NOTHING TRIVIAL (D Danis) – Jumped away awkwardly.

COLORADO PRINCE (M Cameron) – Over-raced badly in the early to middle stages being inclined to get its head up. Lay in under pressure near the 250 metres making contact with LOOKATMEPINS.

HELLO M'LADY (M Coleman) – Came together with NOTHING TRIVIAL near the 100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider M Coleman was of the opinion that the filly would be better suited to more rain affected footing.

FORECAST (M Coleman) – Dislodged rider M Coleman during the preliminary who was uninjured. After being recaptured FORECAST underwent a veterinary inspection being passed fit to run. Raced greenly in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Forced wider near the 900 metres.

MISS EL DORADO (M Hills) – Was slow to begin.

SNEAKY DARCI (B R Jones) – Was slow away.

SOVEREIGN PRINCE (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.

OUTOFTHEMIST (H Marzuki) – Crowded start. The saddle slipped forward passing the 1100 metres with apprentice H Marzuki then having little control of the gelding shifting inwards crowding HUSH LITTLE SISTA going into the bend near the 900 metres with HUSH LITTLE SISTA being checked losing ground, as a result MISS MAZZY was inconvenienced. Apprentice Marzuki then lost the use of his stirrup irons for the remainder of the race.

PACOTAINE (S McKay) - Crowded start.

MISS MAZZY (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced 900 metres.

HUSH LITTLE SISTA (D Danis) – Checked 900 metres losing ground.

GIANT LIKE (S Weatherley) – Crowded start.

SUFFICIENT FUNDS (D Johnson) – Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly forcing FORECAST wider.

SOPHIALIGN (A Jones) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ZABEELIOUS (L Satherley) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 900 metres.

BOHO CHIC (T Thornton) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres, and made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly running wide. Came together with LEONARDO just prior to the winning post.

PROVISION (S Collett) – Hampered passing the 350 metres when ZABEELIOUS shifted out when struck with the whip. Inconvenienced as a result was QUAINTELLE.

QUAINTELLE (R Elliot) – Inconvenienced 350 metres. Was steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of LEONARDO which shifted in near the 150 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider R Elliot was of the opinion that the mare may prefer more rain affected footing.

LEONARDO (M Coleman) – Came together with BOHO CHIC just prior to the winning post.

| <p>DOURO (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly. Came together with JESDEMONA near the 350 metres.</p> <p>PRIVATE HERO (J Nason) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>QUINTESSENTIALLY (D Johnson) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Rider D Johnson reported that she had recommended to the connections the application of blinkers for its next start.</p> <p>LADDIE OF OAKVIEW (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding his riding rounding the final turn apprentice Weatherley advised that the gelding had been off the bit and under pressure, and when looking to ride his mount forward it had lay out rounding the turn despite his efforts which eventuated in a run being presented for PRIVATE HERO to his inside early in the final straight.</p> | |

| <p>MORAL CODE (D Johnson) – Was steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of BAYMAX (J Jago) which shifted ground outwards near the 250 metres. J Jago was issued with a warning.</p> | |
| Race 7 | TRACKS CONCRETE LTD 1600 |
| <p>BOOMERANG (S Weatherley) – Was slow to begin (4L). Placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>PRINCESS EL JAY (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Made contact with BOOMERANG near the 300 metres.</p> <p>JANE'S SECRET (S McKay) – Was held up for a distance passing the 400 metres, then had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>BEN FERRARRI (L Satherley) – Shifted out slightly passing the 300 metres forcing THE DASH out on to BLINDING FAST which shifted out and away placing BOOMERANG in restricted room to the inside of PRINCESS EL JAY which was bumped wider. L Satherley was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>SO BRAZEN (H Marzuki) – Improved on to heels near the 100 metres having to shift ground outwards.</p> | |

| <p>EPAE ROAD (M Cameron) – Trainer Mr J Bell was issued with a warning for presenting EPAE ROAD without notified gear (blinkers).</p> <p>MARSHAL (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>HERE TO STAY (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering ITSABIRD.</p> <p>ITSABIRD (L Satherley) – Hampered start. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> | |

MOTUMAN (J Jago) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

BATTLE ROYAL (A Jones) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of RED KEEP (B R Jones) which shifted in near the 1800 metres, having to be steadied. Then made the bend awkwardly when being restrained. Also inconvenienced as a result was MARSHAL. B R Jones was advised to exercise greater care. Came together with MARSHAL approaching the 400 metres.

PRINCESS DILLON (M Coleman) – Raced wide rounding the first bend before improving to sit outside the leader passing the 1400 metres. Then commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres, and was not persevered with in the final straight. When questioned M Coleman advised that the mare had been a beaten runner prior to entering the final straight, and was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

RED KEEP (B R Jones) – Was denied clear running passing the 300 metres having to be steadied. Then shifted ground inwards to obtain clear running.

VANUZI (M Hills) – Three wide without cover for the majority of the race.
