SUPPLEMENTARY:

<u>Auckland Racing Club – 29 December 2016</u> Race 3 – Canvas Magazine 1200 MY GIDDY AUNT – Co trainer G Thomas reported that veterinary tests on return to his stable had found the mare to be suffering from a throat infection and has been treated accordingly.
<u>Auckland racing Club – Sunday 1 January 2017</u> Race 8 – Laser Plumbing Te Puke City of Auckland Cup FANATIC – Co-trainer Mr G Sanders reported that the mare had suffered from cardiac arrhythmia and had received veterinary treatment on return to his stable. The appropriate veterinary clearance is now required prior to FANATIC racing again.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTSHORE RETAIL FIT OUTS 1400
STOLEN DANCE (S Weatherley) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Briefly contact concluding stages.	
PACKING TYCOON (C Grylls) – Shifted out over the concluding stages making brief contact with STOLEN DANCE .	
Race 2	THE WEEKEND SUN 1300
DARE TO DREAM (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to race ungenerously passing the 1000 metres making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres crowding TIGHTLIGN , and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages. Bled during the running which was confirmed after undergoing a veterinary examination, and is now subject to a three month stand down from racing in New Zealand, and a two month stand down from track work, and will require a veterinary certificate prior to racing or trialing. The connections indicated that the mare is now likely to be retired.	
ELUSIVE EMPIRE (C Grylls) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.	
LOVE THE VIEW (A Collett) – Was slow to begin.	
TUDEE (S Collett) – Made contact soon after leaving the barrier and was steadied.	
SHARP PROPOSITION (C Lammas) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Hampered 25 metres.	
MOTUMAN (D Prastiyou) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
BRONNY'S LAD (S Spratt) – Was crowded and steadied passing the 75 metres by ALERIA (L Innes) which had improved into a run to the outside of MONRECOUR which had shifted out despite the efforts of its rider. ALERIA continued to shift away from MONRECOUR hampering SHARP PROPOSITION near the 25 metres. L Innes was advised he must take corrective action as soon as practicable.	
ALERIA (L Innes) – Shifted out to obtain clear running 100 metres then dictated out.	
TIGHTLIGN (D Johnson) – Crowded 900 metres. Inconvenienced passing the 50 metres having to shift ground.	
Race 3	GREERS GASTRO BAR GREERTON 1300
FREEMAN (S Collett) – Hampered leaving the barriers when FREDDY MAC shifted outwards. Was crowded to the inside of DIAMAIN (C Lammas) which shifted in when not fully clear passing the 1200 metres, with FREEMAN having to steady losing ground as a result. C Lammas was severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised a warning would be placed on his record.	
SAILING (V Gatu) – Was slow away.	
FREDDY MAC (J Waddell) – Raced keenly when being steadied in the middle stages.	
SHE'S FLOSSIE (A Jones) – Raced wide without cover.	
LA VARRA (T Thornton) – Inconvenienced approaching the 250 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SAILING (V Gatu) which shifted out under pressure. V Gatu was advised she must exercise greater care.	
SPEEWAH (S McKay) – Shifted in passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.	

Race 4	TASTE OF ASIA MOUNT MAUNGANUI 1300
<p>RUNNING SCARED (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SAINT LUCIA (K McCulloch) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and was steadied.</p> <p>AMBITIOUS WINNER (M Coleman) – Raced wide without cover. Commenced to give ground passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight. Rider M Coleman advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination found the gelding to be lame in the right foreleg. Co-trainer Mr A Forsman advised that the gelding would be subjected to further veterinary tests on return to their stable, and would be spelled.</p> <p>THATSFORSURE (L Innes) – Was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight.</p> <p>GETALONGHOME CINDY (A Schwerin) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>BRILLIANT MAGIC (S Weatherley) – Lay out when making the bend.</p>	

Race 5	ROB PINNY RAY WHITE COMMERCIAL 2100
<p>ZIFFEL (L Innes) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>SHACKELTONS EDGE (C Lammas) – Was slow away.</p> <p>PRINCESS DILLON (S McKay) – Commenced to race ungenerously in the early stages making the bend awkwardly passing the 1700 metres, running wide and racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race. PRINCESS DILLON made the final bend awkwardly running wider.</p> <p>ITSABIRD (E Farr) – Improved into a marginal run passing the 400 metres and was steadied.</p> <p>EPAE ROAD (V Colgan) – Was held up rounding the final bend, and could not obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>BOYDY (T Thornton) – Shifted in across heels over the concluding stages inconveniencing SUFFICE TO SAY which was briefly steadied. T Thornton was advised she must exercise greater care.</p> <p>SUFFICE TO SAY (R Elliot) – Crowded concluding stages.</p> <p>SORRELL (S Weatherley) – Was held up rounding the final bend, and then had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p>	

