RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 PUNTERS CHALLENGE APRIL 8 – ENTER NOW MAIDEN (1400m)

QUIZ (C Barnes) – Fractious in its barrier delaying the start, raced wide in the early stages.

ULTRA CHIC (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin.

PINNACLE BAY (J Lowry) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, lay outwards near the 600 metres. Apprentice rider J Lowry reported that the gelding had hung outwards throughout.

ONE WAY TICKET (S Muniandy) – Raced wide throughout, was inclined to lay inwards throughout the final straight, brushed with **SUSIE WOLFF** near the 50 metres.

CIELITO LINDO (L Callaway) – Over raced for some distance passing the 1000 metres.

TAXIHOME (K Williams) – Raced keenly for some distance passing the 800 metres, held up in the early stages of the run home.

ATHONIS (T Moseley) – Held up in the early stages of the run home, blundered near the 75 metres losing momentum.

SUSIE WOLFF (S Wynne) – Held up in the early stages of the run home, raced in restricted room near the 125 metres, brushed with **ONE WAY TICKET** near the 50 metres.

HANNAH MARENE (C Johnson) – Was not afforded clear running early in the home straight.

Race 2 NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE APRIL 21 TWO & THREE YEAR OLDS (1200m)

SHINKANSEN (T Moseley) – Fractious going out onto the track dislodging its bridle which resulted in a delay to the start, jostled with **KIWI IDA** for some distance when in restricted room passing the 800 metres.

NAKYAMA (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly, steadied when tightened from both sides near the 400 metres.

KIWI IDA (C Johnson) – Jostled with **SHINKANSEN** for some distance when in restricted room passing the 800 metres, held up momentarily near the 550 metres, shifted outwards away from heels near the 400 metres.

DON CARLO (K Williams) – Steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **SENSEI** near the 500 metres.

WHAT CHOUX WANT (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout, lay inwards near the 400 metres, eased down over the concluding stages. The rider reported that the filly was indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slight abrasion on the left hind leg consistent with being galloped on during the running.

Race 3 SPEIGHT'S MID ALE RATING 65 (1200m)

POP HIT (C Barnes) – Crowded on jumping. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

BLACK ESTATE (C Johnson) – Denied clear racing room early in home straight until the 200 metres.

CINDERELLA (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages, awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres, Held up when awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres and lay inwards near the 350 metres having to be straightened across heels. Apprentice rider K Mudhoo was severely reprimanded and reminded of his obligations to ride out fully to the end of the race.

STROWAN (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages .Raced ungenerously when negotiating the junction passing the 650 metres.

GOOD MAMA (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

LOTTERIO (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide throughout.

PRINCESS ATHENA (A Jones) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the home straight, bumped with **DAIFUKU** near the 75 metres.

DAIFUKU (C Spittles) –Held up momentarily early in home straight. Bumped with **PRINCESS ATHENA** near the 75 metres.

Race 4 FASTTRACK INSURANCE OPEN HANDICAP (1000m)

COUP DARCI BE (K Mudhoo) – Bumped with **ARYACRAZY** on jumping.

ARYACRAZY (C Barnes) – Bumped with **COUP DARCI BE** on jumping, raced keenly in the early stages. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate, with Stewards undertaking to follow up with trainer P Rudkin in subsequent days.

JAZZMAN (W Papier) – Raced wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance, trainer M Pitman advised that the gelding had taken improvement from its recent racing.

RIDING SHOTGUN (T Moseley) – Held up in the early stages of the home straight.

MR TYPHON (S Wynne) – Steadied near the 50 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of MADAM BENTLEY which shifted outwards under pressure.

MADAM BENTLEY (C Johnson) – Shifted outwards near the 50 metres. Rider C Johnson was warned under Rule 638(1)(d).

Race 5 TOM BURNS - YOU WERE A LEGEND RATING 65 (1600m)

SMICHAEL (C Kwo) – Bounded as the start was effected and was further hampered when **FUGAWI** shifted outwards making firm contact.

FUGAWI (R Yatim) – Shifted out abruptly at the start.

OLIGARCH (C Johnson) – Slow to begin, raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres having to steady.

RAPID RISE (K Kalychurun) – Raced keenly when leading in the early stages, lay out when under pressure in the run home.

KOLAMAN (L Callaway) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages getting its head up.

MOREIRA (K Mudhoo) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1000 metres when being restrained, shifted inwards passing the 100 metres and was straightened at the 75 metres.K Mudhoo warned Rule 638(1)(d)

YOURLIPS AR MOVIN (T Moseley) – Lay inwards near the 350 metres making contact with **MYSTIFY ME**, steadied when in restricted room near the 75 metres losing momentum and becoming awkwardly placed between runners.

STONEMASON (K Williams) – Shifted inwards near the 300 metres checking **BOBBY AL**. Rider **K Williams** admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 12 February to 18 February inclusive.

BOBBY AL (S Wynne) - Checked and steadied at the 300 metres.

WINDERMERE LASS (C Spittles) – Steadied and shifted ground outwards at the 300 metres, shifted outwards near the 200 metres. Rider C Spittles was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

KININMONT(C Barnes) – Hung out throughout.

MYSTIFY ME (A Jones) – Lay outwards near the 75 metres having to be steadied.

Race 6 GAVELHOUSE.COM OPEN HANDICAP (1800m)

LOCHAN ORA (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin.

COURT ORDER (T Moseley) – Had difficulty obtaining a clear run throughout the home straight, contacted a heel and blundered near the 200 metres when attempting a marginal run and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

Race 7 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 75 (1400m)

SAPERAVIOUS (C Spittles) – Began awkwardly.

THE REAL DEAL (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously passing the 700 metres.

JOHNNY JONES (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly, raced ungenerously in the early stages, lay inwards through the final straight.

DYNAMIC (W Papier) – Blundered on jumping, rider dropped his whip passing the 375 metres, rider becoming unbalanced near the 50 metres. Apprentice rider W Papier was warned under Rule 636(1)(d) for failing to ride out to the finish. In determining the matter Stewards took into account W Papier's limited riding experience. W Papier, with the assistance of employer M Pitman, was shown the replays of the early and middle stages of the race and advised to show better judgement in future in relation to the tempo of the race.

LUKE (C Kwo) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

HE'S GOLD (S Wynne)- Held up early stages of home straight.

Race 8 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 75 (2000m)

HIYO UGO (C Johnson) – Restrained to the rear on jumping, over raced in the middle stages.

ASOMA (A Jones) – Raced wide in the early stages.

PASSAMAQUODDY (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages, became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1400 metres and was forced to race wider from this point, lay inwards passing the 350 metres when under pressure having to be straightened.

RISING SON (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages, steadied momentarily near the 450 metres when in restricted room.

BLUE PRINT (C Barnes) – Became awkwardly placed and steadied off heels near the 1600 metres, continued to race ungenerously for some distance thereafter. Awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1400 metres.

VANTAA (K Williams) – Became awkwardly placed and steadied off heels passing the 1400 metres.

PRECIOUS PERCY (C Spittles) – Became awkwardly placed and steadied off heels passing the 1400 metres.

LADY EM (R Yatim) – Became awkwardly placed and steadied off heels passing the 1400 metres.

TOETWOTOE (T Jonker) – Eased the pace near the 1400 metres. Apprentice **T Jonker** was warned for careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d). Continued to race ungenerously when in the lead from this point and made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly laying out from the 600 metres.

OPIHI JADE (K Mudhoo) – Over raced when being restrained near the 1200 metres, lay inwards passing the 150 metres having to be straightened.
