RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 NADEEM 1300 (1300 metres)

J Parkes failed to make the contracted riding weight for BELLE CADEAU so was replaced by L Allpress. J Parkes was fined \$100.

DEEDEE PANACHE (R Myers) – Slow away.

OCEAN EMPEROR (M Hills) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when three wide without cover. Dictated wider on the track when MISS WILSON improved to its inside passing the 400 metres. When questioned into the run of OCEAN EMPEROR, rider M Hills advised that after racing keenly when wide in the early and middle stages the horse had little left at the finish. A subsequent veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

MISS WILSON (J Riddell) – Over-raced when being restrained early.

TEMPLE TIGER (J Fawcett) - Bumped with BELLE CADEAU (L Allpress) passing the 50 metres when racing in restricted room.

BELLE CADEAU – Bumped passing 50 metres.

Race 2 STELLA ARTOIS 1300 (1300 metres)

C Grylls did not attend the meeting and was replaced on YOUR GRACE by M Cameron.

OUR GIRL MADI (R Myers) – Shied passing the 800 metres when leading, resulting in PROFICIENT (R Hannam) and LADY GUINESS being dictated wider on the track.

LADY GUINNESS (J Parkes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Dictated wider near the 800 metres.

PROFICIENT (R Hannam) – Dictated wider near the 800 metres.

SARONIC MISS (V Colgan) – Raced keenly early when being restrained. Held up early in the home straight angled out to gain clear running passing the 200metres.

CLAIRETHEWAY (L Innes) – Held up passing the 400 metres and early in the home straight, gaining clear running inside the final 200 metres.

GATA (O Bosson) – Rider advised that the filly may be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 3 PER INCANTO 3YO (1400 metres)

WORD SAVVY (M Tanaka) - Began awkwardly.

DANGER DEE (J Riddell) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Bumped with TWENTY ONE TIMES (L Innes) on a couple of occasions when in restricted room inside the final 150 metres.

TWENTY ONE TIMES (L Innes) – Bumped when in restricted room inside the final 150 metres.

SOPHIA MAGIA (J Parkes) – Shifted out after bumping TWENTY ONE TIMES over the final stages, resulting in CHOUXPERB being hampered near the finish.

Race 4 TRINITY HILL 1200 (1200 metres)

POSTER GIRL (S Collett) – Tightened at the start. Rider reported the mare hit the front of the stalls prior to jumping away.

HUNDYAMONTH (L Allpress) – Fractious in gates prior to the start.

ENCHANTING BEAUTY (D Johnson) – Slow away. Hung approaching the 400 metres, making the bend awkwardly.

DANMULAN (D Bradley) – Over-raced early. Dictated wide passing the 400 metres when SAVE THE STARS (C Lammas) was angled into clear running.

Race 5 HORSE OF THE YEAR 7-12 MARCH 1400 (1400 metres)

BLATHWAYT (R Hannam) – Slow away (2L).

SEIZE THE MOMENT (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly early when being restrained. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

Race 6 TREMAINS STARTING GATES 2100 (2100 metres)

ALFIE DEE (N Teeluck) – Slow away. Over-raced throughout and made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

ZED LEPPELIN (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly.

SOPRAFFINA (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the run the rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

TROUP ROAD (K McCulloch) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer M Eales advised the gelding had been suited by being ridden more positively and taking advantage of the No.1 barrier draw and was well rated when allowed to dictate terms in front.

Race 7 LITTLE AVONDALE LOWLAND STAKES (2100 metres)

GRAND SOLEIL (M McNab) – Hit the gate leaving the enclosure and underwent a veterinary examination prior to the start and was cleared to race. Briefly held up behind the weakening RIP INTO GHIA near the 500 metres.

RIP INTO GHIA (J Riddell) – Rider advised that the filly was making respiratory noises during the running. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a poor post-race recovery with the filly to undergo a further veterinary check on return to its stable.

WHIPPED (J Parkes) - Slow away.

KORAKONUI (L Allpress) – Slow away. Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1000 metres.

STORYTIME (R Myers) – Over-raced early.

IMOGENSMILES (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Briefly held up behind the weakening RIP INTO GHIA near the 500 metres.

NICOLETTA (M Coleman) – Rider M Coleman advised that after over-racing in the early and middle stages, he recommended to connections that they consider removing blinkers for the filly's next start.

Race 8 NZB NATIONAL WEANLING, BROODMARE & MIXED BLOODSTOCK SALE 8-10 MAY (1600 metres)

MIZ OLDFIELDS ROAD (J Bassett) – Slow away. Over-raced when being restrained off heels approaching the 1400 metres.

PLAY THE GAME (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HUNTA PENCE (C Johnson) – Momentarily held up early in the home straight then having to be angled sharply inwards across heels passing the 100 metres to gain clear running, which resulted in the weakening ON DEBUT (L Allpress) having to be briefly steadied near the 50 metres. C Johnson was advised to exercise care.

ON DEBUT (L Allpress) – Briefly steadied when weakening 50 metres.

STEPPENWOLF (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider was unable to offer any excuses but was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a drop back in distance
