Race 1	HYDROFLOW HANDICAP (2200 metres)
<p>ITSALLBELT (H Andrew) - Lay in leaving the barriers crowding MR COOL BOY onto NITRO TED. Raced wide without cover throughout. H Andrew was issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 200 metres</p> <p>MR COOL BOY (C Lammas) – Crowded start. Lost near front plate during running.</p> <p>NITRO TED (T Johnson) – Crowded start.</p>	
Race 2	AGPAC MAIDEN (1200 metres)
<p>ITZ MY ONE (S McKay) - Shifted inwards leaving the barriers crowding MYRTLE.</p> <p>MYRTLE (M Du Plessis) – Crowded start. Inclined to lay inwards throughout the final straight.</p> <p>PRINCESS SPICE (S Wynne) - Jumped away awkwardly. Had to be briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 500 metres. Held up early in the final straight.</p>	

YEMANYA (M Tanaka) – Jumped away awkwardly. Crowded near the 250 metres when ITZ MY ONE shifted outwards under pressure, then further hampered near the 200 metres when MYRTLE lay in when its rider was swapping his whip over to the left hand.	
Race 3	FARM SOURCE HANDICAP (1200 metres)
NORTH AND SOUTH (R Hannam) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.	
ETERNITY (H Andrew) – Over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.	
Race 4	SEALES WINSLOW HANDICAP (1200 metres)
BOXAMOSA (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly bumping with GLADSTONE BELLE.	
GLADSTONE BELLE (A Chan) - Began awkwardly bumping with BOXAMOSA. Received contact to hindquarters 900 metres.	
PROSECCO (D Hirini) - shifted inwards when being restrained making contact with the hind quarters of GLADSTONE BELLE near the 900 metres.	
ENCHANTING SECRET (M Du Plessis) – When questioned regarding poor performance, rider advised that the filly had travelled comfortably in the lead but had been unable to quicken once placed under pressure being disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any significant abnormality other than the filly having a poor recovery rate.	
Race 5	TRU TEST HANDICAP (1600 metres)
CRUISER (J Parkes) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that he had been intending to obtain cover early but after starting to over-race due to a lack of pace he had allowed the gelding to improve forward to lead then being taken on in the middle stages when OUR GAZZA improved forward near the 800 metres. J Parkes further advised that CRUISER had then failed to finish the race off believing that it had not been suited by the small field and muddling tempo.	
Race 6	ECOLAB MAIDEN (1400 metres)
RAM SAM SAM (S O’Malley) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide from the 900 metres. Apprentice O’Malley was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.	
HELLS BELLS (D Turner) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.	
Race 7	NUFARM HANDICAP (1400 metres)
ALL IN LUCK (H Andrew) – Raced keenly in the lead in the early to middle stages. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed an amount of nasal discharge.	
Race 8	PIONEER HANDICAP (1600 metres)
WAZUZU (R Myers) – Slow away.	
MISS DEJAVU (J Parkes) – Slow away.	
ALL GINGA (R Goldsbury) – Over-raced in the early stages.	
MCCULLUM MCCAWE (H Tinsley) – Rider unable to offer any excuses for poor performance.	
S McKay - Admitted a charge that he used the whip excessively on his mount ANOTHER BACHELOR prior to the 200 metres, being fined the sum of \$300 by the Judicial Committee.
