RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HAVE YOUR FUNCTION AT ARAWA PARK 3YO

ADMIRE (D Johnson) - Was slow to begin.

MILLY MOO (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground, then over-raced in the early and middle stages. Had to steady 250 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of FEISTY JANE.

PINCANTO (C Grylls) – Was held up rounding the bend, and then had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

FEISTY JANE (M McNab) – Was crowded having to steady near the 250 metres when crowded to the inside of BELLE HOPE which shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip.

BELLE HOPE (B Hutton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip 250 metres. Rider B Hutton was issued with a warning.

Race 2 MILLS REEF WINERY 1230

KEEP THE MOMENT (L Satherley) – Was slow to begin.

SHEAR VELOCITY (V Gatu) – Shifted in near the 800 metres crowding UTWO TIME which had to steady losing ground. **SHEAR VELOCITY** continued to shift in when not clear of COTE D'OR which clipped a heel and blundered. Apprentice rider V Gatu admitted a breach of careless riding and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 5 November up to and including racing on 11 November, 4 riding days.

UTWO TIME (D Johnson) – Steadied when crowded 800 metres.

COTE D'OR (C Grylls) – Clipped a heel and blundered near the 800 metres losing ground. Faltered approaching the 600 metres. **COTE D'OR** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

COSTA BRAVO (L Innes) – Got its head up when being steadied passing the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of STRIKING KAY.

KEEP THE MOMENT (L Satherley) – Hung out in the final straight and could not be fully ridden out.

Race 3 ATKINSON & DONALDSON PLUMBERS 1560

RUBYREDDRESS (M McNab) – Dislodged rider during the preliminary and after galloping a circuit of the track the filly was late scratched on veterinary advice at 2.13 pm.

WHIPPED (K McCulloch) - Was slow to begin.

EL HEALO (B Hutton) – Was slow to begin, then commenced to over-race near the 1200 metres having to be firmly restrained off heels.

MIGHTY COLOMBO (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Had to steady when crowded to the outside of WHIPPED which shifted out to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

EMPIRE STAR (L Satherley) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight, and was unable to be fully ridden out.

Race 4 FIRST NATIONAL ROTORUA 1560

The start of race four was delayed due to a malfunction when the barrier stalls failed to open. The Stipendiary Steward directed the Starter to remove all runners from the barriers to be checked by the veterinarian and to have the starting gates tested. WATERBERG was removed from the barriers and underwent a veterinary inspection and was passed fit to run. The barrier stalls failed to open on a second occasion, and the Starter was again asked to remove all runners to be checked, and the gates to be tested. The Starter undertook to start the race manually. Starter, Mr J Moody, was charged with failing to obey a directive and was fined the sum of \$500.

JOLT (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DAHLS DELIGHT (L Satherley) – Got its head up when being steadied off the heels of WATERBERG (C Grylls) which shifted out passing the 1000 metres. Rider C Grylls was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

WANNABE ROYALE (D Johnson) – Got its head up when being steadied away from the heels of DAHLS DELIGHT near the 1000 metres. Raced three wide without cover throughout, and was inclined to lay out during the running.

PHOEBE SNOW (V Gatu) – Raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres.

FLANDERS (Zy Nor Azman) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. After undergoing a post –race veterinary examination it was found to have a small laceration inside the right nostril.

DAHLS DELIGHT (L Satherley) returned to the enclosure with blood present inside both nostrils. After undergoing a post-race veterinary examination it was found to have a small laceration in both nostrils.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

MURIWAI (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BOTANIC (D Prastiyou) – Raced keenly when being restrained passing the 800 metres.

STAR VINSKY (S Collett) - Failed to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

Race 6 ZERO TO 100 1950

GARFUNKEL (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly, losing ground. **GARFUNKEL** over-raced in the early stages. **GARFUNKEL** was held up rounding the final bend, and when shifting ground outwards passing the 250 metres in an attempt to obtain clear running made contact with QUEENSLAND for a distance. **GARFUNKEL** was then unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the straight. Rider S MacNab was shown videos of the final straight and was advised to not persevere when attempting to obtain a marginal run.

QUEENSLAND (C Grylls) – Bumped for a distance passing the 250 metres.

EL NINO (B R Jones) – Was not persevered with in the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DOMEROVA (C Lammas) – Shied on returning to the weigh-in area dislodging rider C Lammas who was uninjured.

Race 7 NOVARA PARK 1950

AVE MARIA (K McCulloch) – Stumbled on jumping away.

ALL ABOUT DOOM (S Weatherley) – Over-raced in the early stages when three wide, and continued to race three wide until improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

AUTUMN WIND (L Satherley) – Got its head up making the 1800 metre bend awkwardly shifting out inconveniencing IRINA which had to steady.

IRINA (M Du Plessis) - Steadied 1800 metres.

MAKE MY DAY (S McKay) – Shifted out when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1100 metres. Was briefly held up passing the 100 metres.

EPAE ROAD (D Prastiyou) – Was held up early in the final straight before obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

FOUR DAY HIGH (L Innes) – Rider L Innes advised Stewards that the mare was feeling the effects of the firmer track conditions.
