RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 DMAN ENTERTAINMENT SC MDN 1800M

LOVETHEFEELING (J Riddell) - raced three wide without cover throughout. Hung from the 500 metres.

Rider R Hannam (KEEN TO KEEPER) – Rider R Hannam was questioned by stewards after he eased his mount near the 200 metres when appearing to be still in contention. R Hannam advised that he considered his mount had little left after being well tried rounding the turn and early in the home straight. After reviewing footage the explanation given by R Hannam was accepted.

A post race veterinary inspection of KEEN TO KEEPER was clear.

Race 2 METRO DIRECT INSPIRATION IN 1000M

IRISH FLAME (S McKay) – began awkwardly. Tended to lay in under pressure nearing the 200 metres and was then angled back to the inside for a run near the 100 metres.

WESTSIDE (R Hannam) – slow to begin. Bumped with SHOW ME TIZ when angled for a run near the 200 metres.

SHOW ME TIZ (E Farr) – raced three wide without cover and had to be checked off heels passing the 600 metres.

Rider M McNab (NUCLEONIC) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after he angled his mount inwards shortly after the start when not clear of VINCENT which had to be momentarily steadied.

LINCOLN'S GAL (M Tanaka) – had to be steadied off the heels of NUCLEONIC towards the end of the backstraight.

VINCENT (J Parkes) – steadied shortly after the start.

Race 3 TARANAKI DAILY NEWS SC MDN 1200M

UNUSUAL ACHIEVER (E Farr) – jumped outwards at the start bumping SUMMERFLY then settled back. Tended to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

ABBEY KAY (M McNab) – raced erratically for a short distance passing the 1000 metres when being restrained.

MARS BARS (J Parkes) – over raced along the back straight.

PERSEPHONE (C Dell) –raced erratically near the 800 metres. Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

Race 4 PETER SOLE TRANSPORT SC MDN 1400M

BOOMERANG (L Innes) – was slow away.

BATCHELOR BABE (R Hannam) – raced greenly when crossing on to the course proper from the chute. Continued to over race along the back straight. Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres.

Co-Trainer J Richards (STOLEN LOVE) – advised Stewards that he would make gear alterations on the filly after a disappointing performance.

Race 5 WAYNE BEGGS & MAXINE ROGER 1400M

KEEPING TOM (D Hirini) was rehandicapped 2kgs after winning on 24 December 2016 at New Plymouth. Raced keenly in the back straight and tended to lay out under pressure over the final stages.

KING KANE (M McNab) – began awkwardly and was slow away.

FASCINO LASS (J Parkes) – was slow away.

PRAIRIE CREEK (S McKay) – was disappointed for a run near the 200 metres and had to be angled towards the inside to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres.

WYNTHORPE (R Hannam) – raced keenly passing the 800 metres and made the bend awkwardly.

Race 6 HIREPOOL SC MDN 1600M

KEEP THE MOMENT (R Hannam) – was slow away. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres tightening KEEPER GIRL on to KUIA which became unbalanced. Tended to lay out under pressure in the final 200 metres dictating KEEPER GIRL over extra ground.

COTTONEVA (J Parkes) – was tightened at the start and got back. Commenced to over race into the back straight. Had to be angled out to avoid the heels of KUIA near the 800 metres.

KUIA (M Mcnab) – When questioned into the run of the filly which finished some distance last, rider M McNab said that despite being wide throughout he had no real excuse.

Race 7 FARMLANDS 2000M

EFFECTAV (C Dell) – was slow away.

SHE'S POPPY (S McKay) – had to change ground passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running. Rider S McKay reported to Stewards that in his opinion the mare may prefer more rain affected footing.

Race 8 HEATCOOL 2000M

RED RASCALL (R Hannam) – was slow away.

DAL LAUREON (M Tanaka) – hit the running rail near the 800 metres.

ALARMIST (R Myers) – hit the running rail near the 800 metres. A post race veterinary inspection of ALARMIST revealed a slight arrhythmia with the trainer to take bloods off the mare in coming days.

CUZZIE CHARLIE (S McKay) – shied away from the rail near the 800 metre turn.
