Rider D Bothamley advised Stewards that he was unwell and would be unable to attend today's meeting, with Mr Bothamley being advised that a medical clearance is required prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SPEIGHTS MAIDEN STAYERS 2100m
LIMOUSINE (K Kalychurun) – Steadied near the 950 metres when improving up onto the heels of RED TEMPEST. Held up momentarily passing the 400 metres.	
THE STYLE (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly. Shifted inwards abruptly near the 150 metres when placed under pressure and had to be straightened.	

RED TEMPEST (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Raced wide in the early stages prior to being improved forward to obtain a leading position near the 1000 metres.

Race 2	ANNEDON RACING MAIDEN 1600m

BEETHOVEN (S Muniandy) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

NETHERTOWN EXPRESS (C Johnson) – Crowded shortly after the start when between BEETHOVEN and TANIWHA which began awkwardly and shifted inwards.

MISS GEE JAY (K Kalychurun) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider K Kalychurun advised that after being caught wide throughout the effort had told on the mare over the concluding stages.

HIGHER AUTHORITY (R Cuneen) – Held up rounding the final bend until being angled wider on the track near the 200 metres.

DREAM RICH (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Raced wide in the early stages prior to being improved forward to obtain the lead near the 800 metres.

PORTUMNA LASS (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages and near the 1050 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed to the inside of DREAM RICH.

Race 3	AB LIME MAIDEN 1200m

The start of this event was delayed approximately 2 minutes due to several runners proving difficult to load.

PORTERS PASS (G Jogoo) – Raced wide in the early and middle stages.

MY PLAN (R Yatim) – Bumped by SUPATWISTA at the start.

DOPPELGANGER (K Kalychurun) – Hampered at the start. Inconvenienced when forced wider on the track by SUPATWISTA over the concluding stages.

FRIAR TUCK (C Barnes) – Jumped outwards at the start hampering DOPPELGANGER. Raced wide without cover throughout.

LITTLE BOSSING (S Muniandy) – Steadied when awkwardly near the heels of GALWAY GARRY near the 900 metres, shifting outwards off that runners heels.

GALWAY GARRY (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. Steadied off heels when over-racing passing the 900 metres.

PAST THYME (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

NO CHARGE (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Steadied momentarily near the 100 metres when THE COVER GIRL (J Lowry) shifted inwards under pressure. Apprentice rider J Lowry was advised to exercise greater care. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Johnson advised that after racing three wide without cover the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

THE COVER GIRL (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly making contact with the barrier partition resulting in apprentice rider J Lowry becoming unbalanced. Shifted inwards under pressure near the 150 metres inconveniencing NO CHARGE.

WESTEND MADAM (R Cuneen) – Lay inwards under pressure near the 150 metres having to be straightened.

SUPATWISTA (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards and bumping with MY PLAN. Shifted ground outwards over the concluding stages forcing DOPPELGANGER wider on the track. Apprentice rider R Beeharry with the assistance of his employer Mr B Tapper was shown video coverage of the final straight and advised that in future he would be expected to straighten his mount far sooner than he did so on this occasion.

Race 4	MCCALLUMS GROUP STAYERS HANDICAP 2600m

FRANCONI (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Made the bend near the 2200 metres awkwardly. Hung outwards and made the bend near the 1800 metres awkwardly.

LIN (G Jogoo) – Shied and shifted outwards abruptly passing the 150 metres.

PETER PARKER (S Muniandy) – Raced wide in the early stages. Shifted inwards near the 450 metres.

ZAH CHAMP (T Moseley) – Steadied near the 450 metres when racing to the inside of PETER PARKER (S Muniandy) which shifted inwards when struck with the whip. Rider S Muniandy was issued with a warning. Weakened from the 450 metres with the gelding not being persevered with thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

ELVERA (L Callaway) – Held up for a distance passing the 600 metres. Steadied near the 500 metres when improving up onto heels.

NEWS FLASH (J Lowry) – Bumped with A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT near the 50 metres.

FASTFOOT (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

FANTAMO (K Kalychurun) – Over-raced in the early stages.

A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT (R Yatim) – Crowded shortly after the start when between NEWS FLASH and FANTAMO, both of which shifted ground. Over-raced in the early stages. Shifted inwards under pressure near the 50 metres bumping with NEWSFLASH.

Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200m

The start of this event was delayed due to **LADY LAGMHOR** proving difficult to load.

PATROMIA (J Lowry) – Made the final bend awkwardly with apprentice rider J Lowry reporting the mare had got its tongue over the bit during the running.

DIRECT STAR (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

JESSIES GIRL (R Cuneen) – Slow to begin.

LADY LAGMHOR (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Connections were advised a warning is placed against the mare's barrier manners.

THE GLISTEN (C Johnson) – Raced fiercely in the early stages with the saddle shifting forward placing rider C Johnson at a disadvantage.

PRETTY WHAIHINE (S Muniandy) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

DRUMGOLD (S Muniandy) – Crowded on leaving the barrier when between ALICE WEBB ELLIS and ALL THING'S NICE which was forced inwards by ENTREE. Commenced to over-race passing the 800 metres, being angled outwards across heels resulting in GALELLA being forced wider on the track.

CHICAGO (J Lowry) – Steadied when awkwardly near heels passing the 200 metres.

ROBIN CHARLES (R Cuneen) – Raced wide in the early stages. Shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

GALELLA (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Forced wider on the track by DRUMGOLD passing the 800 metres.

LIZZIE BORDON (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and bumped with RAJIV leaving the barrier. Got its head up when being steadied near the 900 metres when improving up onto the heels of RAJIV.

THE GORE HARPOON (S Wynne) – Steadied near the 500 metres when crowded between CHICAGO (J Lowry) and DRUMGOLD (S Muniandy). After questioning riders it was established that CHICAGO had shifted outwards briefly when attempting to obtain clear running simultaneous to DRUMGOLD laying inwards when placed under pressure. Stewards could not apportion blame solely onto any one horse or rider therefore no further action was deemed necessary.

ALICE WEBB ELLIS (L Callaway) – Rider L Callaway was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 648(5) after weighing in 0.6 kilograms overweight.

POLLY'S SISTER (G Jogoo) – Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages and had to be steadied.

RAJIV (R Yatim) – Bumped leaving the barrier. Crowded and checked near the 300 metres when racing to the inside of POLLY'S SISTER (G Jogoo). After questioning riders it was established that POLLY'S SISTER had improved to the inside of RAJIV when searching for clear racing room simultaneous to DARCI GLITTER (K Kalychurun) laying outwards and CHICAGO (J Lowry) commencing to give ground. Nevertheless, rider G Jogoo was issued with a warning for the manner in which he shifted ground. Apprentice rider R Yatim reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild lameness to the left hind leg.
