Race 1	PUNTERS CHALLENGE APRIL 8 – ENTER NOW MAIDEN (1200m)
POWERBALL (R Cuneen) – Slow to begin.	
SZABO (T Comignaghi) – Shifted out on jumping contacting ZULIANI .	

CAPRI (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly, raced ungenerously for a short distance passing the 700 metres when being steadied off heels.

LOUVRES (D Prastiyou) – Hampered at the start, raced keenly in the early stages. Rider D Prastiyou reported that in his opinion the gelding would appreciate some easing in the track condition.

SMOKE 'EM WILSON (K Mudhoo) – Hampered at the start, contacted at the 150 metres.

SCOTSPIRIT (C Barnes) – Blundered shortly after the start, raced wide in the early stages.

DIORISSIMO (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages, steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 200 metres.

HOOFBEAT (C Johnson) – Lay out under pressure passing the 150 metres and made contact with **SMOKE 'EM WILSON** near the 100 metres.

ZULIANI (S Collett) – The rider reported that the gelding felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

HIGH PLAY (R Yatim) – Hampered at the start, lay outwards rounding the final bend.

CHANCES AGAIN (L Callaway) – Hampered at the start.

BLACK EYED SUSAN (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Rider C Barnes was attended to by St John Paramedics after sustaining a facial injury during the running and cleared to fulfil her remaining riding engagements.

HANS MAYAR (J Lowry) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

JUSTRUSH (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages and continued to over race for some distance passing the 1200 metres when steadied off heels.

SHARP ELLE (R Cuneen) – Raced keenly in the early stages, held up from the 600 metres until early in the home straight.

HEE'S OUR SECRET (T Moseley) – Got its head up on a number of occasions when over racing in the early stages, lay inwards near the 75 metres and became unbalanced when being steadied away from the heels of **NAKURU** making contact with **GLOSS**.

FENDALTON (A Jones) – Raced wide throughout.

CRYSTAL HARMONY (T Jonker) – Lay outwards passing the 800 metres, crowded when weakening passing the 400 metres when **WELCOME** was taken in by **COURTS KING**.

COURTS KING (G Jogoo) – Shifted inwards near the 400 metres. Apprentice rider **G Jogoo** was warned for careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d).

GLOSS (S Wynne) – Contacted near the 100 metres. Rider S Wynne reported that in her opinion the filly may appreciate a track with more moisture.

LOS CABOS (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance on entering the home straight.

<p>VOLCANO (A Collett) – Shifted out under a hard ride passing the 200 metres making contact with BOOTS ‘N’ ALL, continued to shift out near the 100 metres again making contact with BOOTS ‘N’ ALL. Rider A Collett was warned under Rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p>BOOTS ‘N’ ALL (S Wynne) – Shifted wider and contacted by VOLCANO in the home straight.</p>	
Race 5	SPEIGHT’S MID ALE RATING 65 (2000m)
<p>SMICHAEL (A Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CANTINA (S Collett) – Slow to begin, raced wide from the 1600 metres.</p> <p>GOTTAGETMYWOOHOO (T Moseley) – Steadied off heels passing the 1700 metres.</p> <p>TWILIGHT REBEL (L Callaway) – Inclined to lay out near the bend at the 1700 metres , over raced in the middle stages, raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>PERFECT SECRET (C Spittles) – Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>SHEZATOUCHA (G Jogoo) – Rider G Jogoo reported that in his opinion the mare may be better suited to a track with more give. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 6	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>PINSHARP (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly, eased down over the concluding stages. Rider S Wynne reported that the mare felt indifferent over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection showed signs of muscle tie up.</p> <p>MISS MIA (R Yatim) – Began awkwardly, blundered and was then further hampered.</p> <p>VICE MARSHALL (T Jonker) – Blundered on jumping.</p> <p>FERGIE (G Jogoo) – Shifted outwards on jumping and hampered STILL WATERS.</p> <p>STILL WATERS (A Collett) – Hampered at the start, held up near the 300 metres and shifted wider near the 200 metres hampering DE CHINE.</p> <p>SNIPARINDA (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SALU (L Callaway) – Checked and over raced when in restricted room near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>RAPID RISE (C Barnes) – Over raced for some distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>DE CHINE (S Collett) – Raced in restricted room with 200 metres to run and forced to change ground outwards to obtain clear racing room.</p> <p>CASTUP (J Lowry) – Apprentice rider J Lowry defended a charge under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he shifted ground inwards at the 1100 metres causing SALU to be checked. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee upheld the charge and suspended J Lowry’s licence to ride at race meetings for 3 days effective 19 February to 9 March inclusive. Raced in restricted room passing the 450 metres. Inclined to lay inwards throughout the final straight.</p>
