Race 1	CHB MAIL / CENTRAL FM 1400 (1400 metres)		
CLUBS CHOICE (K	McCulloch) - Over-raced from the 1200 to the 1000 metres.		
<b>ALL CHARM</b> (M Singh) – Momentarily hampered near the 300 metres when there was slight inwards movement from NOTIONANNAGINS.			
Race 2	BEN ALLEN TRANSPORT 3YO (1400 metres)		
CHARMING CHOUX (L Hemi) – Slow away. Over-raced in the back straight.			
<b>STELLACANTO</b> (J	Parkes) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.		

**RAVENHILL** (D Hirini) – Lay in in the home straight having to be straightened on a couple of occasions.

**WOTAMISSION** (L Allpress) – Raced in tight quarters approaching the 100 metres.

## Race 3 BAYLEYS MILE (1600 metres)

ABSOLUTELY PEACHES (J Nason) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**SHOW JUDGE** (S Weatherley – Slow away.

**PESO** (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**SUFFIGN** (R Hannam) – Raced in tight quarters passing the 250 metres.

#### Race 4 AEROSPREAD / RAVENSDOWN 1200 (1200 metres)

**BOY SOLDIER** (M McNelis) – Began awkwardly, bumping FLAMINGO, settling back. Held up for several strides approaching the 350 metres. Had to be steadied then angled out across heels approaching the 150 metres.

**PLAY THE FIELD** (C Johnson) – Over-raced approaching the 800 metres. Held up early in the home straight.

**FLAMINGO** (S Weatherley) – Bumped at start when runners either side shifted ground. Over-raced approaching the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly.

MOLIZLAD – Began awkwardly, bumping FLAMINGO. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**DARCI'S DAY** (J Nason) – When questioned the rider could offer no excuses for the geldings performance. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

ITZ MY ONE (L Allpress) - Over-raced approaching the 800 metres.

## Race 5 CHB ANGUS BREEDERS 1200 (1200 metres)

**REDEFINE** (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the back straight and made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

**RIPE** (D Bradley) – Under heavy pressure some distance from home and finished several lengths last. Connections advised that consideration would be given to the racing future of the mare.

#### Race 6 AFFCO NZ LTD 1200 (1200 metres)

**STRUT** (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly bumping GIFTED shortly after the start. Raced keenly when being restrained early in the race.

**GIFTED** (L Allpress) – Bumped shortly after the start.

**MISS DOHERTY** (K McCulloch) – Had to be restrained when in tight quarters passing the 800 metres. Rider D Turner (BASEL DOVE) was reminded to exercise greater care.

ALL IN ABREEZE (H Andrew) – Tightened passing the 800 metres.

## Race 7 BEST TRAVEL WAIPUKURAU CUP (2100 metres)

CAJUN (D Hirini) – Awkwardly away. Over-raced early, clipped a heel and blundered with a circuit to run.

**O'CEIRINS WHISPER** (S Collett) – Settled back, allowed to roll forward four wide around the first bend when the pace eased to lead passing the 1400 metres.

WAIT A SEC (L Allpress) – Held up for the entire home straight going to the line untested.

**DAL SIR TEE** (D Turner) – Held up early in the home straight; had to be angled across heels then raced in tight quarters passing the 200 metres and having to be steadied when tightened approaching the 100 metres.

**ZCASTLE** (H Andrew) – Three wide without cover around the first bend. Lay in under pressure passing the 150 metres, bumping PERFECTLYENCHANTED, which tightened DAL SIR TEE.

**PERFECTLYENCHANTED** (L Hemi) – Held up early in the home straight; gaining clear running passing the 300 metres. Bumped passing the 150 metres.

**TROUP ROAD** (K McCulloch) – Awkwardly away. Held up early in the home straight and was unable to obtain clear running for the length of the straight.

HARE BAWL (D Bradley) – Three wide without cover down the back straight.

#### Race 8 RACE A HORSE WITH TE AKAU – KARAKA MILLION WINNING STABLE (1600 metres)

**HANDFUL** (S Collett) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up momentarily passing the 300 metres having to be angled across heels to obtain clear running.

**POWERADE** (H Tinsley) – Three wide without cover throughout.

MASTER WILLIAM (D Hirini) – Over-raced down the back straight.

THE ORANGE PONY (L Hemi) – Momentarily held up passing the 600 metres.

**KOLEE** (K Cowan) – Raced keenly early.

BATTLE TANK (J Riddell) – Momentarily held up approaching the 600 metres.
