Canterbury Jockey Club – Wednesday, 9 November 2016 Race 8 – NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PREMIER R65 (1200m) An appeal lodged by apprentice jockey K Mudhoo against the severity of the four riding day penalty imposed by the Raceday Judicial Committee was heard today at 10.30 am. After hearing all relevant submissions the appointed Appeals

Tribunal dismissed the appeal reserving their decision as to costs.

Race 1	MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS PREMIER (1400m)			
BROWN GIRL (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

LUKANDER	(M Dee) – Slow to begin.			

STAR OF GREENBEEL (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground, over raced middle stages having to be firmly restrained for a distance to avoid heels passing the 800 metres.

OPIHI JADE (L Hemi) – Crowded at start losing ground.

SAN MICHELE (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LINDIS PASS (C Barnes) – Steadied and shifted ground outwards to avoid the heels of **LANE FROST** passing the 700 metres.

FLICKA OF GOLD (R Hannam) – Steadied passing the 700 metres. Crowded 400 metres.

MONTOYA STAR (K Mudhoo) – Bumped at 700 metres.

VELOCIOUS SATIN (K Williams) – Shifted outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 400 metres crowding **HANDSOME DAX** onto **FLICKA OF GOLD**. K Williams was advised to exercise greater care. Lay out making contact with **LANE FROST** near the 250 metres then shifted back inwards when being corrected with the rider dropping her right rein.

MAHER MOMENT (S Wynne) – Shifted outwards when being steadied to avoid the heels of **KEARNEY** near the 800 metres inconveniencing **LANE FROST**.

LANE FROST (T Moseley) - Inconvenienced 800 metres, bumped 250 metres.

HANDSOME DAX (R Cuneen) – Crowded 400 metres.

Race 2THE RECRUITMENT NETWORK PREMIER (2500m)KEEP THE COURAGE (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin, raced wide from the 1600 metres.

SPEEDY JAX (J Lowry) – Hampered at the start.

LA NOUVELLE VAGUE (D Johnson) – Raced keenly early stages before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1600 metres.

THIRD TIME LUCKY (K McCulloch) – Raced keenly early stages having to be steadied off heels passing the 2000 metres then continued to over race for a distance.

FRANCIS DRAKE (C Grylls) – Briefly placed in restricted room passing the 500 metres.

Race 3

VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS PREMIER (1800m)

ANOTHER COUP (K McCulloch) – Slow to begin, lay inwards throughout final straight being steadied passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of RUBY ROW which shifted outwards abruptly at this point.

SANASAR (C Johnson) – Over raced early stages, lay out making slight contact with the hind quarters of IRISH CALL near the 400 metres.

IRISH CALL (S Wynne) – Over raced early stages.

RUBY ROW (R Myers) – Firmly restrained to avoid the heels of MONTRACHET which was being steadied near the 1600 metres and as a result RUBY ROW dropped back onto OUR BEE JAY which was hampered. Also crowded in this incident was COLONEL KEV. RUBY ROW then commenced to over race.

OUR BEE JAY (D Johnson) – Hampered 1600 metres.

KOLONEL KEV (J Riddell) – Crowded 1600 metres. When questioned regarding performance, the rider was unable to offer any excuses. Trainer L Latta advised she would be giving consideration to adding a tongue tie for its next start.

Race 4 MOHUA PREMIER OPEN (1400m)

NASHVILLE (R Myers) - Slow to begin, bumped 800 metres.

MAYBE MIAMI (C Johnson) - Raced fiercely early stages and wide throughout.

EL CHICO (S Wynne) – Bumped with NASHVILLE 800 metres, bumped with LOCHAN ORA near the 300 metres.

LOCHAN ORA (K Kalychurun) – Bumped with EL CHICO near the 300 metres.

Race 5 BARNESWOOD FARM WELCOME STAKES (1000m)

FUNNY FACE (S Collett) – Blundered start.

SEIRIOS (L Innes) – Blundered leaving the barriers.

KIWI IDA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly early stages.

SENSEI (S Wynne) – Over raced early stages and had to be steadied passing the 700 metres, raced greenly concluding stages. Rider reported that the colt had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

LADY ROSSA (D Johnson) – Shifted inwards briefly crowding LET HER RIP RILEY and SEIRIOS passing the 800 metres.

LET HER RIP RILEY (D Hirini) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained off the heels of GILHOOLIE near the 800 metres.

PROM QUEEN (A Collett) – Lay inwards in the final straight.

Race 6 SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1600m)

PAT IN BRACKETS (J Riddell) – Raced keenly through the middle stages having to be steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres.

BOOTS 'N' ALL (D Johnson) – Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 1000 metres, then further inconvenienced when KIRINA BELLE (M McCulloch) shifted inwards when not fully clear. **K McCulloch** was advised to exercise greater care.

FLYING IBIS (C Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight.

BOXACHOCOLATES (R Myers) – When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had been forced to work early but had nevertheless been disappointing when failing to finish the race off in the final straight and in her opinion may not have backed up from its first day run.

