASURE** (A Schwerin) – Began awkwardly and shifted ground outwards abruptly, losing considerable ground.

**SWISS EIRE** (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly and then commenced to lay out shortly after, losing ground. Raced greenly in the final straight shifting outwards abruptly inside the final 50 metres with Apprentice Rider R Elliot forced to take corrective action. Stable representative G Barlow advised that **SWISS EIRE** is likely to be gelded.

**GILHOOIE** (M Du Plessis) – Lay out abruptly when struck with the whip inside the final 50 metres.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Ecochill 2100</b>

**ALL THE ANSWERS** (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**MAID OF STEEL** (S Weatherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**DOUCETTE** (A Schwerin) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**DOIKNOWYOU** (M McNab) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1800 metres to the inside of **EL LUCHADOR** which was crowded by **DIESEL** which was dictated in slightly by **DOUCETTE** (A Schwerin). Apprentice Rider **A Schwerin** was advised she must exercise greater care.

**BETTERBEGOOD** (Z Nor Azman) – Became unbalanced passing the 300 metres when making brief contact with the running rail.

**I'LLAV BUBBLES** (M Du Plessis) – Rider M Du Plessis advised that today's improved track conditions had not suited the mare. Trainer R Simpson advised that **I'LLAV BUBBLES** is likely to be spelled.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>South Auckland Racing Club Cup (1600 metres)</b>

**LATE DECISION** (R Elliot) – Slow to begin. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**LUCKY FEATHER** (T Thornton) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Commenced to race ungenerously from the 1400 metres when being steadied and continued to do so through the middle stages.

**ZAMBEZI WARRIOR** (M McNab) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1400 metres to the inside of **LUCKY FEATHER** which commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied, **LUCKY FEATHER** was then dictated in slightly by **CHENILLE** which was steadied when shifting away from the heels of **SEVENTEEN SEVENTY** which shifted in when not fully clear. As a result **ZAMBEZI WARRIOR** was hampered losing ground. With Stewards taking into account the racing manners of **LUCKY FEATHER** at the time and **CHENILLE** which shifted in when being steadied the Stewards took no further action other than to advise Riders **S Spratt**, **D Johnson** and **T Thornton** to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. **ZAMBEZI WARRIOR** raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres and was hampered to the inside of **PROMISE TO REIGN** which shifted in when racing ungenerously.

**CHENILLE** (D Johnson) – Briefly crowded 1400 metres when steadying.

**PROMISE TO REIGN** (L Innes) – Raced ungenerously passing the 1300 metres.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Blue Bubble Taxis 1400</b>
<p><b>SOUND PROPOSITION</b> (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly making contact with SOMETHINGVAIN.</p> <p><b>ELETIST</b> (D Johnson) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Was eased down approaching the 100 metres with Rider D Johnson reporting that the gelding had felt uncomfortable in its action. ELETIST underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p><b>ABIDEWITHME</b> (M McNab) – Held up rounding the final turn. Made contact with the hind quarters of TROJAN WARRIOR passing the 350 metres with both coming together for several strides, then had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Auckland Co-op Taxis 1400</b>
<p><b>LAUBERHORN</b> (S Spratt) – Dislodged its rider when commencing its preliminary and was quickly recaptured and underwent a veterinary examination after arriving at the barriers and was cleared fit to race.</p> <p><b>ENDEAN ROSE</b> (B Hutton) – Slow away and then was further hampered when RED TSUNAMI shifted in shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>NEALA</b> (M Hills) – Slow to begin. Commenced to race ungenerously shifted out off heels passing the 1000 metres when the pace steadied, hampering BRUEGEL.</p> <p><b>BRUEGEL</b> (M Du Plessis) – Hampered 1000 metres. Became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance passing the 700 metres. Lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>ZACADA</b> (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Raced fiercely passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed. ZACADA underwent veterinary attention after returning to the enclosure with blood present in the mouth and was found to have a small wound over right upper canine tooth.</p> <p><b>LUEN YAT MIRACLE</b> (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>COLDPLAY</b> (V Colgan) – Commenced to over-race when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of TAKEN THE LIBERTY (S Weatherley) passing the 1200 metres which steadied. As a result ZACADA which was following COLDPLAY was hampered and raced ungenerously for a distance. Apprentice Rider <b>S Weatherley</b> was severely reprimanded by Stewards for steadying the pace in an abrupt manner. Raced in restricted room early in the final straight obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>MARKY MARK</b> (L Innes) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres. Rider L Innes advised that the gelding had not been suited by the impost of 60 kilograms and had over-raced. Co-trainer M Murdoch advised that she would consider gear changes.</p> <p><b>HUNGRY EYES</b> (E Farr) – Raced wide without cover.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Dunstan Feeds Soliloquy Stakes (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>ITS TIME FOR MAGIC</b> (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>VEEARMA</b> (V Colgan) – Hampered passing the 1200 metres by GLASS SLIPPER which was forced out by CHICANE which had commenced to over-race. As a result VEEARMA lost ground.</p>	

**JOY ANNA** (M Hills) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages. Rider M Hills reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action when placed under pressure in the home straight, and underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found the filly to be mildly lame in the left foreleg.

**ASTARA** (S Collett) – Rider S Collett lost the use of her right rein when switching the whip to the right hand approaching the 300 metres.

**GLASS SLIPPER** (L Innes) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight and obtaining clear running approaching the 200 metres. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight.

**CHICANE** (D Johnson) – Slow to begin. Inconvenienced 200 metres.

**MYSTERY SHOW** (M Du Plessis) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>Coca-Cola 1400</b>

**ARMAGUARD** (M Hills) – Slow to begin.

**LEICA GLORY** (G Cooksley) – Blundered shortly after jumping away losing ground.

**WANNABE ROYALE** (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

**COUNTING HOUSE** (S Spratt) – Commenced to race fiercely when placed in restricted room to the inside of SABOTAGE passing the 1200 metres and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages. Rider V Colgan was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. Steadied approaching the 100 metres when placed in restricted room to the outside of WANNABE ROYALE which was taken out by PREETHA VARMA which shifted out when tiring. Contributing was slight inward movement from SYMPHONIC.

**PREETHA VARMA** (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover. Rider L Innes reported although racing wide for the majority of the race the mare had been otherwise disappointing, a subsequent veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

**SABOTAGE** (V Colgan) – Held up early in the final straight obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

**GRAVANO** (D Prastiyou) – Denied clear racing room passing the 200 metres and had to shift out to obtain clear running.

**BANROCK** (T Wenn) – Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres inconveniencing the weakening SCAMP.

**SCAMP** (M Coleman) – Inconvenienced 100 metres.
