RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AON INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP 1200m
FANTAMO (K Kalychurun) – Crowded leaving the barriers when runners either side shifted ground.	
GOLD'N'GURU (S Muniandy) – Over-raced in the early stages.	
A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT (R Yatim) – Began awkwardly and shifted inwards crowding FANTAMO.	
CELTIC CROSS (S Wynne) – Lay outwards shortly after the start.	
Race 2	PETER GENETICS & GRANT FARMING PARTNERSHIP MAIDEN 1335m
KRUGER RAND (G Jogoo) – Raced wide in the early stages.	

BRILLANTE ROSSO (R Cuneen) – Hampered leaving the barriers when between SIR ED and DRUM ROYAL which began awkwardly and shifted outwards.

DRUMROYAL (K Kalychurun) – began awkwardly.

TWIZEL GURU (S Muniandy) – Made the junction passing the 1200 metres awkwardly having to be steadied when near the heels of HAKA STAR. Inconvenienced momentarily passing the 100 metres when awkwardly near the heels of HAKA STAR.

HAKA STAR (T Moseley) – Lay outwards under pressure passing the 100 metres.

Race 3	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1335m

FLYING SARDINE (R Yatim) – Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight. Apprentice rider R Yatim was spoken to advisedly regarding the manner in which he used his whip over the concluding stages.

OVER TAKE (K Kalychurun) – Bounded leaving the barriers losing ground. Steadied near the 400 metres when awkwardly placed to the outside of BRAHMA QUEEN. Rider K Kalychurun advised that the mare had felt flat throughout the event.

QUEEN SERENE (S Wynne) – Raced wide without cover over the final 900 metres.

SUGGESTIVE LOOK (L Callaway) – Crowded momentarily near the 250 metres when racing to the outside of CRYSTALIGHT.

KNUTQUACKER (T Moseley) – Got its head up when being restrained passing the 1200 metres, then commenced to over-race for a distance.

CRYSTALIGHT (R Cuneen) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

POLLY'S SISTER (G Jogoo) – Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

Race 4	WHITE ROBE LODGE / JOHN BRICK MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1100m

LITTLE BOSSING (S Muniandy) – Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

GET RYTHM (L Callaway) – Raced fiercely in the early stages proving difficult to be restrained.

NOMEN LUDI (S Wynne) – Proved fractious prior to the start, beginning very awkwardly losing ground. Raced greenly throughout the final straight having to be straightened on several occasions. Rider S Wynne lost her whip near the 150 metres.

THE LIKELY LAD (M Tanaka) – When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer K Dickson advised the gelding had shown benefit from a recent change in its training regime.

LEILA EVE (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly and blundered at the start.

YOUNG URSULA (R Yatim) – Hampered leaving the barriers. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LADYBIRD (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly.

LIL MISS SWISS (S Wahab) – Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres. Bumped with MOMEN LUDI near the 50 metres.

Following the race, trainer K Tyler viewed footage of the final stages before electing not to proceed with a protest.

ROSIE JANE (G Jogoo) – Shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers crowding **YOUNG URSULA**. Raced greenly when placed under pressure passing the 150 metres and shifted inwards abruptly despite the efforts of its rider resulting in **LITTLE BOSSING** being inconvenienced. **ROSIE JANE** continued to race greenly for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the coronet band on the right fore leg consistent with the filly over reaching during the running.

Race 5	LOGAN EQUINE / HENDERSON LIVESTOCK MAIDEN 2000m

LIMOUSINE (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly bumping with **MISTY TRELLA**. Hampered passing the winning post on the first occasion.

MADAM DE SOIR (R Cuneen) – Steadied near the 350 metres when improving up onto the heels of **THE STYLE**.

THE STYLE (S Wynne) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

FLY THE FLAG (R Yatim) – Over-raced in the early stages and when being restrained passing the winning post on the first occasion shifted outwards hampering **LIMOUSINE**. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1300 metres. Clipped a heel near the 250 metres when crowded for room between **PERCEPTIVE** and **MADAM DE SOIR** (R Cuneen) which angled outwards into a marginal run to the outside of **THE STYLE** (S Wynne) which simultaneously lay outwards on the point of the bend. After reviewing video footage Stewards could not apportion blame to any sole horse or rider and accordingly no further action was taken other than to advise apprentice rider R Cuneen and rider S Wynne to exercise greater care.

MISTY TRELLA (W Papier) – Bumped with **LIMOUSINE** leaving the barriers. Raced wide in the early stages. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

SATIN JITTERBUG (M Tanaka) – Steadied near the 400 metres when awkwardly paced to the inside of **MISTY TRELLA**.

Race 6	RURAL BUSINESS SOLUTIONS GORE HANDICAP 2000m

BELLE BOY (K Kalychurun) – Hung outwards shortly after the start forcing **WHAT A DEEZA** in to the line of **ABLAZE**, **SATIN GURU** and **I’LLBEYOUR PLATINUM**, all of which had to be steadied. Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres having to be steadied and straightened.

TAKE FIRE (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

WAYLAY (S Muniandy) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when leading.

ABLAZE (G Jogoo) – Steadied when crowded shortly after the start.

SATIN GURU (C Barnes) – Steadied when crowded shortly after the start. Raced wide over the final 900 metres.

WHAT A DEEZA (M Tanaka) – Crowded momentarily passing the 100 metres when racing to the inside **BELLE BOY** which shifted inwards under pressure.

I’LLBEYOURPLATINUM (T Moseley) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start.

Race 7	HOKONUI SUZUKI HANDICAP 2000m

HE AINT’T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 900 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider L Callaway reported that the gelding had to improve wide from the 800 metres which he believed had taken its toll when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

SMOKEM UP (S Wynne) – When questioned regarding the performance rider S Wynne reported that in her opinion the gelding was unsuited by the prevailing Slow 7 track conditions encountered today.

THE BELIEVER (T Moseley) – Over-raced in the early stages.

WILD WINGS (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer J Dalton advised the mare had suffered interference at its last start when finishing further back than it should have done. Mrs Dalton further advised that the mare had worked well in preparation for today's outing and the result was not totally unexpected.

Race 8	A B LIME / TED WINSLOE MEMORIAL HANDICAP 1200m

FLICKA OF GOLD (S Muniandy) – Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

KING PIN (G Jogoo) – Shifted outwards under pressure in the early stages of the final straight inconveniencing **FLICKA OF GOLD**.

ROBIN CHARLES (R Cuneen) – Fractious in its barrier prior to the start. Reared as the gates opened dislodging rider R Cuneen and escaping riderless. Following the running of this event the connections sought a ruling from the JCA pursuant to Rule 632(1) alleging that **ROBIN CHARLES** had been denied a fair start due to a Starting Assistant having hold of the horse when the gates opened. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from Stewards, rider R Cuneen, Starter Mr K Price and trainer J Phillips the JCA declared **ROBIN CHARLES** a non-runner. A warning was placed on the barrier manners of the gelding.

TIGER CLAWS (R Yatim) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DARCI CUTTER (K Kalychurun) – Held up in the early stages of the final straight.

BARANOO (S Wahab) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.
