RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DUNSTAN FEEDS STAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 2100
CLARIFY (S McKay) – Stumbled shortly after jumping away losing ground. Was held up rounding the final turn, and was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.	
ULYSSES (T Thornton) – Crowded jumping away losing ground due to outward movement from MIDNIGHT MISTRESS.	

WANNABE ROYALE (D Johnson) – Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1800 metres when the pace steadied. Was bumped and unbalanced passing the 400 metres by MISTRAHMA which shifted out to obtain clear running.

MISTRAHMA (K McCulloch) – Shifted out to obtain clear running 400 metres.

WRANGLER (S Spratt) – Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1800 metres when the pace steadied. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres and steadied, and was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

SYMPHONIC (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages. Improved into a marginal run passing the 250 metres.

TOORAK TOWER (L Innes) – Was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

STREET SMART (O Bosson) – Was held up shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres.

ARMAGUARD (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground (3L).

ELUSIVE KITTY (J Nason) – Was crowded jumping away losing ground when MOSSOMAK began awkwardly shifting out.

MOSSOMAK (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.

QIKCAT (S Collett) – Got its head up when being steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres.

SULTAN OF SWING (S Weatherley) – Could not obtain clear running in the final straight.

KILLARNEY (V Colgan) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 350 metres.

CORTADO (M Coleman) – Had difficulty finding clear running until passing the 200 metres. CORTADO lost the right front plate during the running.

SIERRA BEEL (S McKay) – Blundered badly jumping away.

CHACHAR (C Lammas) – Blundered badly jumping away.

HUNAPO (Z Nor Azman) – Was slow away.

CARNAVALITO (A Sims) – Was slow jumping away losing ground. Raced keenly through the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres.

TRAVEL WISE (D Prastiyu) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied to the inside of GO NICHOLAS (M Coleman) which shifted in passing the 900 metres when steady. Rider M Coleman was advised to exercise greater care.

GO NICHOLAS (M Coleman) – Commenced to over-race when the pace steadied shifting out off heels and improving forward forcing BARBARIC to race four wide near the 700 metres.

BARBARIC (H Marzuki) – Forced to race four wide without cover from near the 700 metres.

CHAMBORD (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously through the middle stages, then had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight improving into a run approaching the 200 metres making brief contact with the hind quarters of HUNAPO which then shifted in slightly, with CHAMBORD then being further crowded by CARNAVALITO (A Sims) which was inclined to shift out under pressure. As a result CHAMBORD was hampered losing ground. Apprentice rider A Sims was issued with a warning taking into account the contribution from HUNAPO.

Race 4	SWISS DELI 2100

QUINTESENTIALLY (D Johnson) – Was crowded on jumping away, losing ground. QUINTESENTIALLY was held up passing the 350 metres.

REALTA (K McCulloch) – Came together with BANBURY LAD jumping away, losing ground. Hampered approaching the 600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of QUINTESENTIALLY which was steadied to avoid the heels of SACRED EMPIRE when that runner was being restrained. REALTA was held up early in the final straight.

RICHIE MCHORSE (C Grylls) – Hampered jumping away and lost ground.

JAYLA MONET (J Nason) – Was slow away.

WOODSMAN (V Gatu) – Was slow away, then raced wide for the majority of the race. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

NELSON PARK (A Collett) – Was crowded passing the 1950 metres to the inside of BLACK LACE (T Wenn). Contributing was slight outward movement from EL FERNANDO. Apprentice rider T Wenn was issued with a warning. NELSON PARK then raced wide for a distance.

LIZZIE L'AMOUR (M Cameron) – Raced wide until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres.

O'CAROL (M Coleman) – Was crowded and hampered approaching the 300 metres to the outside of BLACK LACE which was taken wider by EL FERNANDO which was dictated out by WOODSMAN which lay out despite the efforts of its rider.

HAYLEY GRACE (T Thornton) – Was forced outwards near the 300 metres making contact with RICHIE MCHORSE. HAYLEY GRACE then raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the outside of LIZZIE L'AMOUR which was dictated out slightly by EL FERNANDO with HAYLEY GRACE making contact with RICHIE MCHORSE on a number of occasions and then steadied when crowded.

INCREDITABLE HULK (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground (3L). Was hampered passing the 600 metres by PRINCE MAMBO which commenced to over-race and shifted out to avoid the heels of RISING SHOT.

LIGHT SHADOW (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages. LIGHT SHADOW improved into a marginal run near the 200 metres to the inside of MAGIC OF THE SUN and raced in restricted room for a distance.

MIGHTY ME (G Cooksley) – Raced wide without cover with G Cooksley reporting the gelding had hung inwards throughout. Briefly crowded 150 metres and hampered.

HIFLYER (S Collett) – Was held up early in the final straight, and then raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres between VINEVALE and REINE DE TOUT making contact with that runner and becoming briefly unbalanced. HIFLYER then shifted out passing the 150 metres crowding REINE DE TOUT and MIGHTY ME which were both briefly crowded and hampered losing ground. Inconvenienced as a result was PRIVATE HERO. Rider S Collett was issued with a warning.

<p>BARCELO (S McKay) – Began awkwardly shifting in making contact with O’GUY.</p> <p>O’GUY (K McCulloch) – Crowded on jumping away. O’GUY raced keenly when being challenged for the lead in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>IN POSITION (G Cooksley) – Began awkwardly making contact with TOP PROSPECT. IN POSITION was not persevered with in the final straight with G Cooksley reporting that the gelding had resented the tongue tie which had been an addition to its gear for today’s race, and it was recommended to the connections for it to be removed.</p> <p>TOP PROSPECT (A Collett) – Bumped on jumping away.</p> <p>AVEC MOI (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room to the outside of SECRET STASH (C Grylls) which improved on to the heels of O’GUY and shifted out slightly with AVEC MOI then making brief contact with the hind quarters of SECRET STASH becoming unbalanced and was hampered near the 100 metres. Rider C Grylls was advised that he must exercise greater care in similar circumstances taking into account the movement from O’GUY.</p>

<p>RONCHI (G Cooksley) – Was held up entering the final straight shifting out near the 350 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>STYLISH ATTACK (M Coleman) – Was held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>TROJAN WARRIOR (C Lammas) – When questioned regarding the performance rider C Lammas could offer no tangible excuse with the gelding undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>MATIMBA (S Spratt) – Was examined by the veterinarian and was found to have a minor laceration in a nostril.</p> <p>BLIZZARD (A Collett) – Lost the near front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 8	BENTLEYS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1600
<p>SOUL SISTA (C Lammas) – Was slow away.</p> <p>INFINITE JOY (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SACRED GALAXY (J Nason) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>TEAM PETE (M Vance) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>SCUSA (R Elliot) – Shifted out under pressure final straight.</p> <p>TRIGGER (S Weatherley) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres with SCUSA shifting away from that runner crowding EKAROSA which was steadied. S Weatherley was advised that he must exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>SACRED WIND (V Colgan) – Was steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SCUSA (R Elliot) which lay out under pressure near the 200 metres. Apprentice rider R Elliot was issued with a warning.</p>
