Race 1	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600				
ROMANTIC MAID (M Du Plessis) – Was held up rounding the final turn, and then held up for clear running passing the					
300 metres shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.					
Race 2	PLUS 4 INSURANCE SOLUTIONS 1200				
RONDA (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly, and then commenced to over-race making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.					
When questioned rider C Lammas advised that when the filly was placed under pressure passing the 400 metres,					
failed to respond and was not persevered with from near the 350 metres, but was unable to offer any other reason.					
RONDA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to be mildly lame in the left foreleg.					

MELODY CELEBRE (E Farr) – Was slow away. **Rider E Farr** was fined \$400 by the Judicial Committee for using the whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres.

PINZALOT (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground, and shifted out under pressure in the final straight finishing wide on the track.

SIMPLY CLASSIC (A Jones) – Got its head up when being restrained off the heels of DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC passing the 900 metres which shifted in when only marginally clear.

DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC (O Bosson) – Shifted out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 3THE FRESH MARKET GATE PA SHOPPING CENTRE 2YO

LADY ROSSA (M Cameron) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact. Raced greenly throughout.

SUNRISE RUBY (K McCulloch) – Hampered leaving the barrier and steadied.

BARBELLO (D Hain) – Slow to begin.

AMAZING BANKER (C Grylls) – Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

LORD BUFFALO (T Thornton) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be lame in the left hind leg.

Race 4 CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE 1400

OUR KING SWAY (S McKay) – Slow away.

PACKING TYCOON (C Grylls) – Was held up early in the final straight until obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres.

MAKARSKA (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse with the mare undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 AZTECH SIGNS 2100

HEART BEAT (M Du Plessis) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages to the inside of VON TUNZELMAN which shifted in slightly under pressure.

REALTA (C Lammas) – Jumped away awkwardly, and then was placed in restricted room when ENDEAN ROSE shifted in shortly after the start.

FRANCIS DRAKE (E Farr) – Began awkwardly after being restless in the barrier. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages making brief contact with the running rail near the 1700 metres. Raced in restricted room early in the final straight.

VINCENT STREET (B R Jones) – Had to steady and shift out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1700 metres.

ZACADA (M Cameron) – Settled back in the early stages, and shifted out passing the 1200 metres when the pace steadied, and improved forward to lead passing the 800 metres.

VINEVALE (D Johnson) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 6 MICHAEL STEMMER BARRISTER AND SOLICITORS 1400

FREDDY MAC (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering THATSFORSURE which had to steady losing ground with FREDDY MAC continuing to shift out making contact with CALLIGRAPHY which became briefly unbalanced losing ground.

GETALONGHOME CINDY (M Hills) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering TE WAEWAE BAY which lost ground.

Race 7 C U AT THE PHOENIX ON THE STRAND 1600

HIFLYER (R Elliot) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay out early in the final straight making contact with PRINCE MAMBO.

Race 8 MILLS REEF WINERY AND RESTAURANT 1600

OUR SEQUOIA (A Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding CHANCERY out on to TWINKLES which became briefly unbalanced.

TWINKLES (S Collett) – Briefly crowded at the start. Commenced to over-race near the 1400 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance. Lay in under pressure early in the final straight, then commenced to lay out passing the 200 metres crowding OUR SEQUOIA which had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of TWINKLES passing the 100 metres. **Rider S Collett** was issued with a warning.

SORORIA (J Waddell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SEA OCTOPUS (T Thornton) – Lay in under pressure near the 350 metres crowding EVA GODIVA which had to briefly steady.

SHERIDAN (V Colgan) – Had to steady and shift in across the heels of TWINKLES near the 250 metres to obtain clear running.

KING KANE (M McNab) – When questioned regarding the performance rider M McNab could offer no tangible excuse. Co-trainer S Autridge undertook to report to Stewards anything that may become apparent in the ensuing days.
