RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 AJC Members 2100

MAGIC CHAI (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Denied clear running until passing the 200 metres having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running inconveniencing HEAD OFFICE.

LUCKY OCTAINE (A Jones) - Raced wide without cover until near the 1400 metres.

TAKEIT TO THELIMIT (C Lammas) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HEAD OFFICE (M Cameron) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.

Race 2 NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race

ANEVAY (C Lammas) – Crowded shortly after jumping away.

INANNA (S Spratt) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres shifting in when marginally clear of IVY'S DREAM which had to be steadied and shift out. Also having to be restrained and shifted outwards when becoming awkwardly placed on heels was FORMIDABLE. Rider S Spratt was issued with a warning.

IVY'S DREAM (T Thornton) – Steadied when crowded 1000 metres.

FORMIDABLE (S Collett) – Steadied 1000 metres.

FASHION SENSE (D Johnson) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres. Lay in passing the 400 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BOSTONIAN. When being corrected shifted out placing THE MITIGATOR in restricted room for a short distance.

THE MITIGATOR (S McKay) – Got its head up when being restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of FASHION SENSE near the 900 metres. Raced in restricted for a short distance 400 meters.

VERSES (B Hutton) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BOSTONIAN.

MONGOLIAN BEAUTY (M Cameron) – Shifted out under pressure over the final 75 metres.

Race 3 New Lynn 1200

OLYMPIC (A Collett) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers to the inside of MY PROPHECY which shifted away from THE KIPLING GIRL (D Prastiyou). As a result OLYMPIC had to steady. D Prastiyou was issued with a warning. Soon after THE KIPLING GIRL continued to shift in crowding MY PROPHECY which had to steady. Passing the 900 metres OLYMPIC became awkwardly placed inside the heels of MORE THAN FAST when the pace steadied with OLYMPIC then making the bend awkwardly shifting out forcing THE KIPLING GIRL wide. OLYMPIC then was obliged to race wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

MY PROPHECY (S Spratt) – Crowded and steadied shortly after jumping away. Crowded when steadied approaching the 1000 metres. Commenced to shift ground under pressure passing the 300 metres making firm contact with THE KIPLING GIRL passing the 100 metres.

SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Got its head up when being steadied passing the 600 metres and then raced ungenerously for a distance.

THE KIPLING GIRL (D Prastiyou) – Shifted in shortly after jumping away. Forced wide 800 metres. Bumped 100 metres.

MORE THAN FAST (O Bosson) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. After undergoing a post race veterinary examination the gelding was found not to be a bleeder.

Race 4 Avondale Races Anzac Day 1400

BIZZWINKLE (C Lammas) – Removed from its barrier after becoming fractious and underwent a veterinary examination which cleared BIZZWINKLE fit to race.

MARJOLET (A Jones) – Began awkwardly crowding PIERIAN SPRING. Had to steady approaching the 100 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of STEVIE'S SURPRISE which was laying out when weakening.

PIERIAN SPRING (B Hutton) – Crowded at start.

GOLDEN VALKYRIE (J Waddell) – Crowded at start. Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres making brief contact with OUR GIRL MADI. Shortly after GOLDEN VALKYRIE again made contact with OUR GIRL MADI with that runner shifting out slightly across the heels of ZANYETTA (M Coleman) which had also shifted in slightly with OUR GIRL MADI being steadied. Riders J Waddell and M Coleman were advised they must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

FOR SAM (M Du Plessis) – Crowded at start losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

YOUVEBEENLITUP (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly and then was hampered.

ZANYETTA (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DORA MAAR (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TWENTYSIXTWELVE (O Bosson) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

OUR GIRL MADI (D Johnson) – Crowded 300 metres when commencing to weaken. When questioned into the disappointing performance of OUR GIRL MADI Rider D Johnson advised that the filly had commenced to weaken passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with over the final 100 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

J Mahoney presented SWISS DREAM without notified gear (blinkers) and was issued with a warning.

Race 5 West Brook Wines 1600

TWINKLES (M McNab) – Slow to begin. Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres placing HIGH CLASS in restricted room for a short distance.

HIGH CLASS (A Collett) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded. Placed in restricted room 400meters

CAMINO ROCOSO (O Bosson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

VOLTS (S Weatherley) – Unable to obtain clear running until passing the 300 metres.

Race 6 IRT 1200

CROOKSHANKS (J Waddell) – Made brief contact with NEESON approaching the 300 metres when shifting out to obtain clear running.

MURIWAI (G Cooksley) – Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages.

ALAMOSA EXPRESS (O Bosson) – Held up until near the 200 metres and when shifting to the outside of LORD ASCOT made brief contact with ANACAPRI which was forced out slightly with CROOKSHANKS then shifting away from that runner into the line of NEESON which then in turn shifted away from CROOKSHANKS crowding STOKED ME which was steadied.

STOCKED ME (T Thornton) Crowded having to be steadied 200 meters.

Race 7 C & K Farrell Contractors Ltd 1600

THE KAIHU KID (Z Nor Azman) – Slow to begin (3L).

QUEEN EL JAY (M Coleman) – Slow to begin.

GATA (M Cameron) – Contacted and unbalanced when leaving the barriers by SAVAPAK which shifted in abruptly.

SAVAPAK (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

TOP ACTRESS (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly and then was hampered losing ground.

WHERE ARE YOU (S Weatherley) – Little slow to begin and then hampered.

MY DAKOTA (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

SMART GARDEN (C Lammas) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when leading.

KEEP UP (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lay in early in the final straight making contact with NARVICK.

NARVICK (A Collett) – Bumped early in the final straight and then inconvenienced shortly after when SAVAPAK shifted out to obtain clear running. Briefly steadied when in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

SAVAPAK (D Johnson) Shifted out to obtain clear running 300 meters.

VINORULES (L Innes) – Lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres inconveniencing NARVICK and had to briefly steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KEEP UP.

GATA (M Cameron) and **RED RAVEN** (M Du Plessis) made brief contact passing the 100 metres when both runners shifted ground.