Race 7 gavelhouse.com 44TH NZ 1000 GUINEAS (1600m)

GLASS SLIPPER (L Innes) – Slow to begin and further hampered when MYSTERY SHOW shifted outwards abruptly at the start. Rider advised that the filly did not feel comfortable in the prevailing track conditions. GLASS SLIPPER required veterinary attention post-race as it was displaying a poor rate of recovery and was found to be in a fatigued condition.

MYSTERY SHOW (M Du Plessis) - Raced keenly early stages

LA DIOSA (R Cuneen) – Had to be steadied off heels passing the 700 metres. **R Cuneen** admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used the whip excessively prior to the 200 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500. When pulling up rider R Cuneen was dislodged but uninjured.

ROYAL FASHION (C Grylls) – Steadied away from the heels of MIDNIGHT GOSSIP (C Johnson) which shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 500 metres. **C Johnson** was issued with a warning.

ZIGWIG (T Moseley) – Raced in restricted room for several strides passing the 200 metres.

Race 8 AVON CITY FORD WUHAN JOCKEY CLUB TROPHY PREMIER (2000m)

OUR MADONNA (S Wynne) – Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding TARIHIRA which lost ground.

TARIHIRA (D Johnson) – Crowded start losing ground.

GOTTAGETMYWOOHOO (C Barnes) - Over raced early stages and raced wide throughout,

QUEEN SERENE (C Johnson) – Raced keenly early stages.

ALYTH (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly early and middle stages.

BLUE PRINT (A Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

GARFUNKEL (K McCulloch) – Placed in restricted room passing the 700 metres.

ALMOST COURT (L Innes) – When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had not felt comfortable in today's conditions and may not have backed up from its first day run.

Race 9 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO 153RD NEW ZEALAND CUP (3200m)

The start was officially delayed one minute on TAB request and further delayed due to loading issues behind the barriers.

KINGS PAL (M Dee) – Crowded at the start and got back.

NYMPH MONTE (D Johnson) – Shifted inwards abruptly at the start making heavy contact with BEE TEE JUNIOR and blundering then commencing to over race through the early and middle stages. Further restrained to avoid the heels of ZENTANGLE near the 2500 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had detrimentally affected its chances by failing to settle today.

ZENTANGLE (L Innes) – Raced wide and keenly early stages.

PRINCESS BROOK (C Johnson) – Raced keenly early stages, over raced through the straight on the first occasion on a moderate tempo.

BEE TEE JUNIOR (A Collett) – Over raced through the straight on the first occasion on a moderate tempo.

MISS THREE STARS (S Wynne) – Over raced through the straight on the first occasion on a moderate tempo.

SUREASYOUWEREBORN (K Williams) – Raced keenly early stages, placed in restricted room at the 2800 metres, gave ground from the 1000 metres and did not complete the race. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia. Co-trainer B Blatch was advised that SUREASYOUWEREBORN is required to trial satisfactorily and provide an appropriate veterinary certificate of fitness prior to racing again. Rider K Williams was of the opinion that the mare may have choked down.

KAHARAU (T Moseley) – Raced in restricted room to the inside of MOTORBOAT MIKE (R Cuneen) near the 2800 metres. Required post race veterinary treatment for mild colic symptoms.

PUMP UP THE VOLUME (K McCulloch) – Shifted inwards under pressure final stages crowding IMPERIUM which had to steady just short of the finish.

IMPERIUM (M Du Plessis) – Crowded 30 metres and had to steady.

S Collett admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used the whip excessively on her mount **DELACROIX** prior to the 200 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$400.

Race 10 LAMING RACING PREMIER (1400m)

The start was officially delayed 5 minutes on TAB request.

TANTELLA (G Jogoo) – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

TIARA CONCERTO (M Du Plessis) - Slow to begin.

DONTPOKETHETIGER (S Wynne) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Rider reported that the filly had felt indifferent in its action during the running. Stewards will follow up the condition of the filly with trainer P Rudkin in coming days.

BUSHIDO (C Johnson) – Over raced early stages.

MULBERRY (R Cuneen) – Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight until obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

Following the race a protest was lodged by the connections of 3rd placed horse **PINZALOT** alleging interference by the 2nd placed horse **MULBERRY** inside the final 100 metres. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

R Cuneen - admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount **MULBERRY** to shift outwards causing severe interference to PINZALOT near the 50 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today until the conclusion of racing on Friday 2 December, 3 riding days.

Race 11 NZ TAX REFUNDS PREMIER (1200m)

MAXSSISTAR was a late scratching at 4.10 pm on veterinary advice after requiring treatment for abrasions to both hind legs.

The start was officially delayed 5 minutes on TAB request.

BIG KAHUNA (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly.

BONAPARTE (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly.

WILLIAM WALLACE (R Myers) - Slow to begin.

OPIHI RANGER (R Black) – Slow to begin.

MR CONDUCTOR (S Collett) – Over raced early to middle stages becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of TIEBREAKER near the 800 metres, steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DAIFUKU near the 250 metres.

DYNAMIC (K Mudhoo) – Held up early in the final straight before improving into a marginal run between UNCONQUERED and MR CONDUCTOR near the 350 metres, with MR CONDUCTOR then having to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of DAIFUKU near the 250 metres.

UNCONQUERED (C Grylls) - Crowded and had to steady passing the 200 metres.
