#### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	THE FROCKED UP GIRLS 1300			
OUR JOCKO (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.				
<b>BIG MIKE</b> (M Du F	Plessis) – Slow away.			
FALKIRK LASS (D I up as a result.	Prastiyou) – Attempted to improve into a marginal run early in the final straight, and was briefly held			

**QUINTOS** (M Hills) – Over-raced through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider M Hills advised that after racing keenly in the early stages the gelding was unable to quicken as a consequence.

BROOKBARS (A Jones) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

## Race 2 ULTIMATE MOTOR GROUP 1600

MARTINIZ SPECIAL (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

**WEE SONYA** (D Hain) – Shifted out abruptly crossing on to the course proper near the 1400 metres inconveniencing GREENCAST.

GREENCAST (L Innes) – Inconvenienced 1400 metres.

**WILDFLOWER** (O Bosson) – Rider O Bosson advised that the mare had struggled in the ground which he described as shifty.

Race 3NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACEADRIATIC PEARL (D Prastiyou) – Slow away.

**TRIACTION** (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with MAHALO which became briefly unbalanced.

MAHALO (M McNab) – Bumped at the start becoming briefly unbalanced losing ground.

Race 4 TRITON PACIFIC OWENS PLATE 3YO

MILLY MOO (T Thornton) – Raced fiercely when being restrained in the early and middle stages.

**SPINDLE** (K McCulloch) – Held up early in the final straight having to shift in near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

**CHICANE** (S Weatherley) – Made contact with the running rail near the 900 metres, becoming briefly unbalanced.

**FAST AND FURIOUS** (L Innes) – When questioned regarding the performance rider L Innes could offer no tangible excuse, with the colt undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no abnormality. Trainer T Pike advised the colt would now be spelled.

#### Race 5 BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 2100

**COOL TART** (M Coleman) – Slow away.

FOUR DEGREES (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**COTE D'OR** (D Johnson) – Slow away.

**STAR OF GREENBEEL** (K McCulloch) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

## Race 6 DRYMIX CEMENT BAY OF PLENTY CUP

HEART BEAT (M Du Plessis) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**PACORUS** (V Gatu) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start when racing in restricted room to the inside of SEVENTEEN SEVENTY which shifted in slightly, PACORUS then shifted out abruptly when being steadied, making contact with ARROW IN THE SAND which was shifting in with both horses becoming unbalanced. Passing the 1800

metres PACORUS was steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of ENDEAN ROSE (C Lammas) which shifted in when not fully clear, and when steadying PACORUS shifted back on to ARROW IN THE SAND which was hampered. Rider C Lammas was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**ARROW IN THE SAND** (D Prastiyou) – Shifted in shortly after the start making contact and becoming unbalanced. Hampered 1800 metres.

MATIMBA (D Johnson) – Steadied when awkwardly placed 1750 metres.

#### Race 7 THE BOB AND JACK SILSON MEMORIAL

LIGHT SHADOW (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SUFFIRE** (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.

**SELFIE** (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly making contact.

**KEEPING TOM** (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly making contact.

**AL PACINO** (D Johnson) – Became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance passing the 800 metres when racing keenly.

**VINEVALE** (O Bosson) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

ENDEAN EXPRESS (C Lammas) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

Race 8 WINDSOR PARK STUD JAPAN NZ INTERNATIONAL TROPHY

**SCAPOLO** (O Bosson) – Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

**MARKY MARK** (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Approaching the 1500 metres MARKY MARK clipped heels when shifting in and blundered, dislodging rider S Collett who was uninjured.

**OUR KING SWAY** (M Coleman) – Knuckled leaving the barriers.

**IWANNADANCELIKEHIM** (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages and shifting out abruptly approaching the 1400 metres when linking on to the course proper. Rider S Weatherley reported that IWANNADANCELIKEHIM had felt indifferent in its action.

**ROMANTIC MAID** (D Johnson) – Crowded and steadied passing the 1300 metres to the inside of OHOPE PRINCE (D Prastiyou) which shifted in. As a result TROJAN WARRIOR which was racing to the inside of ROMANTIC MAID was placed in restricted room and steadied. Rider **D Prastiyou** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

**TROJAN WARRIOR** (C Lammas) – Crowded 1300 metres and steadied.

**FARM BOY** (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Improved on to heels approaching the 350 metres and was hampered. Crowded and briefly hampered passing the 250 metres to the inside of TROJAN WARRIOR (C Lammas) which had become awkwardly placed when improved to the inside of ROMANTIC MAID which in turn had shifted in and away from the riderless horse.

**MEESKA MOOSKA** (A Jones) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**BEEFEATER** (L Allpress) – Approaching the 300 metres BEEFEATER shifted in to avoid the heels of OHOPE PRINCE and then became awkwardly placed to the outside of ALL ROADS (K McCulloch) which shifted out to obtain clear running. K McCulloch was advised to exercise greater care.

ALL ROADS (K McCulloch) - Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.

## Race 9 J SWAP CONTRACTORS 2100

HEEZNOT (D Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly.

**CONTESSA BELLE** (M McNab) – Contacted start losing ground. Raced ungenerously when making the bend near the 1700 metres.

**EKAROSA** (S Collett) – Passing the 1800 commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied, getting its head up and losing ground. As a result EVA JENSINE which was following was hampered.

EVA JENSINE (K McCulloch) – Hampered 1700 metres. Contacted 100 metres.

**AMPERAGE** (O Bosson) – Raced in restricted room when weakening passing the 350 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider O Bosson could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

HOT IN HIGH HEELS (C Lammas) – Shifted in near the 100 metres making brief contact with EVA JENSINE.

**SLICE OF CAKE** (J Nason) – Apprentice rider **J Nason** admitted a breach in that he used the whip on SLICE OF CAKE in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

HI GORGEOUS (M Du Plessis) – Rider M Du Plessis advised the filly may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 10BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1600SAFFRON LADY (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

**GARDENIER** (O Bosson) – Slow to begin. Rider O Bosson advised that the mare had not handled the shifty track conditions.

VALANTE (S McKay) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**COSTA BRAVO** (D Johnson) – Over-raced through the early stages. Rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had not been entirely happy in today's track conditions.

**I'M ALL EARS** (S Spratt) – Rider S Spratt was reminded of her obligations on whip use on a runner that is out of contention.
