PLIMMER (S McKay) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	
GUY FOX (K McCulloch) – Crowded start losing ground.	
TYRION (M Du Plessis) – Crowded start losing ground.	

<p>FLASH AS (M Hills) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied away from the heels of NO LOITERING (A Jones) which shifted inwards near the 1700 metres when not fully clear. A Jones was advised to exercise more care. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SMILING ASSASSIN (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early and middle stages getting its head up.</p> <p>LORD SIBFORD (S Weatherley) – Raced three wide without cover.</p>	
Race 2	ADVANCED STORAGE 1000
<p>FELICE’S DREAM (S McKay) – began awkwardly losing ground (4L).</p> <p>THELMA (C Lammas) – Lay out in the early stages making the first turn near the 800 metres awkwardly.</p>	
Race 3	STARLIGHT CINEMA CENTRE 1200
<p>T Thornton – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount STAND FIRM to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of I’M MURPHY which was crowded and checked near the 800 metres losing ground. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Ms Thornton’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 3 January 2017 until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 12 January 2017, 4 riding days.</p> <p>I’M MURPHY (S Weatherley) – Crowded and checked 800 metres.</p> <p>CUT TO THE CHASE (M Cameron) – Commenced to over-race for a distance near the 900 metres.</p> <p>MR DAVINCI (E Farr) – Made bend near the 800 metres awkwardly running wide.</p> <p>KICKATINALONG (C Grylls) – Rider dropped whip near the 175 metres.</p>	
Race 4	THE KIRTON SPRINT
<p>MASSOFDASH (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	GRAEME THOMSON ANTIQUE JEWELLERY 1400
<p>UP ‘N’ ROLLING (S McKay) – Jumped away awkwardly. Briefly steadied to avoid heels near the 500 metres.</p> <p>LETIZIA (K McCulloch) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>HEAVENLY GOLD (R Elliot) – Inconvenienced shortly after leaving the barriers when SUFFICIENT FUNDS shifted outwards. Had to be steadied to avoid heels 700 metres.</p> <p>SHE’S A RIPPER (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover and was inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages. Bumped 300 metres.</p> <p>DREAMS OF PARIS (S Weatherley) – Steadied off heels near the 700 metres going back onto HEAVENLY GOLD which also then had to be steadied.</p> <p>SWEET CHASTITY (D Johnson) – Made contact with SHE’S A RIPPER when held up near the 300 metres then shifting inwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p>CHOUX LACE (A Jones) – Held up for a short distance approaching the 200 metres.</p>

ROC ME - Declared a late scratching at 4pm on veterinary advice after being injured in the tie-ups when being saddled.

WORLDCLASS (K McCulloch) – Slow away.

SHE IS STRYKING (D Johnson) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare had not been suited by the firm nature of today's track.

STRAIGHT SETS (E Farr) – Had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 950 metres.

SAVE THE STARS (C Grylls) – Was struck on the head by the whip of M Du Plessis (PRINCESS KERERU) near the 200 metres.
