## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>COUNTRY FEASTS RATING 65 (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>TOUCH THE SKY</b> (R Hannam) – Trainer A Frye advised the mare would be racing in season. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils. Deemed to be a bleeder and stood down for mandatory three month period.</p> <p><b>VERNA AUDREY</b> (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly and was slow, unbalanced momentarily near the 300 metres when contacted from the inside by <b>PLACID PRINCESS</b>. When questioned regarding the improved performance, Trainer M Daly advised the mare had been working well, had taken benefit from its first up run and appreciated today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>PLACID PRINCESS</b> (A Collett) – Bumped with <b>VERNA AUDREY</b> near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>TUILANA</b> (C Johnson) - Raced fiercely in the early stages, raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>LETMEGO</b> (R Cuneen) – Momentarily in restricted room near the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>ZAH GIRL</b> (K Mudhoo) – Obligated to race wide throughout.</p> <p><b>MANUIA</b> (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, raced in restricted room in the early stages of the run home.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>IKANA MUSSELS MAIDEN (1400 metres)</b>
<b>ROSAEFLORA</b> (S Collett) – Slow to begin.	

**SEBRING DRAGON** (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin, held up early part of the home straight, unable to find clear racing room over the concluding 100 metres and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

**KEEMAIA** (G Jogoo) – Raced ungenerously through the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**JONA MAC** (C Kwo) – Raced wide throughout, lay inwards in the early part of the straight and hampered inside runner.

**ALL ABOUT ROY** (C Johnson) – Keen in the early stages, raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

**MISTY TRELLA** (B Moore) – Denied a marginal run to the inside of **WAGNER** near the 300 metres and held up thereafter and went to the line untested by its rider.

**WAGNER** (S Wynne) – Shifted inwards near the 300 metres. Rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

**PERFECT OCTAINE** (D Bradley) – Shifted inwards under a hard ride near the 100 metres and hampered inside runners.

**TAXIHOME** (K Mudhoo) – Hampered 100 metres.

**OLIGARCH** (L Callaway) – Hampered 100 metres and steadied.

**INCANTESIMO** (A Collett) – Held up in the early part of the home straight, held up near the 200 metres and shifted ground outwards to obtain clear running.

**KEARNEY** (S Muniandy) – When questioned regarding the improved performance, the stable representative reported the performance was not expected.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MICK &amp; MELBA MURFITT MEMORIAL RATING 75 (1400 metres)</b>
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**NATKINGCOLE** (A McKay) – Began awkwardly. Rider A McKay warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

**FLAG THE GROOM** (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly, raced wide in the early stages, heavily contacted 250 metres and unbalanced.

**PAT IN BRACKETS** (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

**HOT DATE** (C Johnson) – Keen in the early stages, attempted a marginal run near the 250 metres and was unbalanced. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

**CARBIDE** (S Weatherley) – Lay out through the straight. Rider reported the gelding was not entirely comfortable and could not quicken in today's track conditions.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>RURAL LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (1200 metres)</b>
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**ELECTRIC SHOCK** (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly bounding as the start was effected, held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres.

**REDEFINE** (K McCulloch) – Slow to begin, made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly shifting wider.

**DISTURBANCE** (A Collett) - Keen in the early stages and got its head up when restrained.

**BOBTAIL** (K Mudhoo) – Shifted wider on the track at the 800 metres, lay inwards near the 300 metres and had to be straightened.

<b>BLACK MARIAH</b> (T Jonker) – Wide throughout.	
<b>DAYTONA</b> (K Williams) – Lay inwards over the concluding stages.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 metres)</b>
<b>DONTPOKETHETIGER</b> (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.	
<b>ON GUARD</b> (B Moore) – Awkwardly placed shortly after the start having to be restrained.	
<b>EXCUSE ME HONEY</b> (C Johnson) – Wide in the early stages.	
<b>RIPPYLONGSTOCKINGS</b> (R Cuneen) – Keen passing the 800 metres and having to be restrained when awkwardly placed on heels.	
<b>DANIELLE</b> (S Muniandy) – Rider reported that in his opinion the mare would benefit from the addition of side winkers.	
<b>CONFLAGRATION</b> (C Spittles) – Rider warned for unnecessary use of the whip on a runner out of contention.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>CANTERBURY EQUINE CLINIC RATING 65 (2200 metres)</b>
<b>MISTER SPIDERMAN</b> (D Bradley) – Slow to begin, keen for a distance passing the 1600 metres, again keen for a distance passing the 600 metres.	
<b>TESSASTOCK</b> (S Collett) – Slow to begin.	
<b>ZANOTTI</b> (K Williams) - Awkwardly placed to the inside of <b>SWEET TIME</b> rounding the bend and again near the 250 metres when having to steady. Rider reported the mare was unable to quicken in today's prevailing track conditions.	
<b>SWEET TIME</b> (S Weatherley) - Lay inwards and came into contact with <b>ZANOTTI</b> near the 250 metres. Lay inwards again near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>C.S. STEVENS MEMORIAL BANKS PENINSULA CUP (2200 metres)</b>
<b>SCHMECKENBECHER</b> (C Barnes) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Lay inwards throughout the final straight.	
<b>SPEEDY JAX</b> (B Moore) – Wide early stages.	
<b>SAINT KITT</b> (C Johnson) - Over-raced middle stages.	
<b>KINGS PAL</b> (R Hannam) – Over-raced middle stages, had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>TELTRAC COMMUNICATIONS MAIDEN (2000 metres)</b>
<b>DARCI INN</b> (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly and got back.	
<b>FALTAINE</b> (S Wynne) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.	
<b>WHAT A DEEZA</b> (K Williams) – Wide in the early stages.	
<b>ANCIENT</b> (R Cuneen) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1600 metres, hampered at the 800 metres.	
<b>PINNACLE BAY</b> (K Mudhoo) – Steadied near the 1400 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.	
<b>ST MALO</b> (L Callaway) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly making contact with <b>PACO RABANNE</b> .	

<b>PACO RABANNE</b> (S Collett) – Bumped at the 800 metres.	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>FAMOUS GROUSE LINCOLN HOTEL RATING 65 (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>EUPHORIA</b> (K McCulloch) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TANIA</b> (S Collett) – Over-raced in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p><b>LADY JESSICA</b> (R Hannam) – Wide throughout.</p> <p><b>ZIGWIG</b> (S Wynne) - Shifted inwards abruptly near the 250 metres crowding and hampering <b>GOODTAGO</b>.</p> <p><b>GOODTAGO</b> (S Muniandy) – Crowded and steadied off heels at the 250 metres.</p>
