**RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	The New Zealand Herald 1400
<p><b>MARKY MARK</b> (L Innes) – Trainers M &amp; K Murdoch were issued with a warning after presenting to race without notified gear (side winkers). Had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>SERIOUS SATIRE</b> which was crowded for room by <b>RED TSUNAMI</b> which was taken inwards by <b>CHARMONT</b> (M Coleman). M Coleman was issued with a warning. Held up early in the final straight and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres made contact with <b>RED TSUNAMI</b>.</p> <p><b>SERIOUS SATIRE</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied to avoid heels 1200 metres then crowded for room near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>SEVENTH UP</b> (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ABADDON</b> (M McNab) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>IRISH CALL</b> (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>OUR KING SWAY</b> (C Lammas) – Jumped away awkwardly then having to be steadied shortly after the start when placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>MR KNOWITALL</b> (L Satherley). Rider L Satherley was advised to exercise care. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until near the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>THE JUSTICE LEAGUE</b> (K McCulloch) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1200 metres and shifted inwards abruptly with <b>SERIOUS SATIRE</b> then having to be steadied to avoid that runner's heels.</p> <p><b>RED TSUNAMI</b> (S Collett) – Crowded 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>ANNABELINDA</b> (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously through the middle stages being inclined to get its head up.</p> <p><b>MR KNOWITALL</b> (L Satherley) – Disappointed for run near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>AAJA NACHLE</b> (V Gatu) – Was not persevered with in the final straight when well beaten. Trainer Mr F Ritchie advised that the mare was showing signs of having jarred up and was now to be retired.</p>	
Race 2	Auckland Co-op Taxis 1100
<p><b>STOLE THE SHOW</b> (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded. Crowded for room between <b>PEACEFUL FALLS</b> and <b>SOPHIE'S CHOICE</b> which both shifted ground near the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>GLOBAL THINKING</b> (S Collett) – Slow to begin before being further hampered when crowded. Had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres when crowded for room by <b>POPACAP</b> which shifted away from <b>KAPOOR</b> (M Cameron) when placed in restricted room to the inside of that runner. M Cameron was issued with a warning.</p> <p><b>LORD BUFFALO</b> (V Gatu) – Began awkwardly then crowded.</p> <p><b>FLEUR DELACOUR</b> (A Collett) – Slow to begin.</p>	

**STAR TREASURE** (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.

**SOPHIE’S CHOICE** (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

**POPACAP** (V Colgan) – Crowded 1000 metres. Raced greenly throughout.

**VERSES** (B Hutton) – Hung outwards rounding the final turn and early in the straight forcing **HAUSSMANN** outwards near the 350 metres with **SOPHIE’S CHOICE** also being inconvenienced.

**PEACEFUL FALLS** (S Weatherley) – Hung outwards rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the straight.

**HAUSSMANN** – Lost the right hind plate during the running.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Conveyancing Shop Lawyers 1400</b>
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**NIGHT’S WATCH** (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin.

**ORPHEA** (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.

**BARCELO** (S McKay) – Began awkwardly. Hung outwards making the final turn awkwardly, running wide.

**WYNDSPELLE** (V Colgan) – Made contact with the hind quarters of **HALL OF FAME** passing the 1300 metres becoming briefly unbalanced hampering **JON SNOW**.

**DARK UNIVERSE** (M Hills) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 1300 metres, hampering **JON SNOW** near the 1100 metres and continuing to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

**JON SNOW** (M Cameron) – Hampered 1300 metres and 1100 metres. Made the turn near the 900 metres awkwardly hampering **ICHIBAN**.

**ICHIBAN** (J Parkes) – Hampered 900 metres.

**BRUCE ARTHUR** (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**HURRY** – Lost the right hind plate during the running.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Shaws Wire Ropes 1200</b>
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**HOLLYWOOD LASS** (L Innes) – Declared a late scratching at 2.27pm after refusing to enter the barriers. Trainer Mr T Pike was advised that the mare is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

**CHADSDALE** (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Made contact with **SHOT IN THE DARK** when attempting to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.

