## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>PERFECT PACKAGING PREMIER (1200m)</b>
<b>ZAKYNTHOS</b> (M Dee) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses.	
<b>WAIMATE BILL</b> (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly then was inconvenienced.	
<b>JEPEZZ GEORGE</b> (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.	
<b>COURT JESTER</b> (R Cuneen) – Slow to begin.	
<b>SEATHEPOWER</b> (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly making contact with the hindquarters of TRAVIMYFRIEND which became briefly unbalanced with SEATHEPOWER losing ground, over raced badly in early stages, lost both front plates during the running.	

**DANNY WIZZ BANG** (J Riddell) – Raced in restricted room after leaving the barriers.

**SUSIE WOLFF** (S Wynne) – Firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of **COURT JESTER** near 800 metres.

**Race 2** | **FARMERS MILL PREMIER (2000m)**

**ZENTANGLE** (S MacNab) – Over raced when being restrained early stages, having to be further restrained to avoid the heels of **ZHANIM** (S Wynne) which shifted inwards when being steadied and not fully clear approaching the 1800 metres. Rider **S Wynne** was issued with a warning.

**REVELATOR** (K Mudhoo) – Raced three wide without cover. **K Mudhoo** was spoken to regarding his whip use.

**Race 3** | **BIDVEST NEW ZEALAND PREMIER (2000m)**

**RUNWAY** (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

**STONEMASON** (B Moore) – Began awkwardly, over raced early and middle stages.

**VELLUTO** (S Wynne) – Commenced to over race near 1400 metres on a moderate pace, racing ungenerously when having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of **ASPEN LASS**.

**ASPEN LASS** (C Johnson) – Made contact with **STONEMASON** when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

**DA SHINDIG** (L Innes) – Held up early in final straight until shifting outwards across heels approaching the 200 metres.

**Race 4** | **AMICUS INSURANCE BROKERS PREMIER (1400m)**

**BROWN GIRL** (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground, steadied to avoid heels near the 300 metres.

**ANOTHER COUP** (M Cameron) – Slow to begin.

**STAR OF GREENBEEL** (C Johnson) – Had a tendency to lay in when being steadied early stages, raced keenly middle stages, placed in restricted room near the 350 metres when **GALLANT DAN** lay inwards. After being corrected by its rider **GALLANT DAN** (K Mudhoo) then shifted outwards when being ridden forward into the line of **BROWN GIRL** which had to be steadied near the 300 metres. **K Mudhoo** was issued with a warning.

**DIAMOND EDGE** (M Du Plessis) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained early stages.

**GALLANT DAN** (K Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **NIPPIN** (T Moseley) which shifted inwards near the 1000 metres when not fully clear. **T Moseley** was issued with a warning.

**Race 5** | **VALACHI DOWNS CANTERBURY BREEDERS STAKES (1400m)**

**LATIN ROSE** (M Cameron) – Slow to begin (2L), raced in restricted room passing the 1150 metres to the inside of **GALLANT RUBY** which shifted in, held up rounding final turn and continued to have difficulty finding clear running in the final straight until near 150 metres.

**CARAMAC** (R Myers) – Slow to begin.

**CZARISTA** (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground, raced wide throughout.

**MEURSAULT** (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ZAH GIRL** (S Spratt) – Crowded and checked passing the 1350 metres to the inside of **GALLANT RUBY** (S Muniandy) which shifted inwards when not clear. **S Muniandy** admitted a resultant breach of careless riding, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races for 3 riding days effective 10 November to 27 November 2016 inclusive.

**FIRST SERVE** (S Wynne) – Raced three wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres.

**FAME SEEKER** (S Collett) – When questioned regarding performance, rider S Collett was of the opinion that the mare had been run off its feet and would appreciate some easing of the round. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality other than the mare being reported to be coming into season.

