Racing Tauranga - 21 December 2016
Race 3 – Ste Industrial Electrical 1600
GUMBOOTS - Trainer K Coxon advised Stewards that GUMBOOTS underwent a veterinary examination including x-rays in the days following its performance in this race which did not reveal any abnormality. It is her intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.
Race 8 – Cronin Cullen Egan Chartered Accountants 1400
BONNY EMILIA - Trainer R James advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of BONNY EMILIA following its performance in this race, adding that he would now be looking for some easing in the ground prior to racing the mare next.

Race 9 – Gear Welding Services 1400

DOUBTLESS BAY - Trainer R James advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of DOUBTLESS BAY following its performance in this race, however the filly has now been sent for a spell.

Race 5 - Carter Bloodstock Rising Romance Mile (1600 metres)

ANIMATOR - Trainer B Hawtin advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of ANIMATOR following its performance in this race, adding it would now be his intention to restrict the gelding to left handed racing in the near future.

Race 6 - Cambridge Stud Eight Carat Classic (1600 metres)

BONNEVAL - Trainer A Forsman advised that he was satisfied with the recovery of BONNEVAL following its performance in this race, however added that the filly would trial prior to racing next.

Race 9 - Zabeel Classic (2000 metres)

SOUND PROPOSITION - Trainer A Scott advised Stewards that SOUND PROPOSITION was still suffering from cardiac arrhythmia following the race and the gelding has been transferred to a veterinary clinic for further treatment.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Viva.Co.NZ 1200
<p>TRAVEL WISE (D Prastiyou) – Dislodged its rider when arriving at the barrier and galloped a short distance before being recaptured. After undergoing a veterinary examination the gelding was passed fit to race. Began awkwardly losing ground and raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>LATIN ROSE (O Bosson) – Lay out after jumping away making contact with BLACK MASCARA.</p> <p>DRAGON DANCER (C Lammas) – Hampered shortly after jumping away when making contact.</p> <p>SAVILE ROW (M Coleman) – Steadied shortly after jumping away when crowded. Had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure early in the final straight.</p>	
Race 2	Timeout 1200
<p>AS YOU WILL (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding OSCAR EIGHT. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>OSCAR EIGHT (M McNab) – Crowded jumping away. Rider M McNab was of the opinion that the gelding may benefit from the addition of blinkers.</p> <p>ORIENTAL DRAGON (M Cameron) – Slow away.</p> <p>VALETINA VITTORIA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting out with SAVELLE shifting away from that runner hampering LUXE which had to steady losing ground. Raced in restricted room passing the 1100 metres to the inside of SAVELLE which was taken in slightly by IFFRAGAL (O Bosson). As a result VALETINA VITTORIA had to steady losing ground. Rider O Bosson was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>LUXE (D Johnson) – Hampered jumping away losing ground.</p> <p>BOMBARD (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Hampered approaching the 900 metres when improving on to the heels of SAVELLE which was steadied.</p>	

PADRAIG (M Du Plessis) – Raced in restricted room shortly after jumping away having to be steadied.

FELTON ROAD (L Innes) – Raced in restricted room shortly after jumping away having to be steadied. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SHORT FUSE (S McKay) – Briefly crowded passing the 300 metres to the inside of IFFRAGAL which lay in when placed under pressure.

MCCARTNEY (T Thornton) – Crowded passing the 100 metres when weakening by SHORT FUSE (S McKay) which shifted out under pressure. Apprentice S McKay was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 3	Canvas Magazine 1200

KIWI KASHBAO (S Collett) – Slow away. Shifted out passing the 350 metres making contact when looking to obtain clear running.

LASTING FRIENDSHIP (M Coleman) – Shifted out abruptly jumping away hampering FAST AND FURIOUS which had to steady losing ground.

FAST AND FURIOUS (L Innes) – Hampered and steadied on jumping away. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres then shifted in to obtain clear running. Improved into a marginal run approaching the 200 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

MAKAKAHO JUNCTION (M Vance) – Slow away.

APOLLO'S DAUGHTER (S Spratt) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages when wide and continued to race three wide without cover throughout.

REGAL DANCER (K McCulloch) – Inconvenienced 400 metres. Unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

BREEZON (A Schwerin) – Made the final bend awkwardly inconveniencing REGAL DANCER and forced TOBI slightly wider on the track.

TOBI (O Bosson) – Raced keenly when being steadied in the early to middle stages. Forced slightly wider 400 metres. Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the outside of BREEZON which lay away from FAST AND FURIOUS. As a result TOBI had to steady losing ground.

DR GREENGRASS (C Grylls) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight and was inconvenienced when bumped by KIWI KASHBAO passing the 75 metres.

MY GIDDY AUNT (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Cameron advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 4	Dunstan Feeds 1200

NEESON (L Innes) – Dislodged Rider L Innes at the barrier who suffered a minor knee injury and was subsequently unable to ride the colt with NEESON declared a late scratching at 2.28pm. **L Innes** was stood down by the club doctor from his remaining rides.

SCAGLIONI (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly making contact with LIZ'S GIFT losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

REPO BAY (D Prastiyou) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering SINGLE MOMENT which had to be steadied losing ground. Over-raced through the middle stages.

SINGLE MOMENT (T Thornton) – Hampered jumping away losing ground.

