Trainer J Bell advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of ROSSO CORSA in the days following being declared a non-runner in this race. It is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

Wellington Racing Club - 14 January 2017

Race 1 MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS PREMIER

Trainer A Schumacher advised Stewards that on return to his stable it was found that KING COBRA had an elevated temperature which has recovered to normal following veterinary treatment.

Race 2 WELLINGTON PROVEDORING 2YO

Trainer T Pike advised Stewards that HAUSSMANN has been sent for a spell following its performance in this race.

Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that ACQUILO has been sent for a brief spell following its performance in this race.

Race 4 STEPHEN DALLAS MEMORIAL PREMIER

Trainer H Bull advised Stewards that in the days following its performance on this race WILLIAM WALLACE underwent a veterinary examination which reveal the gelding to have pulled a muscle in his back. Mr Bull further advised that WILLIAM WALLACE would now be sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 JAKKALBERRY 1400

WAWRINKA (R Elliot) – Was slow away.

MONGOLIAN WOLF (M Cameron) – Was slow away.

MISS ELEGANTE (S Spratt) – Clipped a heel and blundered shortly after jumping away when runners on either side shifted ground, and then raced ungenerously for a short distance.

STARSTRIPE (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover until improving to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

DELUXE EDITION (D Danis) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BREAK MY STRIDE (J Waddell) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres.

Race 2 BURTON CONSTRUCTION 1215

SAVAPAK (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with OUR BROCKSTER which had also began awkwardly. Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres before making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

OUR BROCKSTER (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Lay in when placed under pressure throughout the final straight.

READY TO ROMANCE (S Spratt) – Lay out shortly after jumping away hampering ELETTRA, and then commenced to race ungenerously making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

MISS EL DORADO (S Weatherley) – Was slow away (3L). Was steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of OUR BROCKSTER which was laying in near the 750 metres.

ELETTRA (C Grylls) – Hampered shortly after the start. Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres before making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

RED SHEERAN (E Farr) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

POUR IT ON (A Collett) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 100 metres, and shifted out inconveniencing OUR BROCKSTER which was laying in.

Race 3 CAMPBELLS INFRASTRUCTURE 1950

FLASH AS (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting in hampering CHAMPAGNE TILLY which lost ground.

SHACKELTONS EDGE (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with EARTH SKY forcing that runner outwards making contact with the hind quarters of BEN FERRARRI which was crowded losing ground.

BEN FERRARRI (M Tanaka) – Was crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SVILA DAMA (S Spratt) – Was slow away.

PRO FUMO (I Musiolkova) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced for a short distance. **Rider I Musiolkova** was issued with a warning for failing to claim down to her published riding weight.

BOYDY (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

CHAMPAGNE TILLY (A Collett) – Hampered start losing ground. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MARSHAL (M Du Plessis) – Was held up rounding the final bend.

DUKE OF SUSSEX (L Satherley) – Came together with MARSHAL passing the 100 metres.

CONTESSA BELLE (M McNab) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 4 MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1950

WITHOUT QUESTION (S Collett) – Was slow away, and then raced greenly through the early stages.

MISS ELLAN VANNIN (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

COOL RUNNINGS (S Weatherley) – Was crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Bumped wider passing the 200 metres.

GOODIEGOODY (K McCulloch) – Improved on to the heels of LONGFORD near the 1550 metres and blundered. Contributing was outward movement from SOSECRET which shifted out slightly when being steadied.

SOSECRET (M Cameron) – Shifted out slightly when being steadied near the 1550 metres.

CHATEAU ROC (J Riddell) – Was held up rounding the final bend having to shift ground inwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

MOTUMAN (J Jago) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres making contact with COOL RUNNINGS which was forced wider. J Jago was advised to exercise greater care.

LONGFORD (C Grylls) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Connections advised the gelding had received superficial abrasions to the right hind leg.

Race 5 ARAWA PARK FOR YOUR FUNCTION 1215

WHY ME (E Farr) – Blundered jumping away.

CONQUERING KENNY (D Johnson) – Was crowded on jumping away losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

STYLISH ACHIEVER (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly, and then was further hampered by ENDEAN EXPRESS which shifted out shortly after jumping away. Raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the 900 metres.

ENDEAN EXPRESS (B Hutton) – Shifted out on jumping away. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EPROUVEZ (S Weatherley) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages, and got its head up near the 900 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

DUALIS (T Wenn) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 6 POMARE ELECTRICAL 1400

STRAIGHT JACKET (M Tanaka) – Stumbled badly on jumping away losing ground (2L).

MR DAVINCI (L Satherley) – Was slow away. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

CUT TO THE CHASE (A Collett) – Stumbled on jumping away.

LA VARRA (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

HOOPLA (M Vance) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

NAKURU (D Johnson) – Commenced to give ground early in the final straight, and was not persevered with over the final 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

UNFAZED (M McNab) – Had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running forcing GARDENIER wider.

Race 7 SYNCROFLEX 1400

TORBA (R Elliot) – Shifted out on jumping away.

GOLD ALLURE (K McCulloch) – Was crowded on jumping away losing ground.

PRINCESS DAVONE (O Bosson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ABSOLUTE GOLD (S Collett) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Was held up entering the final straight, and again over the concluding stages.

Race 8 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

YEARN (K McCulloch) – Became fractious dislodging the rider prior to doing its preliminary, and after galloping a distance before being recaptured was declared a late scratching at 5.06 pm.

APOLLO'S DAUGHTER (S Spratt) – Crowded on jumping away having to be steadied losing ground.

PATSYS GIRL (A Collett) – Commenced to race ungenerously making the 1200 metre bend awkwardly.

AHYUM (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously early and middle stages making the 800 metre bend awkwardly running wide.

LUCKY DREAMER (B Hutton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

O'PRINCESS (A Schwerin) – Was held up behind the weakening SALT 'N' PEPPER near the 350 metres having to shift ground outwards to improve.

Race 9 MILLS REEF WINERY 1950

HIGHLY EXCESSIVE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

PARADISE ROCK (O Bosson) – Raced three wide without cover until passing the 1200 metres.

CURIOUS (R Elliot) – Was held up rounding the final bend, and again had to steady near the 100 metres when BAYMAX shifted out under pressure.

VOXER (M McNab) – Was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 200 metres.
