RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZTBA WELLINGTON BRANCH GUINEAS TRIAL
<p>MANHATTAN STREET (J Riddell) – made contact with GORBACHEV when attempting to obtain clear running entering the final straight near the 450 metres. MANHATTAN STREET then shifted back to the inner but failed to quicken when placed under pressure. When questioned, J Riddell was unable to offer any tangible excuse for the colt's disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>GORBACHEV (L Hemi) – bumped 450 metres.</p> <p>LINCOLN BLUE (M Tanaka) - had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
	TUI BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 PREMIER
<p>HEISTHEONE (H Tinsley) – commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 2000 metres and became awkwardly placed on the heels of MA BELLE KATE. H Tinsley said that whilst the gelding was not entirely suited to the muddling tempo of the race, it had nevertheless been disappointing.</p> <p>SIR MANAWA (M Singh) – slow away, raced wide throughout. Shifted inwards under pressure early in the final straight inconveniencing ITSALLBELT near the 350 metres, then continuing to shift inwards making contact with</p>	

SARABI on a number of occasions with that runner having to steady near the 250 metres. Apprentice Singh was issued with a warning. Shifted outwards under pressure near the 75 metres crowding **AL MUNROE**. Apprentice **SINGH** was fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

AL MUNROE (T Johnson) – began awkwardly. Badly held up near the 250 metres having to be angled wider on the track to obtain clear running.

SARABI (R Myers) – crowded for a distance early in the final straight and briefly steadied near the 250 metres. Rider could offer no excuses for the disappointing run.

ITSALLBELT (H Andrew) – had to briefly steady to avoid the heels on **SIR MANAWA** near the 350 metres.

MA BELLE KATE – lost the left hind plate during running.

SHE'S HALF IRISH – required veterinary attention following the race for a bout of colic.

Race 3 | **MARGARET ARNOLD ANNIVERSARY PREMIER**

OUR GAZZA (D Turner) – jumped away awkwardly.

MEGABLAST (J Riddell) - lost the right hind plate during running.

JACKSSTAR - was placed in restricted room near the 2200 metres then commenced to over race for a distance. When questioned regarding performance, rider R Hannam was unable to offer any excuses advising that the gelding had felt disinterested. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormalities.

SANJARRA (N Teeluck) – raced wide without cover throughout.

BRAD THORN (R Myers) – over-raced early stages when being restrained.

Race 4 | **SWISS ACE@WESTBURY STUD WELLESLEY STAKES - Listed**

GIFT OF POWER (C Grylls) – began awkwardly crowding **REVERED** then over-raced early stages.

REVERED (J Riddell) – crowded at start.

O'MARINA (R Myers) – raced wide early and then raced greenly crossing the junction onto the course proper.

WALDORF (T Johnson) – raced greenly throughout.

Race 5 | **HANLEY FORMULA PREMIER**

PLATINUM EXPRESS (C Grylls) – was crowded at the start when **Kairanga Lad** began awkwardly crowding **THE RICH LISTER**.

THE RICH LISTER (M Tanaka) – Crowded at the start when **Platinum Express** was forced in by **Kairanga Lad** who began awkwardly.

NASHVILLE (J Bassett) – began awkwardly

KAIRANGA LAD (D Turner) – began awkwardly. Made the bend awkwardly crossing the junction to the course proper near the 500 metres running wide inconveniencing **HE'S RESOLUTE**.

DARCI MAC (A Chan) – rider advised the gelding was not comfortable in the track conditions.	
Race 6	CIVIC@CAMBRIDGE THOROUGHBRED LODGE THOMPSON HANDICAP – Group III
<p>PROFILE – reared in the barriers, being removed to undergo a veterinary inspection initially being passed fit to run. After being re-loaded, it became apparent that the mare had commenced to bleed from the right nostril and after again being removed to undergo a further inspection was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.46pm. Subsequent veterinary examination on return to the enclosure found the blood to be as a result of external trauma.</p> <p>BLATHWAYT (N Teeluck) – slow to begin (4L)</p> <p>ROCKNROLLA (H Andrew) – over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages. Bumped going into the bend near the 1500 metres when AUTHENTIC PADDY shifted inwards. When questioned regarding its poor performance, apprentice H Andrew advised that the mare had been unable to quicken in today’s track conditions once placed under pressure. Post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p>AUTHENTIC PADDY (R Hannam) raced three wide without cover throughout</p> <p>SAMPSON (D Bradley) – raced wide without cover.</p> <p>CRUISER (T Johnson) - made contact with the hindquarters of CASSIE ANNE near the 600 metres.</p> <p>CASSIE ANNE (L Hemi) – unbalanced near the 600 metres when bumped.</p> <p>GET THAT JIVE (C Grylls) – briefly held up passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>BEL SORRISO (J Parkes) - was held up for a short distance near the 500 metres.</p>	
Race 7	KEMEYS BROTHERS PREMIER
<p>ART DECO (A Chan) – underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers after having kicked the outside rail when arriving at the start being passed fit to run.</p> <p>ONEFORTHEDITCH (R Myers) – slow away (3L).</p> <p>ALL IN LUCK (H Andrew) – had to be steadied after improving onto heels near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>HENREE WINKLER (L Hemi) - raced wide without cover</p> <p>LINCOLN BAY (J Riddell) - held up for a distance rounding the turn passing the 600 metres. Steadied and shifted inwards after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ANIMATOR near the 100 metres.</p> <p>ANIMATOR (J Parkes) – lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>CHOCANTE (H Tinsley) – shifted away from ART DECO near the 50 metres.</p>	
Race 8	RYDGES WELLINGTON PREMIER
<p>BEADLE (N Teeluck) – began awkwardly then commenced to buck shortly after the start dislodging apprentice Teeluck who was uninjured. Trainer Mr M Bentley was advised that BEADLE must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next and indicated that the gelding was now likely to be spelled.</p> <p>SENSIBLE PRINCESS (J Parkes) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned rider J Parkes advised that the mare had travelled comfortably but had been unable to quicken once placed under pressure early in the final</p>	

straight and had felt to have shortened up in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to have a poor post-race recovery with an elevated heart rate.

NOM DE BOSS (M Tanaka) – blundered leaving the barriers and lost ground.

JUMANAHA (D Turner) – had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 450 metres.
