RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BOOF FLEMING MEMORIAL MDN 1800M
<p>NATIONAL ASSET (R Elliot) - began awkwardly. Checked off heels of GAE LIC BEAUTY near 1500 metres.</p> <p>DEEMICO (D Hirini) – raced erratically near 1500 metres and shifted out bumping GAE LIC BEAUTY. DEEMICO then proceeded to hang through the middle stages. Rider D Hirini stated her mount had hung away from the rail throughout the race.</p> <p>GAE LIC BEAUTY (K McCulloch) – bumped near the 1500 metres.</p>	
Race 2	STELLA ARTOIS MDN 1100M
<p>VUI (T Johnson) – jumped sharply bumping MADAM BULLBARS on to SILVER CLOUD. Made the bend very wide.</p> <p>MADAM BULLBARS (R Elliot) – bumped at the start.</p> <p>SILVER CLOUD (S Collett) – bumped at the start settling back.</p> <p>BEAU VISAGE (L Hemi) – jumped outward at the start dictating RASCALLION and SUMMERFLY which bumped RHIZA and</p>	

SMOKEN HOT. Made first bend awkwardly when inclined to lug outwards.

SMOKEN HOT (J Parkes) - checked at the start and settled back.

RHIZA (J Riddell) - returned to the weigh-in area with blood present in the right nostril. A subsequently veterinary inspection confirmed the mare to have sustained a cut consistent with having hit its head on the front of the gate.

SUMMERFLY (R Hannam) – had to avoid the heels of RHIZA approaching the home turn and was then angled outwards to improve.

DEJA ROO (K McCulloch) – was held up for some distance passing the 400 metres prior to gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

Race 3	REVITAL FERTILISERS MDN 1200M

MAGIC CHAI (A Collett) – began awkwardly bumping HENLEY ROAD and settled back.

HENLEY ROAD (S McKay) – bumped at the start.

SMART BRONSON (L Innes) – steadied near the end of the back straight when ALAMCFERSON (R Myers) shifted in then over raced for a short distance. Both riders were shown footage with R Myers advised to exercise greater care. L Innes stated that in his opinion SMART BRONSON would prefer firmer footing. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormalities.

THE IMP (D Turner) – made the corner awkwardly when wide.

BREAK MY STRIDE (J Parkes) – raced 3 wide without cover throughout.

Race 4	CHAIN RIGGING & SCAFFOLDING

UNFAZED (M McNab) after making contact with the starting gates during its preliminary underwent a veterinary examination and was found to have lost a plate. UNFAZED was attended to by the course farrier but was unable to be re-plated so was cleared to start minus its off hind plate.

KAIWAKA (S Collett) – began awkwardly bumping BEAR GRYLS.

BEAR GRYLS (L Hemi) – bumped at the start. Raced in restricted room for a short distance approaching the 200 metres. Lost a hind plate during the running.

FLAVOURING (R Elliot) – hung outwards badly after the start tightening LIBRETTI, GRAZIA and NEVERSTOPDREAMING. Over raced in the back straight.

LIBRETTI (J Riddell) – tightened at the start.

GRAZIA (A Collett) – tightened at the start.

NEVERSTOPDREAMING (J Parkes) – tightened at the start.

ON DEBUT – made the bend near the 600 metres awkwardly. Had to be steadied when improving on to heels shortly after straightening.

DEFER (B Hutton) – over raced through the early and middle stages.

DANDEEDEE (D Hirini) – raced greenly throughout the home straight.

Rider M McNab reported UNFAZED may have clipped a large divot on the point of the turn which caused his mount to become momentarily unbalanced. Stewards inspected the area of the track and whilst no slip marks were evident, it was observed several large divots had been displaced in the vicinity of the bend. The situation was conveyed to Course management who agreed to monitor and continue to monitor the area throughout the course of the programme and replace divots.

Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1400M
<p>Following a track inspection the start of this was delayed approximately 13 minutes and times were adjusted accordingly.</p> <p>STREET RANGER (R Myers) – was slow away</p> <p>OUT OFTIME (D Turner) – was tightened at the start and got back.</p> <p>OLIVIA MARY (T Johnson) – over raced in the early and middle stages and when being steadied went back on to ICEHOUSE near the 800 metres.</p> <p>HOW PERFECT (M Tanaka) – raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GLADSTONE BELLE (T Thornton) – held up rounding the home turn.</p> <p>ELLIES EMPRESS (M Hills) – was held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 6	PENINSULAR BEACHFRONT RESO 1600M
<p>DEE AND GEE – Began awkwardly and was slow away, then commenced to over race and had to be steadied for some distance going into the back straight.</p> <p>KOKO BELLE (S Collett) – raced greenly early. Ran about under pressure over the final stages.</p> <p>SUBLIME HABIT (R Myers) – shifted wide making the crossing in the back straight and then bumped with CLERMONT passing the 400 metres then raced wide for the remainder.</p> <p>SPONDULIX (D Bradley) – raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>MILLY MOO (T Thornton) – was inclined to shift inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened near the 100 metres.</p> <p>EPIC TALE (M McNab) – momentarily hampered near the 100 metres.</p> <p>CLERMONT (M Hills) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned into the run of CLERMONT which disappointed. Rider M Hills advised he had no excuse and understood the horse may be spelled</p>	
Race 7	LANDMARK HOMES 1200M
<p>MISS PERCYNALLITY – rider R Myers was dislodged early in the preliminary resulting in the mare galloping some distance riderless prior to being recaptured in the back straight. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed superficial cuts where MISS PERCYNALLITY had made contact with a fence in the 1600 metre shoot area.</p> <p>POROTENE MAGNUM (D Turner) – dipped at the start and lost ground.</p> <p>WILLBEOKAY (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly. Hung rounding the first turn.</p> <p>KEEPING TOM (T Johnson) – tended to lay in under pressure over the final stages having to be straightened.</p>	
Race 8	RACING DECEMBER 27 1800M
<p>CALL ME IRISH (T Johnson) – was slow away.</p> <p>MISS NORWAY (D Hirini) – raced in restricted room shortly after the start. Had to be straightened when shifting ground near the 200 metres.</p> <p>ALARINDA (R Myers) – was trapped wide early so was taken forward to lead going into the back straight. Raced 3 wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TWILIGHT REBEL (J Parkes) - was held up rounding the turn but failed to finish the race off when in clear room in the home straight.</p> <p>FASTNET FIRE (M McNab) – had to improve wide rounding the home turn.</p>
