RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GALLAGHER MAIDEN (2100 metres)		
THE IMP (E Farr) – Dislodged the rider during the preliminary and took some time to recapture, being declared a late			
scratching on veterinary advice at 2.18pm. Rider E Farr was initially attended to by ambulance personnel and after			
being examined by the course doctor, stood down from her remaining engagements today.			

DEMI (R Hannam) – Raced three wide without cover

ART OF WAR (D Turner) – Shifted outwards to avoid the heels of DEMI which was commencing to weaken near the 700 metres forcing TWILIGHT JEWEL over extra ground.

TWILIGHT JEWEL (R Goldsbury) – Forced over extra ground 700 metres. Hung inwards rounding the bend becoming unbalanced when making contact with AUDACIOUS near the 500 metres.

AUDACIOUS (R Myers) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance, the rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

MY ISABELLA (J Parkes) – Inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres. When questioned rider advised that after over-racing the mare had been unable to respond once placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 2 AGRICOM HANDICAP (1550 metres)

BELLA'S DELIGHT (D Bradley) – Raced wide without cover for the majority.

GOLD ALLURE (R Myers) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider was unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 NUFARM HANDICAP (1200 metres)

JUDI ANNE (R Myers) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Briefly held up early in the final straight, shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

THE RICH LISTER (J Parkes) – When questioned the rider was of the opinion the gelding would be better suited to a more rain-affected track. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4 TUI – BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 MAIDEN (1200 metres)

CHARMING CHOUX (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered passing 200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels and continued to race greenly running wide.

SMOKEN HOT (R Hannam) – Slow away.

SAINT CROIX (J Riddell) – Hung inwards shortly after the start resulting in tightening to RAVENHILL and HEINEKEN ROCKS. Continued to lay in rounding the first turn resulting in MISS DOHERTY racing in restricted room and being steadied.

RAVENHILL (R Myers) – Tightened shortly after the start.

HEINEKEN ROCKS (L Allpress) – Tightened shortly after the start.

MISS DOHERTY (M Tanaka) – steadied 700 metres.

CHOUX MANIA (R Goldsbury) – R Goldsbury issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) in that after being denied a run approaching the 200 metres angled her mount out hampering CHARMING CHOUX which was racing greenly then becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 5 PGG WRIGHTSON MAIDEN (120 metres)

SILVER LADY (A Chan) – Jumped away awkwardly and was then further hampered having to be steadied when WONDER LASS shifted outwards. Hung outwards rounding the bend.

BOY SOLDIER (N Teeluck) – Jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced badly in the early to middle stages on a moderate tempo, having to be firmly restrained to avoid heels going into the turn near the 800 metres, making the bend

awkwardly as a result.

MISS CONTESSA (L Allpress) – Knuckled leaving the barriers.

LAMBADA (J Parkes) – Hampered shortly after leaving the barriers when HOW'S THAT GIRL lay in. Made the turn near the 800 metres awkwardly when being restrained to avoid heels.

HOW'S THAT GIRL (M Tanaka) – Raced three wide without cover.

GARMENT (R Hannam) – Over-raced in the middle stages getting its head up when having to be steadied to avoid the heels of MISS CONTESSA near the 800 metres.

WONDER LASS (D Turner) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 1000 metres then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MYSTIGAN for a distance near the 800 metres.

R Myers (MYSTIGAN) and **L Allpress** (MISS CONTESSA) were both spoken to regarding the manner with which they slowed the pace passing the 900 metres.

Race 6 MERIDIAN ENERGY MAIDEN (1400 metres)

EYE'S WIDE OPEN (L Allpress) – Shifted inwards abruptly when jumping away from the number 1 barrier stall.

REDROCK HIGH (R Hannam) – Jumped away awkwardly.

WHAT NOW MY LOVE (A Chan) – began awkwardly. Had to be steadied for a distance when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 900 metres.

CANNY MAGIC (D Turner) – Lay in shortly after jumping away making contact with ETHNEE then having to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of HELVETICA.

ETHNEE (A Jones) – Bumped shortly after the start.

CASSINO TO TRIESTE (S McKay) - Held up early in the home straight

EL KAYO (C Johnson) – Held up early in the home straight.

Race 7 FARMLANDS MAIDEN (1550 metres)

I SPIED (R Hannam) - Jumped inwards at the start bumping FRENCH SERGE.

FRENCH SERGE – Bumped at the start. Raced keenly in the early stages. Dictated wide passing the 800 metres when ON THE QUIET went amiss. Momentarily held up passing the 400 metres.

WOTAMISSION (L Allpress) – Hung passing the 400 metres making the bend awkwardly.

MONTPELIER (K Cowan) – Slow away. Momentarily checked approaching the 750 metres. Raced greenly in the home straight.

PENANCE (S McKay) – Slow away.

ALLMOSTA (A Chan) – Raced three wide throughout.

THE HUNTSMAN (N Teeluck) – Awkwardly away. Dictated wide passing the 800 metres by ON THE QUIET.

MAY WE ALL (A Jones) - Dictated wide passing the 800 metres when ON THE QUIET went amiss

ON THE QUIET (B Hutton) – Pulled up by its rider passing the 800 metres after going amiss. Was immediately attended to by the course veterinarian and humanely euthanised having suffered a fracture to the near fore.

Race 8 POWER FARMING HANDICAP (2100 metres)

HARE BAWL (D Bradley) - Shifted ground inwards under pressure early in the home straight and bumped with ALCALDESA (R Goldsbury). A short distance further both runners shifted ground and bumped inside the final 100 metres.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends, connections of the 2nd placed ALCALDESA (R Goldsbury) lodged an objection against the winner HARE BAWL (D Bradley) alleging interference in the home straight but after viewing footage elected not to proceed with a protest which was withdrawn.

NEWSTEAD (L Allpress) – Checked near the 400 metres.

R Goldsbury (ALCALDESA) – Admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that she angled her mount outward near the 400 metres when not clear of NEWSTEAD (L Allpress), which was checked. After submissions the JCA suspended her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday, 10th March up to and including racing on 23rd March (3 days).

J'WALKE (A Chan) - Raced greenly throughout and shifted outwards when struck with the whip in the home straight.

DREAM CRUZA (H Tinsley) – Rider could offer no excuse for the disappointing run.

MICHELIN (D Turner) – Slow away.

JUSTNAMETHEPRICE (N Teeluck) – Began awkwardly.

J'WALKE (A Chan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BLACKGAMMON (R Hannam) – over-raced when wide in the early and middle stages. Rider advised the mare may prefer more easing in the ground. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.

ZCASTLE (H Andrew) – Had to be checked off heels of the tiring BLACKGAMMON passing the 500 metres.
