RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TREVOR BANNISTER MEMORIAL 2000M
<p>BO YING (V Gatu) - checked at the start when COLONIA jumped inwards. Raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>COLONIA (D Hirini) - jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>KOWHAI KERRY (L Hemi) - lay out across the heels of BO YING near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>HERE TO STAY (Z Azman) - briefly steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres. When questioned regarding performance apprentice Nor Azman was unable to offer any excuses other than the gelding possibly failing to stay the 2000 metre distance of today's race.</p>	
Race 2	RETURN TO EARTH SUPPORTING LIFE TRUST 1200M
<p>BONNIE SAREEH (Z Azman) - reluctant to load then fractious in the barriers and slow away.</p>	

GOBUYIT (T Johnson) - raced wide without cover throughout when racing greenly. Had to be corrected by its rider on a number of occasions when continuing to race greenly.

SMILING ASSASSIN (E Farr) - made contact with INCOGNITO leaving the barriers before being further hampered shortly after the start when crowded.

INCOGNITO (S Weatherley) - bumped at the start. Commenced to over race when being restrained in the early stages. Had to be steadied when improving onto heels near the 600 metres. Held up near the 300 metres having to be steadied. Was inclined to lay inwards under pressure over the final stages crowding a number of runners to its inside passing the winning post. Apprentice Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care.

ZE ONE (A Chan) - when questioned regarding performance rider A Chan was unable to offer any excuses.

Race 3

REVITAL FERTILISER SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST 1200M

RED SKY AT NIGHT (S McKay) - slow away.

INVOKE (Z Azman) – jumped away awkwardly.

POPCORN - knuckled shortly after jumping away. Inconvenienced passing 1100 metres.

LISA LOU (B Hutton) - had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres when crowded for room by CELEBRATEDACHIEVER. Apprentice R Elliot was advised to exercise greater care. Also inconvenienced was POPCORN.

LECTIO DIVINIA (T Johnson) - over raced when three wide without cover passing the 800 metres.

Race 4

COMCAT SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST 1400M

PARTY MARTY (S Weatherley) - reared at the start and lost considerable ground taking no effective part in the race. Trainer Mr S A Sharrock was advised that the mare must barrier trial satisfactorily prior to its next start.

CHOUX PLAY (M Singh) - made the turn passing the 800 metres awkwardly. Had to be steadied when improving onto heels near the 500 metres.

SHINELIKEADIAMOND (B Hong) - raced three wide without cover.

E Farr - admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount KING COBRA to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear dictating SHE'S A ROCK inwards crowding KINI MARIE which was checked near the 150 metres. Miss Farr was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 2 November to the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 8 November, four riding days.

KINI MARIE (D Hirini) - checked 150 metres.

SHE'S A ROCK (R Goldsbury) - hampered when forced inwards 150 metres.

ISHINKTAATLEDO (A Chan) - ran out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5

NICCI GOODIN DESIGNER FLORIST SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST 1600M

CARRERA (Z Azman) - fractious in the barriers having to be removed and re-loaded. Trainer Mr G McBeth was advised that a warning would be placed against the filly for its barrier manners.

GUY FOX (T Johnson) - jumped away awkwardly losing ground then raced ungenerously racing erratically when being restrained passing the 1000 metres. Forced wider when attempting to improve near the 400m when ADEQUACY was steadied and shifted out across heels. Again forced wider by ADEQUACY rounding the turn near the 300m. Apprentice T Johnson was spoken to regarding his riding tactics in the presence of Riding Mentor N Harris.

DEVI (S Mackay) – Failed to respond when placed under pressure rounding the final turn and was not persevered with over the final 100m when well beaten dropping out to finish at the rear rider S Mckay being unable to offer any excuses. A Post race Veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

COUNTESS EL JAY (D Hirini) - raced three wide without cover throughout.

DOCTOR FOX (V Gatu) - raced wide throughout.

BROTHER ONE (R Goldsbury) - raced wide for the majority of the race.

Race 6 | **PENINSULAR BEACHFRONT RESORT MOOLOOLABA SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST 1400M**

ALARINDA (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly and was slow away.

CUTTING UP ROUGH (E Farr) - Raced four wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BAMURRU (B Hutton) - Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of WHY ME near the 700m, then having to shift out to avoid that runners heels making contact with DYNAMITE LUCY on a number of occasions.

DYNAMITE LUCY (H Andrew) – Bumped on a number of occasion near the 700m by BAMURRU.

Race 7 | **LANDMARK HOMES SUPPORTING 1200M**

THE ARK (D Hirini) - Over raced passing the 800metres making the bend awkwardly, running wide.

SILVER BUBBLES (A Jones) – Rider advised that the mare may not have been entirely comfortable in todays track conditions, but would in her opinion benefit from today's fresh up run..

Race 8 | **TWILIGHT FRIDAY RACES NOV 18TH 1800M**

LAMASON (B Hutton) – Underwent a veterinary inspection at the start after making contact with a gate leaving the enclosure and was cleared to start. Hung outwards rounding the final turn.

NIPPA MARY (A Jones) – Slow away. Rider reported that the mare had hung throughout the race.

BOYSWAY (D Hirini) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of CHONNEY.

DES DE JEU (T Johnson) – Travelled three wide without cover.

DELUXE EDITION (S Weatherley) – Had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.
