RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ADAMS ENGINEERING STAYERS

JOVANNI (E Farr) - slow away. Was briefly held up passing the 250 metres having to shift outwards to obtain clear running.

JANE'S SECRET (S Collett) - raced wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 800 metres, then was quickly under pressure passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight.

SUFFICE TO SAY (R Elliot) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

KOWHAI KERRY (K Cowan) – was briefly held up passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of **GAME PERCY** which shifted in slightly.

Race 2 KIWI TRANSPORT SPRINT

STRUT (R Myers) - was late scratched on veterinary advice at 1.29pm.

REAL BEACH (M Tanaka) - began very awkwardly with rider M Tanaka becoming unbalanced losing the use of his left stirrup iron for a distance and losing ground as a result.

FLAVOURING (R Hannam) – had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **DESTINY ONE** (C Grylls) which shifted in passing the 1000 metres. As a result **FLAVOURING** went back onto **RINGLOCK** (R Elliott) which had to be firmly restrained. C Grylls was issued with a warning.

MORE THAN FAST (M McNab) - was slow to begin.

DEEJAY MAC (D Hirini) - was slow to begin.

RINGLOCK (R Elliot) - had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly place on heels near the 1000 metres.

NOPELE (S Weatherley) – had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 750 metres to the inside of **IMPERIOUS PRINCE** (E Farr) which shifted in and away from **ST REGIS** (C Johnson) which had shifted in slightly. As a result **NOPELE** went back onto **DESTINY ONE** which had to be steadied. C Johnson was issued with a warning.

TAIHIKI PRIDE (S Collett) - was firmly restrained when placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres.

DESTINY ONE (C Grylls) - had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 750 metres and again passing the 450 metres.

Race 3 BAY FORD / FRASERTOWN TAVERN JUVENILE

SILVER MISSILE (C Lammas) - began awkwardly, then was crowded shortly afterwards losing ground, over-raced through the early stages.

OTTAVIO (C Grylls) - lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 WAIROA STAR 1500

PRINCESS DAVONE (C Lammas) - began awkwardly losing ground, got its head up for a distance when being steadied passing the 1250 metres.

WAIT A SEC (M Tanaka) - was slow away.

Race 5 BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES (HAWKE'S BAY) STAYERS

GINGERBREAD MAN (K Cowan) - began awkwardly and had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MASTER WILLIAM** losing ground.

KING KANE (C Johnson) - was slow away. Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres and was then forced wide entering the final straight by **EVA JENSINE** which shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

MIO KIWI (R Elliot) - was slow away.

DANDEEDEE (D Hirini) - over raced in the early stages.

EVA JENSINE (J Riddell) - made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly when over racing shifting out. Held up rounding the bend having to shift ground outwards near the 250 metres to improve.

FASTNET FIRE (M McNab) - when questioned regarding the performance rider M McNab advised that in his opinion the mare was feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 6 AFFCO NZ LTD WAIROA CUP

CAJUN (C Lammas) - was slow away.

SANASAR (R Elliot) - commenced to lay out shortly after jumping away making the first bend awkwardly.

THIRD TIME LUCKY (R Myers) - shifted out entering the final straight to obtain clear running making slight contact with **FRANCIS DRAKE**.

Race 7 VETENT 1450

ABSOLUTELY PEACHES (J Bassett) - began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced shifting out hampering **ABLOOM** with both runners losing considerable ground.

ABLOOM (M NcNab) - hampered start losing ground.

MIGHTY MAK (R Elliot) - raced three wide without cover.

HIGHBROOK (R Myers) - **ABLOOM** improved into a marginal run passing the 200 metres between **HIGHBROOK** and **SWISS DREAM**. Near the 100 metres **HIGHBROOK** shifted out slightly making contact with **ABLOOM** and as a result was steadied by its rider.

SWISS DREAM (S Weatherley) - was steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 75 metres when **MAKE ME ACHIEVER** shifted in slightly and **ABLOOM** was forced out slightly by **HIGHBROOK**.

Race 8 WAIROA EXPATS 1400

LADY CONRAAD (E Farr) - began awkwardly making contact with **ESBEEDEE** which became briefly unbalanced. Held up by the weakening **JAIDES JEWELL** having to shift ground outwards to improve near the 400 metres.

THE CZAR (R Myers) - was hampered on jumping away for a short distance when runners on either side shifted ground.

POWERADE (A Jones) - began awkwardly and was further hampered when **CASAQUINMAN** (J Riddell) shifted in shortly after jumping away.

RED TIARA (C Johnson) - was steadied when weakening passing the 100 metres when **ESBEEDEE** (R Elliot) lay in when placed under pressure. R Elliot was issued with a warning.

ESBEEDEE (R Elliot) – bumped start becoming unbalanced. Commenced to over race approaching the 800 metres shifting out across heels.

KNIGHT'S PRINCESS (R Hannam) - made the bend near the 750 metres awkwardly.

COLORADO PRINCE (C Lammas) - lay out rounding the final bend.

JAIDES JEWELL (D Hirini) - raced wide without cover throughout and commenced to give ground inside the final 600 metres.

ROC ME (M Tanaka) - was held up until near the 200 metres.

CORPORATE MISSILE (M McNab) – when questioned regarding the performance rider M McNab could offer no tangible excuse.
