GENERAL:

<p>C Dell advised stewards that he was unwell and would not be attending today's meeting. C Dell is to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.</p> <p>The start of Race 8 was delayed due to the fall in Race 7 with the new start time being 5.02pm.</p>

SUPPLEMENTARY:

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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WANGANUI MOTORS (2200 metres)
<p>SCOOTA KING (N Teeluck) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after dislodging rider on route to start and was cleared to start. N Teeluck was also uninjured. Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TRISHA LEA (D Bradley) – slow to begin. DEVI commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres with TRISHA LEA having to be firmly restrained before clipping a heel of that runner and blundering. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have a minor laceration in the left nostril and an abrasion on the left hind leg.</p> <p>ROCFIVE (D Turner) – made the bend awkwardly near the 1750 metres.</p>	

DEVI (A Chan) - raced wide in the early stages. Commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer S Rainford advised Stewards that DEVI would now be sent for a spell.

RHIANNON (T Johnson) - lay out entering the final straight.

Race 2 | **WAVERLEY HARVESTING/BIG BLADE (2200 metres)**

BENNIES APPROVAL (J Parkes) - jumped out at the start hampering **BEAU ZED** which settled back. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 150 metres to the inside of **SIR MANAWA** which was forced inwards by **SAKURA** (A Chan). A Chan was advised to exercise care.

ZEDBEE (R Hannam) - began awkwardly losing ground.

SIR MANAWA (S MacNab) – held up rounding the final bend and shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with **SAKURA** near the 200 metres.

DOCTOR FOX (V Gatu) – **CRAFTY LADY** (H Andrew) shifted out when placed under pressure passing the 150 metres with **DOCTOR FOX** having to be steadied when weakening. H Andrew was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).

BEAU ZED (L Hemi) – hampered start losing ground.

SAKURA (A Chan) – was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 800 metres to the inside of **BENNIES APPROVAL** (J Parkes) which shifted in when not fully clear. J Parkes was advised to exercise care.

Race 3 | **TOTAL TRANSPORT/R & L FREIGHT (1400 metres)**

JUST YOU (R Hannam) – began awkwardly and settled back.

ANGELICA ROX (T Johnson) – made the bend near the 1150 metres awkwardly losing ground.

SHINDANO (E Farr) – was held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.

HOT SPOT (R Myers) – was held up rounding the bend and had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until near the 200 metres.

Race 4 | **WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS (1650 metres)**

FOREIGNER (J Riddell) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious in the barriers and was cleared to start.

MASTER COURTSMAN (D Turner) – slow to begin.

RAWINIA (R Goldsbury) - began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced when being restrained approaching the 1100 metres. Lay out entering the final straight making contact with **AHJAY**.

LUCQUIDE (H Andrew) – slow to begin.

AHJAY (S Collett) – approaching the 1500 metres commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained. Had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on heels near the 1100 metres. Forced wider 250 metres.

LIGHT EM UP (R Myers) – attempted to improve into a marginal run near the 150 metres to the outside of **FOREIGNER** which shifted out slightly and to the inside of **LUCQUIDE** which lay in when contacted by **LIGHT EM UP**. As a result **LIGHT EM UP** became awkwardly placed on the heels of **FOREIGNER** having to be firmly restrained and losing ground.

Race 5	CR GRACE (1650 metres)
<p>MISSY MOO (S Collett) – slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance, Rider S Collett advised Stewards that after being slow to begin and settling at the rear of the field the mare was unable to make any ground over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>I SUGGEST (T Johnson) – slow to begin. Became awkwardly placed on heels on the tiring ZEDSATIONAL approaching the 400 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p>CARNABY (R Myers) – slow to begin. Raced wide early and middle stages.</p> <p>ZEDSATIONAL (N Teeluck) - raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	
Race 6	STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP WAVERLEY CUP (2200 metres)
<p>ALINKO PRINCE (J Parkes) - shifted out on jumping away, hampering FREDRICK WILLIAM and OUR GAZZA which both settled back.</p> <p>OUR GAZZA (D Turner) – underwent pre-race veterinary examination after dislodging its rider in the preliminary and was cleared to start. Hampered start losing ground. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FREDRICK WILLIAM (R Hannam) – hampered start losing ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>ALFIE DEE (N Teeluck) – began awkwardly.</p> <p>GUESS WHAT (S Collett) – When questioned regarding the performance, Rider S Collett advised Stewards that the gelding had not been entirely suited by today’s track conditions.</p>	
Race 7	TOM ANDREWS CONTRACTING/THE BOLD ONE @ GW STUD (1200 metres)
<p>ITELLYOUNETHING (H Andrew) – clipped a heel dislodging rider near the 750 metres. An investigation was opened and adjourned into the incident until riders involved are able to be questioned. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any abnormality. H Andrew was airlifted to hospital for further assessment.</p> <p>INCOGNITO (S McKay) - heavily contacted by ITELLOUNETHING which shifted out sharply when blundering, with S McKay becoming unbalanced and being dislodged. S McKay was checked by St John paramedics and cleared to ride in the last.</p> <p>BROTHER ONE (D Bradley) – hampered by fallen rider near the 750 metres.</p> <p>ROCK NOIR (A Chan) – severely hampered by the riderless ITELLOUNETHING near the 750 metres, having to be firmly restrained.</p> <p>INTA STAR (M Tanaka) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious behind the barriers and was cleared to start. Was severely hampered by the riderless INCOGNITO and was forced wider on the track. Was not persevered with for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>JUSTA SMALL RANSOM (T Johnson) – was slow to begin. Severely hampered when avoiding fallen riders near the 750 metres, running wide.</p>	

A CHAN (ROCK NOIR) – was charged under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) in that he used his whip excessively on his mount ROCK NOIR prior to the 200 metres. Due to the unavailability of A Chan the Judicial Committee adjourned the hearing to a date to be fixed.

Race 8 | **TONY WILSON LIVESTOCK (1200 metres)**

LEWIS CAROLL (S McKay) – lay in when under pressure in the final straight.

WAFER (R Myers) – momentarily steadied when LEWIS CAROLL (S McKay) shifted in under pressure when marginally clear, then shifted ground outwards near the 75 metres. S McKay was advised to exercise care and that he must make a greater effort to straighten his mount when in similar circumstances. Connections of the second placed WAFER viewed video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

BLACK SAV (K McCulloch) – when questioned regarding the performance Rider K McCulloch advised stewards that in her opinion the mare is now looking for a step up in distance.

MISS PERCYNALLITY (S Collett) – when questioned regarding the performance Rider S Collett advised stewards that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.
