Race 5 DONAGHYS PUREFLUSH 1000

Trainer S Autridge advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of KINGSMAN following its performance in this race, adding that is their intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

Trainer T Pike advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of YWAHOO following its performance in this race. YWAHOO will now be sent for a spell.

Race 7 MAGNUM INDUSTRIES 1150

Trainer A Scott advised Stewards that in the days following its performance in this race BALLYCHINE underwent an endoscopic examination which found the mare to be suffering from a wind issue. BALLYCHINE is to undergo surgery in the coming days.

Levin Racing Club - 25 November 2016

Race 2 LEVIN TAB & SPORTS BAR PREMIER

Trainer J Scott advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of BANG in the days following its performance in this race, adding it was his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 7 LUCIA VALENTINA WELLINGTON STAKES (Group3)

Trainer J Bary advised Stewards that O'REILLY'S CHOICE underwent a veterinary examination including having bloods take on return to his stable which revealed the colt to have a low grade infection. Mr Bary added O'REILLY'S CHOICE has been treated and will be freshen prior to racing next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 SSANGYONG 2200

JIGSAW JANE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly shifting out and crowding CHERRY BAY, TAMA AKARANA and PISTOL PETE. Over-raced through the middle stages when the pace steadied.

CHERRY BAY (O Bosson) – Crowded start. Raced keenly when being steadied passing the 1800 metres. CHERRY BAY raced keenly through the middle stages.

TAMA AKARANA (Z Nor Azman) – Crowded start. Over-raced through the middle stages when the pace steadied. Improved into a marginal run to the inside of RUN FORREST RUN which shifted in slightly passing the 200 metres.

PISTOL PETE (V Gatu) - Crowded start.

SIR HAROLD (A Collett) – Began awkwardly, and then was crowded losing ground.

HERE TO STAY (T Thornton) – Crowded start. Rider T Thornton was given a warning for excessive use of the whip.

RUN FORREST RUN (R Elliot) – Was held up for a distance passing the 350 metres shifting out to obtain clear running.

Race 2 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

STYLE BY DESIGN (A Collett) – Began awkwardly, and then was crowded losing ground. Commenced to hang out near the 800 metres running wide passing the 600 metres placing the rider in difficulty, and continued to hang out for the remainder of the race.

AMAZONE (S Spratt) – Was slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running, and then improved into a marginal run to the inside of STORM BREAKER simultaneously STOLE THE SHOW improved into a run between STORM BREAKER and PEACEFUL FALLS with PEACEFUL FALLS shifting in slightly briefly crowding STOLE THE SHOW with STORM BREAKER laying in and away from that runner crowding AMAZONE which was hampered losing ground near the 300 metres. Riders S Weatherley and C Lammas were advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

IRONSIDE (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

PEACEFUL FALLS (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being steadied.

STOLE THE SHOW (C Lammas) Improved into a marginal run 300 metres.

STORM BREAKER (M Cameron) – Shifted in abruptly 300 metres.

Race 3 NRM 1100

READY TO ROMANCE (M Cameron) – Knuckled leaving the barrier making heavy contact with WHERE THERES SMOKE, and then raced in restricted room. READY TO ROMANCE lay in under pressure in the final straight. When questioned into the filly's performance rider M Cameron advised that from the draw the filly had to work hard early, and then once placed under pressure early in the final straight was unable to quicken. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SWISS MOMENTS (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier, losing ground.

COLORADO BAY (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground, and made the first bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

MAESTRO MAX (O Bosson) – Raced wide in the early stages.

WHERE THERES SMOKE (S Weatherley) – Raced in restricted room to the inside of READY TO ROMANCE (M Cameron) which lay inwards under pressure passing the 300 metres. Rider M Cameron was advised that he must make a greater attempt to straighten his mount than on this occasion.

ST REGIS (R Elliot) – Shifted in abruptly under pressure passing the 300 metres.

SHANGOLD (A Collett) – Was held up for clear running until passing the 150 metres.

Race 4 TAB PUKEKOHE 1200

LAMBRUSCO (K McCulloch) – Trainer S Logan presented LAMBRUSCO to race with leather reins which are not approved, and was issued with a warning. LAMBRUSCO was slow to begin.