**Race 6**

**HALLS REFRIGERATED TRANSPORT PREMIER (1600m)**

**SEBRING DRAGON** (E Farr) – Hampered leaving the barriers by **SCANDALO** which shifted outwards. As a result **POWERBALL** which was slow to begin was also further hampered.

**POWERBALL** (C Johnson) – Slow to begin then further hampered. Lost the right front plate during the running.

**LITTLE HAAST** (S Wynne) – Slow to begin then further hampered.

**LIN** (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**STEPHENSTIHLS** (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

**MOST LIKELY** (S Muniandy) – Raced wide without cover. Trainer M McCann advised that the gelding was now likely to be retired from his stable.

**JUSTRUSH** (R Myers) – Raced wide throughout.

**SCANDALO** (T Moseley) – Over raced for a distance when placed in restricted room near 1200 metres.

**SAVASON** (M Dee) – Held up early in final straight with rider dropping his left rein near 250 metres before obtaining clear running near 200 metres.

**Race 7**

**LINDAUER STEWARDS STAKES HANDICAP (1200m)**

**KINAGAT** (C Johnson) – Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied, raced keenly early stages.

**EL CHICO** (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly making brief contact with **REILLY LINCOLN** which became unbalanced.

**REILLY LINCOLN** (R Myers) – Unbalanced leaving barriers.

**RIDING SHOTGUN** (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly and then restrained.

**PINZANO** (D Johnson) – Came together and bumped with **KINAGAT** near the 700 metres.

**KINAGAT** (C Johnson) – Came together and bumped with **PINZANO** near the 700 metres then over racing for a distance.

**SIGNIFY** (R Cuneen) – Shifted outwards to obtain clear running inconveniencing **KINAGAT** near the 150 metres. **R Cuneen** was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>NZB READY TO RUN SALE PREMIER 3YO (1400m)</b>
<p><b>TUILANA</b> (C Johnson) – Knuckled leaving the barriers and shifted outwards crowding SHADOW KING which had been slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SHADOW KING</b> (R Myers) – Slow then further hampered when crowded at start.</p> <p><b>FRIDAY KNIGHT</b> (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly then having to steady when racing in restricted room.</p> <p><b>ELECTRIC SHOCK</b> (S Collett) – Commenced to race fiercely when being steadied early stages and continued to do so through middle stages. Trainer P Rudkin was advised that ELECTRIC SHOCK is required to trial to the satisfaction of Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>JUST</b> (S Wynne) – Held up early in final straight then having to be steadied away from the heels of SHADOW KING near the 250 metres before obtaining clear running to the inside of that runner near the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>12<sup>TH</sup> COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE (1600m)</b>
<p><b>SEVENTH UP</b> (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards and crowding CHARMONT onto TOMMY TUCKER which lost ground.</p> <p><b>TOMMY TUCKER</b> – Hampered at start losing ground.</p> <p><b>NASHVILLE</b> – Slow to begin (2L).</p> <p><b>FIVE KINGS</b> (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SEIZE THE MOMENT</b> (L Innes) – Hampered leaving the barriers, raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance, L Innes advised that the gelding had not felt comfortable on today's firm surface. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality other than a small abrasion to the left nostril.</p> <p><b>MAYBE MIAMI</b> (C Johnson) – Over raced when being restrained early stages.</p> <p><b>STOKERS ROCK</b> (S Wynne) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near 200 metres.</p> <p><b>THEE AULD FLOOZIE</b> – Rider D Johnson reported that in her opinion the mare had not been entirely suited by the firm nature of today's track.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>ROMANO'S PIZZAS PREMIER (2500m)</b>
<p><b>SWEET TIME</b> (M Cameron) – Began very awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SHOW MACCOOL</b> (D Hirini) – Raced wide without cover until working forward to sit outside the leader passing the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>EVADIR LA BALA</b> (M Dee) – Lay in making slight contact with SHOW MACCOOL passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>BLU MACH</b> (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight.</p>