**ENOUGH** (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SHOT IN THE DARK** (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Bumped 150 metres.

**GO NICHOLAS** (M Du Plessis) – Over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres. Shifted outwards away from **SPLURGE** over the final 100 metres.

**ALL TORN UP** (D Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover.

**SPLURGE** (O Bosson) – Was inclined to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting away from SELFIE over the final 100 metres with GO NICHOLAS also being inclined to shift away from SPLURGE over the final 100 metres.

**SELFIE** (A Collett) – Shifted outwards under pressure over the final 100 metres.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Carter Bloodstock Rising Romance Mile (1600 metres)</b>
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**DESERT STORM** (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

**HEART BEAT** (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin.

**DOURO** (Z Nor Azman) – Slow to begin.

**CHANCERY** (C Lammas) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

**NEALA** (BR Jones) – Slow to begin.

**ANIMATOR** (K McCulloch) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 1400 metres and near the 1300 metres when continuing to race fiercely made contact with SERAPHIM after becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of DESERT STORM which shifted away from TE WAEWAE BAY (R Elliot). Apprentice R Elliot was advised to exercise care. ANIMATOR continued to over-race through the middle stages hanging outwards rounding the bend and was unable to be fully ridden out in the straight. Trainer Mr B Hawtin was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its racing manners with Mr Hawtin indicating that he would be looking to restrict its racing to left-handed tracks. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**SERAPHIM** (D Johnson) – Became unbalanced when bumped near the 1300 metres.

**ASTON PARK** (L Satherley) – Raced ungenerously passing the 600 metres.

**SOUL SISTA** (M Cameron) – Inclined to lay in once placed under pressure in the final straight. When questioned rider was of the opinion that the mare may be better suited over more ground.

**WANNABE ROYALE** (J Parkes) – Briefly crowded to the inside of TE WAEWAE BAY near the 150 metres.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Cambridge Stud Eight Carat Classic (1600 metres)</b>
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**AVEC MOI** (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground before being crowded to the inside of VOLPE VELOCE which lay in despite the efforts of its rider. Checked 1400 metres and 800 metres.

**SHE BRINGS JOY** (S Collett) – Began awkwardly. Hampered 800 metres. Forced wider 500m

**THISTLEDONICELY** (M Du Plessis) – Forced wider shortly after leaving the barriers. Hampered 800 metres.

**Apprentice B Hutton** admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount DEVISE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear forcing VOLPE VELOCE inwards crowding AVEC MOI which was checked near the 1400 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Apprentice Hutton's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 27 December 2016 until the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 3 January 2017, 6 riding days.

**DEVISE** (B Hutton) – Commenced to over-race when the pace steadied then making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly shifting outwards to avoid the heels of CHAMBON. DEVISE continued to be awkwardly placed near the heels of CHAMBON for a distance with DATE NIGHT then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DEVISE when

that runner was being corrected with DATE NIGHT shifting inwards when having to be steadied into the line of AVEC MOI which was checked near the 800 metres. Hampered as a result were THISTLEDONICELY, PRINCESS SAPPHIRE, SHE BRINGS JOY and BONNEVAL. Forced wider 500 metres.

**PRINCESS SAPPHIRE** (D Johnson) – Hampered 800 metres.

**VOLPE VELOCE** (J Parkes) – Shifted outwards to obtain clear running rounding the bend near the 500 metres forcing DEVISE, GALLOPING GERTE and SHE BRINGS JOY wider on the track.

