<b>A Collett (BLOODSTREAM)</b> defended a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of SLY ROMANCE making heavy contact with that runner. After hearing all evidence and submissions the JCA found the charge proven and suspended Ms Collett's licence to ride from the close of racing on Sunday 29th January 2017 until the close of racing on Monday 6th Feb. 2017 (5 days)

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MURRAY CONTRACTORS</b>
<b>CLASS ABOVE</b> (J Parkes) – Awkwardly away bumping <b>LA PHYTA</b> and settled back.	

<b>ETHNEE</b> (K Smith) – Slow away.	
<b>CLASS ABOVE</b> (J Parkes) – Rider considered the gelding may appreciate more ground.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MCI &amp; ASSOCIATES / TARARUA CLUB</b>
<b>HANDFULL</b> (J Riddell) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Had to be straightened on several occasions in the home straight when racing greenly under pressure.	
<b>SALVINIA</b> (D Hirini) – Rider reported the mare may appreciate firmer going.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PRENTERS READY MIX CONCRETE</b>
<b>ROCK NOIR</b> (A Collett) - Slow away. Three-wide without cover throughout.	
<b>ACCLAIM</b> (H Tinsley) – Tended to lay in near the top of the straight when racing in tight quarters, having to be steadied.	
<b>SWISS ANGEL</b> (A Chan) – Shifted out near the 250 metres when shying away from the whip of the rider of DEEP BLUE.	
<b>COTTONEVA</b> (J Parkes) – Slow away. Lay in under pressure over the final 100 metres.	
<b>MIDNIGHT DUCHESS</b> (M Hills) – Rider reported the filly may have held its breath during the running.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>GOLDEN BAY CEMENT</b>
<b>ROSETTA</b> (K McCulloch) – Slow away.	
<b>OUR LUCK DRAGON</b> (S O'Malley) – Slow away.	
<b>FINAL STAND</b> (R Hannam) – Three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>RASCALLION</b> (S McKay) – Raced greenly down the back straight.	
<b>STAROSSA</b> (C Perrett) – Improved up onto heels passing the 600 metres and held up early in the home straight until gaining clear running passing the 300 metres.	
<b>FOXY POROTENE</b> (J Parkes) – Rider advised the mare was not suited to the Slow9 track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>TUI 'BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889'</b>
<b>RED SIERRA</b> (A Collett) – Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground and settled back.	
<b>ROLL THE GOLD</b> (M Hills) – Raced greenly when being restrained in the early stages. Lay in under pressure in the home straight dictating MY JOELENE inwards over the concluding stages.	
<b>MY JOELENE</b> (K McCulloch) – Dictated inwards over the concluding stages.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>PURPLE HAZE LAVENDER</b>
<b>PINSONELLA</b> (A Collett) – Bounded as the gates opened.	
<b>VENLA</b> (N Teeluck) - Awkwardly away. Gave ground quickly approaching the home turn. Connections advised the filly will be retired.	
<b>MY ISABELLA</b> (J Parkes) – Slow away. Forced over extra ground passing the winning post on the first occasion. Obligated to make its run wide round the final bend after being dictated wider on the track.	
<b>NAPOLEON</b> (K Smith) – Dictated wider passing the winning post on the first occasion. Very wide into the first turn.	
<b>KIT</b> (S McNab) - When being steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion, shifted out forcing EVENTIDE, HOLLYPOP, MY ISABELLA and NAPOLEAN over extra ground. Checked off the heels of the tiring VENLA near the 600 metres.	
<b>HOLLYPOP</b> (K McCulloch) – Forced wide passing the winning post on the first occasion.	

**EVENTIDE** (D Hirini) – Forced wide passing the winning post on the first occasion.

**DEEMICO** (R Myers) – Forced over extra ground passing the winning post on the first occasion. Held up passing the 800 metres. Shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

**ZED LEPPELIN** (J Parkes) – Awkwardly away. Raced erratically getting a long way out of its ground before settling in the run along the back straight.

**ALARINDA** (D Hirini) – Over raced past the winning post on the first occasion and had to be firmly restrained.

**EVADIR LA BALA** (S McNab) – Raced wide throughout.

**DR WATSON** (R Myers) – Awkwardly away. Shifted out under pressure short of the winning post when only marginally clear requiring **BELLA'S DELIGHT** to be steadied. R Myers was advised to exercise care and that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

**BELLA'S DELIGHT** (S Wynne) – Had to briefly steady prior to the finish.

**KAIRANGA LAD** (H Tinsley) – When questioned into the performance, H Tinsley could offer no excuses.