FREDDY MAC (O Bosson) – Shifted out leaving the barrier crowding SHADOWS on to CORPORATE RAIDER and MICHIKO which were both hampered losing ground.

SHADOWS (S Spratt) – Crowded start.

CORPORATE RAIDER (G Cooksley) – Hampered start, losing ground.

MICHIKO (L Satherley) – Hampered start, losing ground.

ALAMOSA EXPRESS (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

VOLER POUR MOI (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly, and then raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

SAVE THE STARS (S Weatherley) – Raced wide without cover until passing the 600 metres.

DANGER DEE (D Johnson) – Hung out around the bend until into the final straight. DANGER DEE was crowded passing the 100 metres by PURE SAVALINA which shifted out. DANGER DEE then raced in restricted room to the inside of SAVE THE STARS (S Weatherley) which shifted in under pressure with DANGER DEE being steadied. Rider S Weatherley was issued with a warning.

MARKOVA (T Thornton) – Was held up in the final straight being unable to obtain clear running.

PURE SAVALINA (C Lammas) – Made contact with DANGER DEE when attempting to shift out to obtain clear running 400 metres.

Race 5 MOUNT SHOP 1300

THAILAND (S Collett) – Trainer J Collett presented THAILAND to race without notified gear (pacifiers) with THAILAND racing without pacifiers as suitable gear could not be found. J Collett was fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

SWISSILICIOUS (V Gatu) – Began awkwardly, and then was hampered.

PRAISE DAN (A Jones) – Began awkwardly.

YAMATO NADESHIKO (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

BIG MARNE (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.

THUNDER GIRL (K McCulloch) – Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1200 metres, and then continued to over-race for a distance.

ARUNDEL (O Bosson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

NIGHTSONG (S Weatherley) – Lay inwards throughout.

UP 'N' ROLLING (M Coleman) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres and inconvenienced THUNDER GIRL and YAMATO NADESHIKO which were forced wider on the track. M Coleman was issued with a warning.

Race 6 HAUNUI FARM 1400

KORAKONUI (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly, and then was crowded losing ground.

NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE (S Collett) – Was crowded jumping away. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. Shifted out under pressure in the final straight.

MANUREWA (S Spratt) – Hung out and made the bend passing the 900 metres awkwardly shifting out and forcing VOLEUSE wider on the track. MANUREWA then hung out for the remainder of the bend and raced wide without cover. MANUREWA was hampered near the 350 metres when crowded by PURSUED which shifted out despite the efforts of its rider.

VOLEUSE (B Hutton) – Forced wide 900 metres.

PURSUED (M Hills) - Shifted out abruptly 350 metres despite the efforts of its rider.

SMILING ASSASSIN (E Farr) – Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

MR SELFRIDGE (B R Jones) – When questioned into the improved performance of MR SELFRIDGE co-trainer Mr A Scott advised that the gelding was fresh-up after a spell and had been working well leading into today's race, and they expected a forward showing.

Race 7 FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400

CANTARE (S Collett) - Was slow to begin. CANTARE was held up early in the final straight.

ALI BABA (M Coleman) – Shifted in abruptly leaving the barrier crowding REBEL ROSE and EIGHT TO RULE with REBEL ROSE having to steady.

REBEL ROSE (D Johnson) – Crowded start and steadied. Shifted out passing the 700 metres forcing MARKY MARK wider on the track.

MARKY MARK (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly, and then was steadied. Forced wide 700 metres.

BULLSPUR (M Hills) – Was retired from the race near the 400 metres, and after undergoing a veterinary examination was confirmed to have bled. This is the second occasion BULLSPUR has bled, and as such is ineligible for future racing in New Zealand.

Race 8 LONE STAR PUKEKOHE 1600

EMBEYA (M Cameron) – Was slow to begin.

MADAM WOO (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

HEAD OFFICE (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly crowding DENIAL which lost ground.

DENIAL (T Thornton) Crowded on jumping away losing ground.

MASTER GENIE (E Farr) – Was slow to begin.

MAKFACTOR (M Vance) – Was crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SWITCH IN TIME (K McCulloch) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HAKKASAN (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room passing the 450 metres.

QUEENSTOWN (B R Jones) – Rider B R Jones was reminded of his obligations when weighing in.
