RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	KURIPUNI SPORTS BAR 1000 (1000 metres)			
FETISH (L Hemi) – Blundered at the start settling back. When questioned rider advised that after losing its footing at				
the start the mare had been unable to recover and would be better suited over more ground.				

THEATRE (S O'Malley) – Had to be steadied when crowded shortly after the start. Lost the left front plate during the running. Ran wide rounding the final turn near the 350 metres when shifting outwards to obtain clear running.

S O'Malley (THEATRE) – Was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 February up to and including racing on Thursday 23 February (4 Central Region riding days) after admitting a charge of careless riding in that he

permitted his mount THEATRE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of JESSICOVA, which was checked near the 700 metres.

JESSICOVA (S Collett) – Crowded and checked near the 700 metres.

Race 2

MCKENZIES ELECTRICAL 1600 (1600 metres)

ON THE HILL (D Bradley) – Slow to begin; commenced to over-race passing the 1400 metres; having to be steadied away from the heels of MAGIC WONDER near the 1200 metres, continuing to over-race through the middle stages.

DAL DANTRIX (S Collett) – Had to be firmly restrained after improving on to heels near the 700 metres.

Race 3 ECOLAB MAIDEN 2050 (2050 metres)

MY ISABELLA (C Johnson) – Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race shortly after the start.

INDICAR (D Bradley) and **RUBY WOO** (L Hemi) – Crowded to the inside of MASTER COURTSMAN (D Turner) near the 1900 metres. D Turner was advised to exercise care.

STORMY HABIT (R Goldsbury) tightened at the start and got back.

OUR WONDER (L Allpress) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages so was taken wide near the 1700 metre mark where it continued to race three wide without cover for the remainder.

CHALLENGE (R Myers) – Raced ungenerously throughout. Bumped passing the 350 metres. Lay in under pressure in the home straight making contact with HANDYMAN on a number of occasions. R Myers was advised that she must make a greater attempt to straighten her mount than she had on this occasion.

HANDYMAN (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1700 metres. Bumped passing the 350 metres.

PLATINUM RAIDER (R Hannam) - When questioned regarding the disappointing performance rider Hannam was unable to offer any excuse but recommended to connections that the blinkers which had come off today be reapplied. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4 CLAREVILLE FRESH MILK 2050 (2050 metres)

KEEPING FAITH (M Coleman) - Slow away.

LOOKHEREPAL (D Johnson) – Slow away.

ALARINDA (D Hirini) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MISS NORWAY (R Myers) had to steady when placed in restricted room over the final stages when IRISH CHAT (D Turner) shifted inwards under pressure. Rider D Turner was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount when under hard riding sooner than he did on this occasion.

When questioned into the run of **KAMANDA LINCOLN**, rider M Tanaka said whilst the colt was held up for some distance rounding the turn when placed in restricted room, finished the race off only fairly.

CAJUN (S Wynne) – Jumped in the air at the start losing ground.

KOLONEL KEV (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ANTONIO (R Myers) - Made the first bend awkwardly when placed in restricted room to the inside of ALL IN VOGUE which was taken in slightly by **BELLA'S DELIGHT** (D Bradley). D Bradley was advised to exercise care.

LEADING ROLE (C Johnson) - Held up passing the 300 metres until near the 150 metres.

WIGGLE (H Tinsley) - Had to be steadied away from the heels of BELLA'S DELIGHT over the concluding stages

ALL IN VOGUE – Trainer K Gray was questioned by the stewards regarding the improved performance of the mare, which had finished last at its most recent start. K Gray advised that the mare had been working well in the lead up prior to today's run and that he had instructed rider S Collett to ride ALL IN VOGUE more positively on this occasion.

Race 6 TE POWER RAPA WAIRARAPA THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS STAKES (1600 metres)

CHARMONT (M Coleman) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ETERNITY (S Collett) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

ROHAISE (L Hemi) – Held up passing the 600 metres until the 300 metres. Connections advised the mare is retired.

MAE WEST (R Hannam) – Held up passing the 400 metres until the 350 metres.

BRONSTEEL (D Bradley) – Over-raced through the middle stages.

SHE KNOWS (H Tinsley) - Had to be angled wide in the home straight to improve.

Race 7 PROPERTY BROKERS 1400 (1400 metres)

PLAY THE GAME (L Hemi) – Slow away.

INCANTATION (R Myers) - Held up approaching the 700 metres until passing the 400 metres when angled back to the inside to gain clear running.

THE DUKE OF JAZZ (S Collett) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

MASTER WILLIAM (D Hirini) – Had to be straightened when inclined to shift in in the home straight.

JACKOFALL (R Hannam) – Raced three wide without cover throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight. Rider R Hannam advised that he felt there may have been something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary inspection found the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance required prior to racing again. Trainer L Latta indicated the gelding is unlikely to be persevered with from her stable.
