FIERTE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JAIDES JEWELL (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 WAIROA STUD BREEDERS SPRINT

TAIHIKI PRIDE (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Galloped up onto the heels of the tiring INDULGENT entering the final straight then had to be shifted wide to improve.

RED SHEERAN (C Grylls) – Was slow to begin.

BOB'STHEJOB (S MacNab) – Was crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the finish.

ST REGIS (C Johnson) – Had to steady off heels when racing keenly passing the 800 metres.

MORE THAN FAST (C Lammas) – Was held up for a short distance near the 200 metres.

NOPELE (S Weatherley) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 WAIROA BUSINESS SUPPORTS SPRINT

BISOU BISOU (S MacNab) – Was unable to obtain clear running over the concluding stages.

WAIT A SEC (M Tanaka) – Slow to begin.

Race 5 KENILWORTH PLUMBING 1400

SWISS DREAM (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with AVE MARIA.

AVA MARIA (R Myers) – Crowded start losing ground.

NATIONAL ASSET (R Hannam) – Over-raced in the middle stages and had to be steadied off heels for some distance near the 800 metres.

SIR HAROLD (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CHOUXPERB (J Riddell) – Held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.

Race 6 PGG WRIGHTSON CUP TRIAL

THIRD TIME LUCKY (R Myers) – Slow to begin.

Race 7 SILVER FERN FARMS 1900

DANDEEDEE (D Hirini) – Slow to begin. Bumped when in restricted room to the inside of FASNET FIRE passing the 800 metres.

THE COSSACK (R Hannam) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

AMPERAGE (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly.

CASEY MARIE (S MacNab) – Became awkwardly placed on heels when over-racing leaving the home straight on the first round having to be firmly restrained.

PALACIO (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 800 metres.

Race 8 RUSSELL ROADS 1900

HANDFULL (S Collett) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Was inclined to hang outwards during the running.

MASTER WILLIAM (D Hirini) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres. Was held up until near the 250 metres.

PARADISE ROCK (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover rounding the first bend. When questioned regarding the performance Rider C Lammas advised Stewards that the gelding had over-raced throughout and had little left at the finish.

JUDITH KATE (S Weatherley) – Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres going back onto MASTER WILLIAM and KATIEM MARIE. Was then held up for a distance until near the 250 metres.

KATIEM MARIE (R Myers) – Inconvenienced 400 metres.

Race 9 K9 PETFOODS 1400

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (A Collett) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in its barrier stall and was cleared to start. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Held up rounding the final bend.

EVA JENSINE (D Hirini) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE CZAR (R Myers) – Was held up until near the 300 metres.

COLORADO PRINCE (C Lammas) – Was held up early in the final straight having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.
