### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DR JACK GRAY PAINTERS 1200
<b>WILLBEOKAY (A Jones)</b> – Began awkwardly then bumped REGAL WINKS shortly after the start which was dictated out onto ABSOLUTELY ME.	
<b>ABSOLUTELY ME (J Riddell)</b> – slow away and bumped. When questioned into the run of ABSOLUTELY ME J Riddell had no tangible explanation for the mare's performance. ABSOLUTELY ME underwent a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.	
<b>REGAL WINKS (J Parkes)</b> – bumped shortly after start then dictated outwards and bumped ABSOLUTELY ME.	
<b>ST REGIS (C Johnson)</b> – raced keenly in front throughout, lay out over the final stages under pressure.	
Track was downgraded to Dead 5 retrospective to race 1.	

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>DAIRY NUTRITION SPECIALISTS 1400M</b>
<p><b>LADIES FIRST (A Chan)</b> – was slow away. When questioned into the run apprentice A Chan had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>NOM DU BEEL (E Farr)</b> – over raced badly early and middle stages. Lost off fore front plate during the running.</p> <p><b>SILVER BUBBLES (A Jones)</b> – raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PLACEMAKERS OPEN HANDICAP 1600M</b>
Nothing to report.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TREE AWARENESS MDN 1600M</b>
<p><b>MARTY O’CEIRIN (J Parkes)</b> – slow to begin. Held up approaching the 400 metres and early in the home straight.</p> <p><b>KOLEE (K Cowan)</b> – slow to begin. Steadied off heels when pace ahead eased passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>POROTENE MHIA (D Turner)</b> – slow to begin.</p> <p><b>WHAT NOW MY LOVE (A Chan)</b> – over raced early and middle stages, raced up on to heels and was abruptly steadied near the 1000 metres and again steadied passing the 800 metres. Had to be briefly checked approaching the 400 metres when racing in tight quarters. Apprentice Chan was shown footage of his ride and advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>SKUFFLE (E Farr)</b> – raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>GRANDLY (L Hemi)</b> – held up passing the 500 metres for a short distance.</p> <p><b>THE MENTALIST (H Andrew)</b> – hung throughout. Trainer K Gray advised that he would have the gelding undergo a veterinary inspection on return to his stable and report findings to the stewards.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>MOLLER JOHNSON ISUZU MDN 1400M</b>
<p><b>SMOKEN HOT (A Chan)</b> –awkwardly away</p> <p><b>BLACK ANASTA (C Johnson)</b> – slow away.</p> <p><b>SUMMERFLY (A Jones)</b> – jumped out abruptly at the start bumping MISS BONDI which jumped inwards.</p> <p><b>MISS BONDI (L Hemi)</b> – bumped at the start</p> <p><b>SILVER LADY (J Riddell)</b> – was late scratched prior to leaving the saddling area by the Veterinary Surgeon when it was reported by staff that the mare may require treatment to a tendon.</p> <p><b>MR DAVINCI (E Farr)</b> – raced fiercely in the back straight and was steadied off heels near the 1000 metres when SARDEEN (K Cowan) shifted in when not the required distance clear. Apprentice jockey K Cowan was advised to exercise more care.</p> <p><b>ITZ MY ONE (H Andrew)</b> – raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>TINY TOT (M Singh)</b> – raced keenly in the middle stages.</p>	

**Race 6****STORAGE & EQUIPMENT HIRE 2100M**

**SAKURA (A Chan)** - raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. Continued to race keenly around the first bend, was sent forward in the back straight to lead. Jockey A Chan admitted a subsequent breach of Rule 638(1)(d) careless riding, in that he steadied his mount SAKURA abruptly on reaching the lead near the 1000 metres resulting in KING OF STING being sharply steadied and having to go back on to ANGEL IN BLUEJEANS which also had to steady. GO TO MAN was unable to avoid the heels of ANGEL IN BLUEJEANS and clipped that runner's heel and blundered. Apprentice Jockey A Chan had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on Thursday 30 March (4 days).

**KING OF STING (C Perrett)** – had to be steadied off heels passing the 850 metres when the pace was steadied abruptly going back on to ANGEL IN BLUEJEANS which went back on to GO TO MAN which clipped a heel and blundered.

**ANGEL IN BLUEJEANS (J Riddell)** – checked off heels approaching the 800 metres and held up approaching the 400 meters having to be angled back to the inside to gain clear running.

**GO TO MAN (C Johnson)** – clipped heels and blundered passing the 800 meters. When attempting a run inside the 100 metres bumped CALL ME IRISH when in restricted room.

**CALL ME IRISH (E Farr)** - bumped passing the final 100 metres.

**Race 7****THE TANK GUY MAIDEN**

**BEAUTIFUL MAN (A Jones)** – slow away.

**DREAM DANCER (D Turner)** – began awkwardly losing ground.

**OUR DAISY (H Andrew)** – raced three wide without cover throughout.

**POROTENE MAGNUM (C Johnson)** – When questioned into the run Jockey Johnson stated the gelding hung throughout.

**AWATANE (H Tinsley)** – raced in tight quarters approaching the 400 metres momentarily held up early in the home straight.