SIDESTEP (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to over-race approaching the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on heels and was hampered as a result.

CHANKOWONG (R Elliot) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 450 metres.

Race 5	Dunstan Feeds 1600
---------------	---------------------------

LONGFORD (C Grylls) – Lay out after jumping away hampering VENDIMA, MANDILARIA and MASTER OF SPEED.

VENDIMA (D Prastiyou) – Hampered at start losing ground. Had to steady passing the 450 metres for a distance when awkwardly placed.

MANDILARIA (C Dell) – Hampered at start losing ground.

MASTER OF SPEED (M Coleman) – Hampered at start losing ground. Raced ungenerously when awkwardly placed approaching the 700 metres.

COMIN'THROUGH (M Cameron) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final turn approaching the 400 metres.

LAMBRUSCO (O Bosson) – Raced wide in the early stages.

KALDOREI (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Forced wider 400 metres.

NYMPH (K McCulloch) – Had to shift out to avoid heels approaching the 700 metres when the pace steadied.

BLACKMAGICWOMAN (S Weatherley) – Shifted out approaching the 400 metres forcing KALDOREI wider on the track.

CHATEAU ROC (J Jago) – Had to steady passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of FLAGSTAFF which shifted out.

NEDDY NADEEM (A Collett) – Crowded passing the 150 metres and steadied for a distance to the outside of MARSHAL which shifted out when Rider M Du Plessis changed his whip hand. Contributing was slight inward movement from LAMBRUSCO which was taken in slightly by BLACKMAGICWOMAN.

HE ROCKS – Lost the off hind plate during the running.

STACCATO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

STRADIVARIUS (E Farr) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when leading. Rider E Farr was questioned regarding the riding tactics adopted on STRADIVARIUS and in particular why after establishing a significant lead, she had shown no apparent vigour until near the 250 metres when being challenged by other runners. Rider E Farr explained that she believed STRADIVARIUS had tended to round his races off when horses had challenged him, but further advised that in hindsight she may have erred in not trying to maintain her advantage earlier in the final straight.

Race 7	The New Zealand Herald 1400
<p>SIN TO WIN (M McNab) – After becoming fractious in the barriers was removed to undergo a post-race veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching at 4.15pm after suffering lacerations to the hind legs.</p> <p>OUR SEQUOIA (A Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting in and crowding ELFEE in on to SAFFRON LADY with ELFEE having to be steadied losing ground. Raced ungenerously on a moderate pace through the middle stages.</p> <p>ELFEE (M Du Plessis) – Crowded jumping away losing ground. Hampered 900 metres when awkwardly placed on heels shifting out forcing MISS ELEGANTE wider on the track.</p> <p>JULIUS (M Cameron) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1200 metres shifting back on to POWER OF PATCH which also commenced to race ungenerously. Raced ungenerously on a moderate pace through the middle stages.</p> <p>POWER OF PATCH (C Grylls) – Commenced to race ungenerously when awkwardly placed on heels 1200 metres and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages. Held up rounding the final turn and then had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.</p> <p>ANOTHER GIRL (T Thornton) – Had to be steadied when improving into restricted room approaching the 1200 metres. Hampered 900 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>SAFFRON LADY (C Lammas) – Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages on a moderate pace. Hampered 1200 metres and 600 metres when awkwardly placed.</p> <p>LUCKY SWEEP (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously on a moderate pace through the middle stages. Hampered passing the 600 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of JULIUS.</p> <p>BRAKBAR (M Coleman) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LUPELANI (K McCulloch) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight and then was then held up from near the 200 metres.</p> <p>TERRIFIQUE (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance of TERRIFIQUE Rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had hung out when placed under pressure in the final straight and had failed to respond as anticipated. TERRIFIQUE underwent a post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 8	Weekend Herald 1200
<p>HARDCASE (D Johnson) – Dislodged Rider D Johnson enroute to the barrier and was quickly recaptured. HARDCASE was declared fit to race after undergoing a veterinary examination.</p> <p>LET THEM TALK (S Collett) – Slow away.</p> <p>MAUI MISS (M Coleman) – Stumbled jumping away shifting out hampering BARABAS.</p> <p>BARABAS (K McCulloch) – Hampered leaving barriers.</p> <p>DOUGIE (S Spratt) – Began a little awkwardly.</p> <p>MAKARIOS (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>VEEARMA (M Du Plessis) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	

ROYAL FASHION (M McNab) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

TATTERS (O Bosson) – Inclined to lay out under pressure in the final 150 metres.

Race 9

The New Zealand Herald Super Sport 2100

WHITE DIAMOND (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded and hampered when improving inside heels 200 metres.

KINGS DAUGHTER (A Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SIMPLICITY (M Du Plessis) – Raced in restricted room near the 1850 metres.

STAR ELLA (A Jones) – Raced in restricted room near the 1850 metres. Crowded passing the 200 metres and hampered having to be steadied for a distance to the inside of SON TAARI which shifted in and away from WHITE DIAMOND which had shifted in when improving on to the heels of RIVERDEEP which shifted in simultaneously.

SON TAARI (K McCulloch) – Crowded 200 metres and hampered.

THE CHIEF (A Schwerin) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages shifting wide when making the bend near the 1700 metres. Continued to race keenly through the middle stages.

ZACADA (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover until near the 1300 metres.

IRISH MIST (S Spratt) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.