**GALLOPING GERTE** (M McNab) – Forced wider 500 metres.

**BONNEVAL** (O Bosson) – Shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers dictating THISTLEDONICELY wider on the track. Was not persevered with in the final straight being retired from the race. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Rider O Bosson advised that the filly had hung throughout. Co-trainer Mr A Forsman was advised that BONNEVAL would be required to trial satisfactorily before racing again.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>2016/17 Dunstan Feeds Rising Stars Championship Final (1500 metres)</b>
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**CAPRIKOSA** (M Du Plessis) – The start was delayed due to CAPRIKOSA requiring attention to its blinkers which had failed during the preliminary. Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

**BRUEGEL** (S Collett) – Underwent a veterinary examination at the barriers before being passed fit to run. Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LIGHT SHADOW** (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

**PALACE ROCK** (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**HENREE WINKLER** (J Riddell) – Shifted inwards passing the 1300 metres briefly crowding SULTAN OF SWING and ALAMER. Rider J Riddell was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**SULTAN OF SWING** (S Weatherley) – Crowded 1300 metres. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

**ALAMER** (J Parkes) – Crowded 1300 metres.

**WHATZ OCCURRING** (A Collett) – Raced wide without cover.

**DARK AND STORMY** (M Coleman) – Was briefly held up early in the final straight.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>Hallmark Stud Handicap (1200 metres)</b>
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**FULLY FUNDED** (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

**ROCANTO** (O Bosson) – Slow to begin.

**SOMETHINGVAIN** (S Spratt) – Had to be steadied when crowded between SNAPSHOT and IN FLIGHT near the 1000 metres.

**LOS VARGAS** (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover.

**SPEECH CRAFT** (J Riddell) – Was held up early in the final straight.

<b>IN FLIGHT</b> (M Cameron) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>Zabeel Classic (2000 metres)</b>
<p><b>PERFECT START</b> (M Du Plessis) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving at the barriers and was passed fit to run. Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BEL SORRISO</b> (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Dipped passing the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>PROMISE TO REIGN</b> (L Innes) – Began awkwardly. Hampered near the 150 metres when HASSELHOOF shifted away from CONSENSUS which lay in.</p> <p><b>STYLISH ATTACK</b> (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and was steadied.</p> <p><b>GIRL OF MY DREAMS</b> (S Spratt) - Over raced when leading in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>CONSENSUS</b> (A Collett) – Briefly raced in restricted room passing the 1800 metres to the inside of AUTHENTIC PADDY. Lost the left front plate during the running.</p> <p><b>HASSELHOOF</b> (O Bosson) – Commenced to over race near the 1700 metres, racing ungenerously when being restrained to avoid the heels of CONSENSUS, then continuing to over race through the middle stages. A post-race veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination confirmed the gelding to have bled and as such is now subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing with a veterinary clearance required prior to trialling or racing again.</p> <p><b>SOUND PROPOSITION</b> (M Coleman) – A post-race veterinary examination found the gelding to have suffered from Cardiac Arrhythmia. Co-Trainer Mr A Scott was advised the appropriate veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>M Cameron</b> - admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount VOLKSTOK’N’BARRELL to shift outwards over the final 50 metres when not sufficiently clear of SAINT EMILION which was crowded and checked. M Cameron was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Monday 1 January 2017 until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 12 January 2017, 6 riding days, and was in addition fined the sum of \$1,000.</p> <p><b>SAINT EMILION</b> (D Johnson) – Crowded and checked final 50 metres. Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections viewed available films before electing not to proceed with a protest.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>Dunstan Feeds Stayers Championship Qualifier 2100</b>
<p><b>LATE DECISION</b> (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>FOUR DEGREES</b> (S McKay) – Made contact when leaving the barriers becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>QUINTESENTIALLY</b> (D Johnson) – Crowded shortly after jumping away. Held up near the 450 metres.</p> <p><b>BLIZZARD</b> (H Marzuki) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>ARROW IN THE SAND</b> (S Spratt) – Held up for a distance rounding the final turn from the 500 metres. Lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>EL FERNANDO</b> (C Grylls) – Awkwardly placed near heels approaching the 400 metres. Crowded and hampered for a distance near the 250 metres when BANROCK shifted outwards.</p>	

**Apprentice T Wenn** – Suspended from the conclusion of racing today 26 December 2016 until the conclusion of racing on Monday 2 January 2017, 4 riding days, after admitting a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount BANROCK to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of EL FERNANDO which was crowded and hampered for a distance near the 250 metres.

**ZAFRENZY** (A Collett) – Held up near the 300 metres having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.