Race 6	TAURANGA A & P LIFESTYLE SHOW SUNDAY JAN 15TH 2100
<p>DOWNTON ABBEY (V Colgan) – Jumped away awkwardly. Had to steady approaching the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on heels. DOWNTON ABBEY appeared to shy passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>BLUE FLAG (M Coleman) – Was badly hampered soon after the start when MASTER POET shifted in abruptly with BLUE FLAG losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider M Coleman could offer no excuses. Co-trainer Mr A Forsman advised that the mare was now likely to be retired from racing.</p> <p>ROAD TRIP (K McCulloch) – Was placed in restricted room when runners on either side shifted ground shortly after the start, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider K McCulloch advised the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.</p>	

SOLEADO (T Thornton) - Raced in restricted room for a distance shortly after the start to the inside of MASTER POET which shifted in slightly. Contributing was outward movement from RODMAR. Apprentice rider D Danis was advised to exercise greater care. Raced wide until near the 1400 metres.

LUSTROUS (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room for a distance shortly after the start.

IRINA (M Du Plessis) – Commenced to over-race when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of DOWNTON ABBEY (V Colgan) which steadied when shifting in near the 1800 metres. V Colgan was advised to exercise greater care.

RODMAR (S McKay) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1800 metres.

MANDALAY (D Johnson) – Raced wide before improving forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 800 metres.

HEEZNOT (A Collett) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 700 metres and was steadied. Was held up rounding the final turn shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

Race 7	NEW WORLD SUMMER CUP
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KEEP ON COMING (S Weatherley) – Was slow to begin.

SLICE OF CAKE (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TEMPLE TIGER (M Hills) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer Mr G Hennessy advised that the addition of blinkers today had been of benefit as they were able to ride the gelding more positively.

MARTINIZ SPECIAL (O Bosson) – Was hampered passing the 400 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

SLEEK SECRET (D Johnson) – Was eased down by its rider from near the 100 metres with rider D Johnson reporting the mare had felt indifferent in its action. SLEEK SECRET underwent a subsequent post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality with the mare to undergo further veterinary tests on return to its stable.

Race 8	TAURANGA HARDWARE AND PLUMBING 1600
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COTE D'OR (D Johnson) – Was slow to begin. Had to shift out to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

TWINKLES (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

BAMURRU (K McCulloch) – Raced wide without cover.

VITESSE (A Collett) – Shifted wide passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

REAL SAVVY (S Weatherley) – Was briefly steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 350 metres.

PREETHA VARMA (R Elliot) – Was crowded approaching the 300 metres to the inside of BEAR (C Grylls) which shifted in when C Grylls was changing his whip from the left to right hand. C Grylls was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 9	FASHION IN THE FIELD JAPAN CUP DAY MARCH 25TH 1600
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PIERIAN SPRING (R Elliot) – Was slow to begin.

THOUGHTFUL (S McKay) – Was slow to begin. Crowded 300 metres.

EARTH SKY (D Johnson) – Raced greenly in the early stages making contact with the running rail passing the 1000 metres.

ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE (M McNab) – Had to be steadied when improving into restricted room approaching the 400 metres. ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE was then held up for a distance, and then hampered approaching the 300 metres by THOUGHTFUL which was dictated inwards by CHARLES ROAD which lay in when placed under pressure. ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE was then held up for a distance.

ZUMA (J Waddell) – Lay out when placed under pressure when rider J Waddell changed his whip to the left hand passing the 300 metres and shifted out abruptly forcing MENTAL TELEPATHY out on to O'ANGEL which was hampered losing ground. Contributing was inward movement from CHARLES ROAD which continued to race greenly when laying in under pressure in the final straight.

MENTAL TELEPATHY (M Coleman) – Crowded 300 metres.

CHARLES ROAD (C Grylls) – Lay in when placed under pressure final straight, racing greenly.

REFINED (D Danis) – Crowded passing the 150 metres by TE TAIKA which shifted in when placed under pressure. J Jago was advised he must exercise greater care.
