RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MILLS REEF WINERY AND RESTAURANT 3YO
O'RACHAEL (S steadied losing	Spratt) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when IN POSITION was inclined to lay out, and was ground.
IN POSITION (G Cooksley) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.
VOLPE VELOCE	(J Parkes) – Was inclined to lay out over the final 100 metres.

Race 2 CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE 1600

FLYING ON RED (R Elliot) – Dislodged its rider during the preliminary and galloped a distance before being late scratched by Stewards at 1.04 pm.

SOSECRET (S Spratt) – Was slow to begin.

SECRET LIAISON (B Hutton) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Was not persevered with in the home straight by its rider with B Hutton reporting that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. SECRET LIAISON underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

SECRET MERCHINE (L Satherley) – Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of CONTESTANT which shifted in near the 1300 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of SECRET MERCHINE rider L Satherley could offer no tangible excuses.

ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE (V Colgan) – Was held up until shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 3 BACK TO BLACK YOUR FRIENDLY DEBT COLLECTORS 1200

DAINTY ROSE (V Gatu) – Was slow to begin.

KING'S LANDING (J Parkes) – Was slow to begin. Was briefly steadied passing the 150 metres when improving on to heels.

HOLD ON (D Johnson) – Commenced to race fiercely passing the 900 metres shifting out and forcing FALKIRK LASS and I'MA SHYGIRL wider on the track passing the 800 metres. As a result GALLOPING GERTE shifted out in an effort to give HOLD ON racing room with GALLOPING GERTE becoming awkwardly placed on heels and blundering. CIVIQUE ROSE which was following then took evasive action shifting out off heels forcing SHINE ON wide on the track. HOLD ON continued to race fiercely for a distance. Trainer P Da Silva Teixeira advised that he would experiment with gear changes for the gelding. HOLD ON must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

GALLOPING GERTE (M McNab) – Became awkwardly placed 800 metres and blundered. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

CIVIQUE ROSE (T Thornton) – Shifted out abruptly 800 metres when rider took evasive action.

SHINE ON (L Satherley) – Forced wide 800 metres.

I'MA SHYGIRL (A Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

FALKIRK LASS (M Cameron) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1200 metres.

Race 4 CHESTERS PLUMBING AND BATHROOM 1300

LUEN YAT MIRACLE (B Hutton) - Raced keenly in the lead in the early and middle stages.

OHOPE PRINCE (B R Jones) – Made contact with CLOSE UP passing the 350 metres when looking to obtain clear running.

CLOSE UP (G Cooksley) – Commenced to lay in when placed under pressure making contact with MATIMBA passing the 200 metres.

MATIMBA (D Johnson) – Bumped 200 metres.

Race 5 SANCTUM BEAUTY THERAPY AND DAY SPA 2100

EL NINO (B R Jones) – Jumped away awkwardly.

MESSI (S McKay) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

SHEEZ THE BOSS (A Collett) – Rider A Collett admitted a charge in that she failed to ride SHEEZ THE BOSS (4th) out to the end of the race when there was a reasonable chance of the mare finishing in 3rd position, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 1 November up to and including racing on 10 November, 7 riding days.

EL BANDIDO (M McNab) – It was reported to Stewards that following the race and on return to its stable, EL BANDIDO had collapsed and died. The veterinarian advised the probable cause of death was a heart attack with a blood sample being taken for analysis.

Race 6 KIRSTY CASHMORE BAYLEYS 1300

TEMPLE TIGER (S McKay) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early stages and made the corner awkwardly when the pace steadied near the 900 metres.

MR LUIGI (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. The Stewards questioned rider S Spratt regarding her riding tactics, in particular why she had elected to remain three wide when the pace appeared to be moderate. Ms Spratt explained that she believed had she improved forward the horses would have improved to her inside and she would have remained in a three wide position, but further added she may have erred in her decision in not attempting to do so. Ms Spratt's explanation was noted by Stewards.

IT'S BEN AGAIN (L Innes) – Raced ungenerously when the pace steadied passing the 800 metres. L Innes reported the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in its action when placed under pressure.

DOUBTLESS PRINCESS (R Elliot) – Had to shift out across heels approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

SLEEK SECRET (D Johnson) – Was inconvenienced over the concluding stages when SHOT IN THE DARK shifted out making contact.

SHOT IN THE DARK (S Weatherley) – Shifted out over the concluding stages making contact.

Race 7 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600

MERITAGGIO (Z Nor Azman) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance of MERITAGGIO apprentice Z Nor Azman was of the opinion that the mare would prefer further easing of the ground, and added that MERITAGGIO may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

NELSON PARK (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages and had a tendency to hang in, was then asked to improve forward wide from near the 700 metres.

JIAYUGUAN (R Elliot) – Was held up rounding the final turn.

RUBEE (M Hills) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 KAY GANLEY BAYLEYS 1400

LOLA JANE (M McNab) – Was slow to begin.

FORTUNE KEPT (B Hutton) – Was slow to begin.

GETALONGHOME CINDY (A Schwerin) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

KEEPING TOM (Z Nor Azman) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

THE CANON (J Parkes) – Made the final bend awkwardly when laying out.

WHAT'S UP ALF (S Weatherley) – Shifted in passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.
