## GENERAL:

<b>Race 4 PHOENIX PARK 2 YEAR OLD CLASSIC</b>
A change of rider had been actioned without Stewards authorisation between the Baker/Forsman runners being CAESOUR'S DREAM (original engagement L Satherley changed to K McCulloch) and LADY ROSSA (original engagement K McCulloch changed to L Satherley). Once Stewards became aware that the alteration had occurred between the partnership and the bureau on race morning without authorisation, the original rider engagements were reinstated by the RIU. At this time all web sites were updated and On and Off Course patrons were advised.

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Harold Tuson Memorial 1400</b>
<b>MARY QUANT (V Colgan)</b> raced three wide without cover throughout. Post race Veterinary inspection revealed a small cut on hind leg.	
<b>DRAMATIST (R Hannam)</b> slow to begin settled back.	
<b>CARAMAC (K McCulloch)</b> over raced early.	
<b>LET HER RIP (L Allpress)</b> made the turn awkwardly and changed legs passing the 800 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Energy Vets Taranaki Maiden 14 0</b>

**ETOILE D'ANGE (D Turner)** slow away.  
**KITTYKITTYBANGBANG (L Satherley)** slow away.  
**MISS BONDI (M Tanaka)** raced three wide without cover throughout.  
**AMNESTYS CHILD (D Hirini)** raced four wide without cover throughout. Bumped with Our Bandit approaching the 600 metres.  
**OUR BANDIT (N Teeluck)** Bumped with Amnestys Child approaching the 600 metres.  
**ROLL THE GOLD (B Hutton)** had to be steadied approaching the 600 metres when racing keenly. In tight quarters being held up early in the straight then having to be angled into clear running approaching the 150 metres.  
**NEEDLEPOINT (V Colgan)** lay inwards early in the home straight when under pressure.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Cast Iron Services 1600</b>

**LONELY BOY (E Farr)** awkwardly away.  
**MACKLEMORE (M Tanaka)** slow away.  
**MALIBU MISS (D Turner)** raced ungenerously when being restrained for some distance then made the bend approaching the 1200 metres awkwardly running wide and taking SNOW DRIFT over extra ground.  
D Turner was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift in under hard riding near the finish hampering SLICE OF CAKE which was improving to it's inside.  
**SNOWDRIFT (R Myers)** Taken over extra ground by MALIBU MISS running awkwardly.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Phoenix Park Classic 1200</b>

**IRISH FLAME (D Turner)** awkwardly away. D Turner admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he angled his mount outwards when not clear of ICE BOMB which was hampered and dictated over extra ground. After submissions D Turner had his license to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on Thursday 2 March.  
**NUCLEONIC (L Allpress)** Rider reported filly unsuited to the Slow 8 track. Post race Veterinary check proved clear.  
**ICE BOMB (S McKay)** raced keenly early. Hampered and dictated over extra ground approaching the 600 metres.  
**SCOTT BASE (R Hannam)** had to be restrained off heels passing the 500 metres. Held up early in the home straight having to be angled outwards to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres.  
**CAESOUR'S DREAM (L Satherley)** Rider reported filly unsuited to the Slow 8 track.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Coca Cola Dash 1100m</b>

**KATIE'S SO KOOL (D Turner)** slow away and then raced ungenerously early. Had to be straightened over final stages.

**NASHVILLE (R Hannam)** slow away.  
**OVERTHERIVER (D Hirini)** three wide around the first turn being allowed to improve to the lead approaching the 1100 metres.  
**NOMISMA (R Elliot)** blundered at the start and was slow away. Tightened near the 800 metres, R Elliot advised that after being slow away his mount was unable to make up any discernible ground in the footing over the final stages.  
**OUR KING SWAY (A Jones)** slow away. Rider A Jones was spoken to regarding her salute prior to the finishing post.  
**EFFECTAV (M Tanaka)** rolled inwards on entering the home straight simultaneously as TWOZNOTENOUGH shifted out marginally resulting in EFFECTAV racing in restricted room for some distance prior to being angled inwards to improve, steadied near the finish  
**MAID OF STEEL (V Colgan)** was not persevered with from early in the home straight. Rider V Colgan advised the mare was not entirely comfortable on the Slow 8 track. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed stiffness in the near hind.  
**ALL ROADS (R Myers)** over raced early and middle stages, held up rounding the home turn. Rider advised the gelding was unsuited to the prevailing track conditons.  
**PENTATHLON (L Allpress)** Steadied when in restricted room passing the winning post on the first round.  
**CRUISER (D Bradley)** – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Bob Sharrock Memorial Oaks Prelude 1800m</b>
<p>Start of this race delayed by 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.</p> <p><b>EVA GODIVA (D Turner)</b> – Began awkwardly bumping VENCEDORA settling back. Was not persevered with over the final stages. Rider D Turner advised the filly was not entirely comfortable in the Slow 8 track conditions. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p><b>VENCEDORA (T Thornton)</b> – Over raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SACRED RHYTHM (V Colgan)</b> – Raced three-wide with-out cover throughout.</p> <p><b>STORYTIME (R Myers)</b> – Shifted ground under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p><b>IMOGENSMILES (L Satherley)</b> – Shifted in and away from STORYTIME in the home straight when laying in under pressure.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS SAPPHIRE (S McKay)</b> – Rider advised the filly was not suited by the Slow 8 track conditions.</p>

Raced in restricted room over the final stages.</p> <p><b>MASTER COURTSMAN (D Turner)</b> - Slow away.</p> <p><b>CALL ME IRISH (D Hirini)</b> – Three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>TICKET CLIPPER (K McCulloch)</b> – Over raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>KING OF STING (C Perrett)</b> – rider was reminded of his obligations regarding whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>
