Auckland Racing - 1 November 2016

Race 5 Carbine Club Trophy (1600 metres)

Trainer M Rogers advised Stewards that in the days following its performance in this race SEVENTEEN SEVENTY underwent surgery for entrapment of the epiglottis, with the gelding now requiring a two week break from training.

Race 6 OMF Stakes (2000 metres)

Trainer S Ralph advised Stewards that following its performance in this race THUNDER DOWN UNDER underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the entire to be slightly lame in both front legs. X-rays were also taken but did not reveal any abnormality. THUNDER DOWN UNDER has worked in the days following the veterinary examination and shown no signs of lameness, with Mr Ralph further adding it is his intention to continue on with the entries preparation towards the Counties Cup.

Race 7 Carlton Events 1200

Trainer M Murdoch advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of MARKY MARK following its performance in this race, adding it is her intention to trial the gelding prior to racing next.

Otaki-Maori Racing -1 November 2016

Race 6 INPRO GROUP HANDICAP (1350 metres)

Trainer G Humphries advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of MCCULLUM MCCAW following its performance in this race, adding it is his intention to continue on with the gelding current preparation.

Avondale Jockey Club - 2 November 2016

Race 4 Waterview 1600

Trainer S Ritchie advised Stewards that in the days following its performance in this race FIVE OFF THE TEE underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be slightly jarred up in the hind quarters, adding it is now this intention to freshen the gelding prior to racing next.

Waikato Racing - 5 November 2016

Race 4 GOLDSMITH'S GALLERY 2100

Trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of INASTRIDE following its performance in this race, adding it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THANK YOU RODNEY SANDERS 1150

ST REGIS (C Grylls) – Was slow to begin.

DRAGON KINGDOM (M Hills) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

THE KIPLING GIRL (L Satherley) – Was held up for a distance from near the 400 metres, and then raced in restricted room for a distance from near the 200 metres. Following the race rider L Satherley viewed Stewards video footage and elected not to proceed with a protest.

SILK (T Thornton) – When questioned rider T Thornton advised the filly would be better suited over more ground, and was unable to offer any other reason for the filly's performance.

Race 2 PAPER PLUS AND TOYWORLD TE AWAMUTU 1150

OUR REDNECK REBEL (L Satherley) – Trainer K McDonald was issued with a warning for presenting **OUR REDNECK REBEL** to race in gear which had not been notified (blinkers).

MIK JAGGER (A Jones) – Was slow to begin. **MIK JAGGER** hung throughout running wide around the final bend, and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. Trainer G Cameron was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its racing manners.

JUST JIFFI (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly, losing ground.

LIKE A LIE (M McNab) – Was hampered passing the 900 metres by WEHADADEAL which shifted out when steadying.

CAPSTRANO PEARL (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of ICING ON THE CAKE approaching the 800 metres. Hung out around the bend near the 600 metres.

CELEBRATEDACHIEVER (R Elliot) – Hung out around the bend near the 600 metres, and continued to hang until in the final straight.

Race 3 HIGHVIEW STUD 1400

COAT OF HONOR (L Satherley) – Had to be firmly restrained near the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SAVE THE STARS (S Weatherley) which shifted in. Rider S Weatherley was issued with a warning.

ODALISQUE (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SAVE THE STARS (S Weatherley) – Shifted in to obtain clear near the 150 metres inconveniencing BLUE HAZE, and when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of OUR SEQUOIA, which was shifting in under pressure, hampered the weakening ODALISQUE.

Race 4 VILIGRAD WINERY 1580

HAPPYTOKNOWYOU (G Cooksley) – Began awkwardly. Crowded over the concluding stages.

SPRING SHOW (M Hills) – Began awkwardly but quickly recovered.

MUELED (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Held up and unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

MY TRICKSTER (V Colgan)) – Over-raced in the early stages, then was hampered near the 1400 metres when BABOONSKI shifted out abruptly after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of LADY FERNER.

NITETIME LOVER (A Schwerin) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 1100 metres, and dropped back on to BUSTER ABBOTT.

BUSTER ABBOTT (C Grylls) - Steadied 1100 metres.

READY TO RUMBLE (A Sims) - Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages crowding HAPPYTOKNOWYOU.

Race 5 HARNESS & WAIPA 28 DECEMBER 2016 1580

HUNGRY EYES (A Schwerin) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start to the inside of SWEET MOLLY which lay in. As a result **HUNGRY EYES** had to steady.

LUEN YAT MIRACLE (Z Nor Azman) – Over-raced through the middle stages.

INDIAN MAID (M Cameron) – Was held up passing the 450 metres.

RUBEE (S Collett) – Went off stride passing the 300 metres.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

SHONALI (S Spratt) – Was slow to begin.

FLYING ON RED (A Schwerin) – Shifted in shortly after leaving the barriers crowding JUMEIRAH and DULCE BEBE which were checked losing ground. Contributing was some outward movement from MARSHAL.

DULCE BEBE (T Thornton) Crowded and checked on jumping away losing ground.

LADYINTHEWOODS (M McNab) – Raced in restricted room and was steadied shortly after the start.

BELLA ROCCIA (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early stages. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

MARSHAL (M Du Plessis) – Got its head up when being steadied, and made the 1100 metre bend awkwardly. Lost the left front plate during the running.

JUMEIRAH (M Hills) – Crowded and checked on jumping away losing ground. Steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of MARSHAL and got its head up making the bend, near the 1100 metres, awkwardly.

I'LL STAND BY YOU (G Cooksley) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 7 BOXING DAY @ PIRONGIA 1150

SALTED CARAMEL (K Marzuki) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Was held up for clear running for some distance in the final straight.

BALLYCHINE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

RIO CLARO (K McCulloch) – Over-raced for a distance passing the 800 metres when the pace eased making the bend awkwardly and shifting out crowding ABSOLUTE GOLD which was also over-racing.

ABSOLUTE GOLD (Z Nor Azman) – Crowded 800 metres when over-racing through the middle stages.

Race 8 BDO 2000

LOTUS LAUD (D Prastiyou) – Underwent a veterinary inspection at the barrier after being kicked and was a late scratching at 4.53 pm.

STAN'S TUF TIGER (A Sims) – Was slow to begin.

MR INK (B Hutton) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages making the first bend awkwardly near the 1600 metres, and continued to race ungenerously for the remainder of the race.

KEANDRA (C Grylls) – Made the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion. When questioned into the performance rider C Grylls advised Stewards that the mare had got back in the early and middle stages of the race, and was unable to make up the ground over the final stages.

SAKHEE'S STAR (A Schwerin) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.
