RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600
GATA (V Colgan) – Crowded jumping away.	
SHINE ON (M Hills) – Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground.	
ROAD TRIP (T Thornton) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages, then passing the 1300 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside heels. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages making contact with KAMIKAZE REBEL.	

FLAGSTAFF (M Cameron) – Was bumped and unbalanced passing the 1400 metres by GATA (V Colgan) which shifted in. Rider **V Colgan** was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. Lay in passing the 1300 metres making contact with KAKAHU STALKER which became briefly unbalanced. FLAGSTAFF raced in restricted room approaching the 800 metres to the inside of KAMIKAZE REBEL (C Lammas) which improved to the inside of NO LOITERING (S McKay) which had been forced wider by ROAD TRIP which continued to over-race, as a result FLAGSTAFF became badly unbalanced and was hampered. Riders **C Lammas** and **S McKay** were advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

KAKAHU STALKER (S Spratt) - Contacted 1300 metres and unbalanced.

NO LOITERING (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover.

POLAR SECRET (M Coleman) – Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

TIFFANY'S TIME (M McNab) – Came together with CASCATA jumping away with TIFFANY'S TIME becoming unbalanced and losing ground. TIFFANY'S TIME and XIONG FENG came together passing the 300 metres.

LORD ASCOT (R Elliot) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

SHEALLRAAJ (V Gatu) – Raced wide without cover and lay in when making the bend near the 900 metres.

VOLPE VELOCE (J Parkes) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 600 metres forcing CASCATA wider on the track.

CASCATA (T Johnson) – Forced wide 600 metres. Rider T Johnson lost his whip near the 200 metres.

XIONG FENG (S Spratt) – Came together with TIFFANY'S TIME when briefly crowded passing the 300 metres by VOLPE VELOCE which shifted in slightly.

ROCKNROLLA (T Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

LATE DECISION (S Spratt) – Crowded jumping away losing ground.

STRADIVARIUS (E Farr) – Lay out early in the final straight.

AIDE MEMOIRE (V Gatu) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 4	IXOM 2100

CHEQUERED FLAG (S McKay) – Was slow away. Rider lost his whip near the 200 metres.

REALTA (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Became awkwardly placed on heels when making the crossing near the 1600 metres.

EL LUCHADOR (V Colgan) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1800 metres, and when becoming awkwardly placed on heels, shifted out making contact with SKY IDEA with that runner shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of BEYOND REACH with both those runners becoming unbalanced. Continued to over-race through the middle stages. EL LUCHADOR was crowded passing the 250 metres by BEYOND REACH which was dictated out by STOCKTAKE which shifted out under pressure.

ON PAROLE (C Lammas) – Raced ungenerously when making the first bend. Steadied passing the 100 metres when crowded to the inside of STOCKTAKE which shifted away from BEYOND REACH which had a tendency to lay in.

SKY IDEA (M Tanaka) – Was crowded passing the 1800 metres having to steady for a distance. Raced wide without cover throughout making contact with LIZZIE L'AMOUR for a distance passing the 900 metres.

BEYOND REACH (A Jones) – Raced wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leading passing the 1200 metres.

GO NICHOLAS (C Dell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. GO NICHOLAS shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 500 metres forcing DE NIRO wide on the track. Following the race the connections of the 2nd placed horse GO NICHOLAS lodged a protest against the 1st placed horse ROCANTO alleging interference in the final straight. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the objection.

DE NIRO (S McKay) – Forced wide 500 metres.

CINEMATIC (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly making contact with MR KNOWITALL which became briefly unbalanced.

MR KNOWITALL (A Schwerin) – Bumped and unbalanced start.

LIGHT SHADOW (M Coleman) – Commenced to race fiercely when being steadied for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

ROCANTO (H Marzuki) – Lay out making the final bend. Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight shifting out and inconveniencing IT'S BIANCA passing the 100 metres.

IT'S BIANCA (T Thornton) – Inconvenienced 100 metres.

ABADDON (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding the performance of ABADDON rider V Colgan could offer no tangible excuses.

ABIDEWITHME (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CELEBRITY MISS (T Thornton) – Crowded to the outside of AMARULA which lay out when linking on to the course proper near the 1400 metres. Raced wide for the majority of the race.

JULINSKY PRINCE (J Parkes) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1200 metres, and then raced in restricted room to the inside of MIME (V Colgan) which shifted in. As a result JULINSKY PRINCE then made contact with SOUND PROPOSITION which was briefly unbalanced. Rider **V Colgan** was severely reprimanded and advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. JULINSKY PRINCE was held up until near the 300 metres.

SOUND PROPOSITION (M Coleman) – Contacted and briefly unbalanced near the 1100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of SOUND PROPOSITION rider M Coleman advised that the gelding had not been suited by today's track conditions.

MIME (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding the performance of MIME rider V Colgan advised the mare had travelled well, but when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres failed to respond. MIME underwent a veterinary examination which revealed bilateral proximal shin soreness.

<p>ANIMATOR (T Johnson) – Began awkwardly, then was crowded shortly after losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained off heels passing the 1200 metres, and continued to do so for a distance.</p> <p>RICHIE MCHORSE (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>ULTIMATA (M Coleman) – Stumbled jumping away.</p> <p>CURSIVE (H Marzuki) – Was crowded shortly after the start having to steady.</p> <p>HIGHLAND PARK (M Cameron) – Lay out shortly after the start. Crowded 300 metres to the outside of ENDEAN ROSE (B Hutton) which shifted out. Apprentice rider B Hutton was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>ENDEAN ROSE (B Hutton) – Shifted out passing 300 metres.</p> <p>MCCULLUM (Z Nor Azman) – Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>TE HANA (J Parkes) – When questioned regarding the performance of TE HANA rider J Parkes advised that the mare had switched off and became disinterested when becoming tailed off in the final straight.</p>	
Race 8	PRO STEEL STAINLESS STEEL FABRICATORS 1600
<p>DOURO (Z Nor Azman) – Apprentice rider I Fraser-Hayes was replaced by Z Nor Azman after failing to claim to his published riding weight with I Fraser-Hayes being fined \$100.00 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.</p> <p>ZACADA (M Cameron) – Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>WHAT’S UP ALF (T Johnson) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SACRED GALAXY which was steady. As a result WHAT’S UP ALF raced ungenerously for a distance and was hampered, shifting back on to GUMBOOTS which raced in restricted room for a distance.</p> <p>GUMBOOTS (B Hutton) – Raced in restricted room 900 metres. Rider B Hutton reported that GUMBOOTS had felt indifferent in its action with the gelding undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p>
