RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SOUTHERN RANGITIKEI VETERINARY SERVICES PREMIER
SMASHING (C Lammas) – was slow away but recovered quickly to lead after 200 metres.	
WHISPERING (A Chan) – raced keenly in the early stages. Rider could offer no excuses for the run. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed nothing amiss.	
CLUBS CHOICE (A Collett) – lay in under pressure passing the 400 metres.	
McLAREN (S O'Malley) – rider advised of obligations with regard to whip use on a horse out of contention.	
Race 2	MERIAL ANCARE PREMIER
JUST A LOVER (M Hills) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
IRISH CALL (S McKay) – raced keenly in the early stages.	

TWOZNOTENOUGH (A Chan) – inclined to lay in down the final straight.

KOLONEL KEV (J Riddell) – awkwardly away.

Race 3	NORBROOK LABORATORIES 3YO PREMIER

BRING TO THE BLOCK (L Hemi) – awkwardly away.

MCPHOEBE (M du Plessis) – awkwardly away.

SWEEPSTAKE (D Hirini) – shifted wider on the home turn and bumped when STEPHENSTHILS improved to its inside and then again approaching the 400 metres when MCPHOEBE also improved to the inside. Over-raced in the early and middle stages and hung throughout.

XCESSORY (A Collett) – Led early before fading in the home straight. Rider could offer no excuses.

HEISENBERG (H Tinsley) – unable to claim clear running in the home straight between the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

Race 4	THE RT. HON. WINSTON PETERS CUP

SLIMLINE (A Collett) – vetted behind the barrier after making contact with the fence leaving the birdcage. Disappointed for a run passing the 400 metres having to change ground.

SATIN RIDGE (R Goldsbury) – slow away

DAL DANTRIX (M Hills) – slow away.

CATWOMANDU (A Chan) – rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after WILLS ROAD had to steady near the 1000 metres when being crossed by CATWOMANDU. Hampered also in this incident was CHARLESTOWN which was racing adjacent to the running rail and to the inside of WILLS ROAD. A Chan was issued with a warning.

WILLS ROAD (R Myers) – had to steady off heels approaching the 1000 metres.

PROSECCO (D Hirini) – rolled in under pressure near the 100 metres taking the line of running of ALL CHARM necessitating that runner having to change ground. D Hirini was issued with a warning.

ALL CHARM (S McKay) – had to check off heels approaching the 100 metres shifting to the outside to ensure a clear run to the line.

Race 5	CENTRAL ITM PREMIER

PROFILE (R Myers) – slow away.

CHARMONT (J Parkes) - raced keenly early.

SHADOW FOX – exhibited signs of stress on cooling down after the race and required veterinary attention.

Race 6	BJW MOTORS PREMIER

ROCK ON (J Riddell) – slow away. Over-raced early for a short distance.

ZED LPPELIN (C Lammas) – bumped at the start when DR WATSON jumped outwards at start.

BLACK LACE (M du Plessis) – over-raced in middle stages.

DR WATSON (S Collett) – caught wide early and allowed to roll forward to sit outside leader passing 1200 metre.

SANJARA (M Tanaka) – unable to find clear running for the entire straight going to the line untested as a result.

GOBSTOPPER (S Weatherly) – after over-racing in the early and middle stages and then three-wide around the final bend, the gelding compounded shortly after turning for home finishing some distance behind the remainder of a field. S Weatherly confirmed the gelding over raced and when placed under pressure had nothing to offer. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

SOPRAFFINA (R Myers) – held up passing the 500 metres.

HARE BAWL (D Bradley) - became awkwardly placed on heels in restricted room inside the final 100 metres when weakening and having to be steadied.

AMORATA (T Johnson) - awkwardly away. Over-raced in middle stages. Rounded the turn adjacent to the running rail before being angled wide to obtain clear running which eventuated inside the 100 metres

DOIKNOWYOU (J Waddell) – unable to obtain clear running until being angled outwards near the 100 metres.

Race 7	GALLAGHER MARTON CUP - Listed

JACKSSTAR (C Lammas) – bumped with KAIRANGA LAD at start and settled back.

ALINKO PRINCE (J Parkes) – raced three wide around the first bend.

SAMPSON (R Myers) – rider lost whip near the 300 metres.

BALHAM (M du Plessis) – unable to find clear running in the home straight until inside the final 100 metres.

KAIRANGA LAD (S Weatherly) - bumped with JACKSSTAR and settled back. Held up for a considerable distance in the home straight when an anticipated run did not eventuate and was sharply checked when racing up onto the heels of ANTONIO near the 200 metres.

ECHEZEAUX (R Myers) – unable to secure a clear passage early in the home straight, shifting across heels to obtain a run near the 200 metres. Crowded near the 100 metres when there was movement from ALINKO PRINCE (J Parkes) on the outside and JACKSSTAR (C Lammas) on the inner. Both J Parkes and C Lammas were requested to exercise greater care.

ALCALDESA (S McKay) – held up early into the home straight but when in the clear failed to finish the race off.

Race 8	SPREADING RURAL BULK PREMIER

DANDEEDEE (D Hirini) – slow away. Raced keenly approaching the 1000 metres.

AMARONE (S Collett) – slow away. Held up momentarily passing the 200 metres.

PASS IT ON (T Johnson) – three wide throughout

BEAUTIFUL MAN (R Hannam) – ran up onto heels near the 100 metres having to be angled out to gain clear running

near the 50 metres.

DREAM LOVER (M Hills) – had to be steadied near the finish when BEAUTIFUL MAN was angled out in search of a run.

A post-race veterinary inspection of CASAQUINMAN which finished last revealed nothing amiss. Trainer S Brown advised that he would be taking bloods from the gelding during the week and would report anything untoward from those tests to the Stewards.
