Trainer A Schumacher advised Stewards that on return to his stable it was found that KING COBRA had an elevated temperature which has recovered to normal following veterinary treatment.

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>JAKKALBERRY 1400</b>
<b>WAWRINKA</b> (R Elliot) – Was slow away.	
<b>MONGOLIAN WOLF</b> (M Cameron) – Was slow away.	
<b>MISS ELEGANTE</b> (S Spratt) – Clipped a heel and blundered shortly after jumping away when runners on either side shifted ground, and then raced ungenerously for a short distance.	
<b>STARSTRIPE</b> (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover until improving to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.	
<b>DELUXE EDITION</b> (D Danis) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
<b>BREAK MY STRIDE</b> (J Waddell) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BURTON CONSTRUCTION 1215</b>
<b>SAVAPAK</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with OUR BROCKSTER which had also began awkwardly. Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres before making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.	
<b>OUR BROCKSTER</b> (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Lay in when placed under pressure throughout the final straight.	
<b>READY TO ROMANCE</b> (S Spratt) – Lay out shortly after jumping away hampering ELETTRA, and then commenced to race ungenerously making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.	
<b>MISS EL DORADO</b> (S Weatherley) – Was slow away (3L). Was steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of OUR BROCKSTER which was laying in near the 750 metres.	
<b>ELETTRA</b> (C Grylls) – Hampered shortly after the start. Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres before making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.	
<b>RED SHEERAN</b> (E Farr) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>POUR IT ON</b> (A Collett) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 100 metres, and shifted out inconveniencing OUR BROCKSTER which was laying in.	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>CAMPBELLS INFRASTRUCTURE 1950</b>
<p><b>FLASH AS</b> (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting in hampering CHAMPAGNE TILLY which lost ground.</p> <p><b>SHACKELTONS EDGE</b> (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with EARTH SKY forcing that runner outwards making contact with the hind quarters of BEN FERRARRI which was crowded losing ground.</p> <p><b>BEN FERRARRI</b> (M Tanaka) – Was crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>SVILA DAMA</b> (S Spratt) – Was slow away.</p> <p><b>PRO FUMO</b> (I Musiolkova) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced for a short distance. <b>Rider I Musiolkova</b> was issued with a warning for failing to claim down to her published riding weight.</p> <p><b>BOYDY</b> (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>CHAMPAGNE TILLY</b> (A Collett) – Hampered start losing ground. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>MARSHAL</b> (M Du Plessis) – Was held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p><b>DUKE OF SUSSEX</b> (L Satherley) – Came together with MARSHAL passing the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>CONTESSA BELLE</b> (M McNab) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1950</b>
<p><b>WITHOUT QUESTION</b> (S Collett) – Was slow away, and then raced greenly through the early stages.</p> <p><b>MISS ELLAN VANNIN</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>COOL RUNNINGS</b> (S Weatherley) – Was crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Bumped wider passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>GOODIEGOODY</b> (K McCulloch) – Improved on to the heels of LONGFORD near the 1550 metres and blundered. Contributing was outward movement from SOSECRET which shifted out slightly when being steadied.</p> <p><b>SOSECRET</b> (M Cameron) – Shifted out slightly when being steadied near the 1550 metres.</p> <p><b>CHATEAU ROC</b> (J Riddell) – Was held up rounding the final bend having to shift ground inwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>MOTUMAN</b> (J Jago) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres making contact with COOL RUNNINGS which was forced wider. J Jago was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>LONGFORD</b> (C Grylls) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Connections advised the gelding had received superficial abrasions to the right hind leg.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>ARAWA PARK FOR YOUR FUNCTION 1215</b>
<p><b>WHY ME</b> (E Farr) – Blundered jumping away.</p> <p><b>CONQUERING KENNY</b> (D Johnson) – Was crowded on jumping away losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.</p>	

**STYLISH ACHIEVER** (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly, and then was further hampered by ENDEAN EXPRESS which shifted out shortly after jumping away. Raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the 900 metres.

**ENDEAN EXPRESS** (B Hutton) – Shifted out on jumping away. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**EPROUVEZ** (S Weatherley) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages, and got its head up near the 900 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**DUALIS** (T Wenn) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>POMARE ELECTRICAL 1400</b>

**STRAIGHT JACKET** (M Tanaka) – Stumbled badly on jumping away losing ground (2L).

**MR DAVINCI** (L Satherley) – Was slow away. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

**CUT TO THE CHASE** (A Collett) – Stumbled on jumping away.

**LA VARRA** (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**HOOPLA** (M Vance) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**NAKURU** (D Johnson) – Commenced to give ground early in the final straight, and was not persevered with over the final 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

**UNFAZED** (M McNab) – Had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running forcing GARDENIER wider.

**TORBA** (R Elliot) – Shifted out on jumping away.

**GOLD ALLURE** (K McCulloch) – Was crowded on jumping away losing ground.

**PRINCESS DAVONE** (O Bosson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**ABSOLUTE GOLD** (S Collett) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Was held up entering the final straight, and again over the concluding stages.

**YEARN** (K McCulloch) – Became fractious dislodging the rider prior to doing its preliminary, and after galloping a distance before being recaptured was declared a late scratching at 5.06 pm.

**APOLLO'S DAUGHTER** (S Spratt) – Crowded on jumping away having to be steadied losing ground.

**PATSY'S GIRL** (A Collett) – Commenced to race ungenerously making the 1200 metre bend awkwardly.

**AHYUM** (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously early and middle stages making the 800 metre bend awkwardly running wide.

**LUCKY DREAMER** (B Hutton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**O'PRINCESS** (A Schwerin) – Was held up behind the weakening SALT 'N' PEPPER near the 350 metres having to shift ground outwards to improve.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>MILLS REEF WINERY 1950</b>
<p><b>HIGHLY EXCESSIVE</b> (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>PARADISE ROCK</b> (O Bosson) – Raced three wide without cover until passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>CURIOUS</b> (R Elliot) – Was held up rounding the final bend, and again had to steady near the 100 metres when BAYMAX shifted out under pressure.</p> <p><b>VOXER</b> (M McNab) – Was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 200 metres.</p>
