RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WALLACEVILLE ESTATE PREMIER

LA FILLE EN JEU - Declared a late scratching behind the barriers at 12.04pm on veterinary advice after pulling the right hind shoe on the way to the start causing a puncture wound to the sole at the toe.

ROYAL SUCCESS (M Cameron) – Escaped through the front of the barriers dislodging the rider then taking some time to be recaptured. Once returned to the start, underwent a veterinary examination being cleared to start. Co-trainer Mr J Richards advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding. As a result this race ran approx. 10 minutes late.

ETERNITY (C Johnson) – Underwent a veterinary inspection at the barriers and cleared to start.

CRUISER (H Tinsley) – Raced three-wide throughout.

MR LUIGI (S Spratt) – Checked passing the 1000 when ROYAL SUCCESS ducked inwards abruptly with MAE WEST then also having to be checked to avoid the heels of MR LUIGI. After questioning riders and reviewing films the Stewards were satisfied that the movement from ROYAL SUCCESS had been sudden and beyond the control of its rider who had taken immediate corrective action to relieve the pressure.

MAE WEST (C Grylls) – Checked passing the 1000 metres.

Following the race connections of the 3rd placed MR LUIGI lodged a protest against the winner ROYAL SUCCESS alleging interference near the 1000 metres. After viewing films and hearing evidence the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

Race 2 FASTTRACK INSURANCE CHALMERS TWO MILE PREMIER

The start of this race was delayed 5 minutes due to the delay in race one.

BEAU ZED (N Teeluck) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

JACKSSTAR (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ZEDBEE (R Hannam) - Slow away.

NITRO TED (S Wynne) – Briefly held up passing the 600 metres.

GUARANTOR (T Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight.

Race 3 WOODRIDGE HOMES PREMIER

MORSE CODE - Declared a late scratching at 1.18pm after rider S Wynne was unable to mount the mare to proceed to the start. Trainer Mr T Perry was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare.

KONOHIKI (D Bradley) – Blundered leaving the barriers. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room between CATWOMANDU and IN FLIGHT when making the function onto the course proper near the 500 metres. Held up passing the 400 metres before shifting outwards across the heels of IN FLIGHT to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

CHARLESTOWN (K McCulloch) – Slow away. Held up passing the 400 metres.

Race 4 WELLINGTON SEAMARKET WAKEFIELD CHALLENGE STAKES – GpII

MELODY BELLE (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HASAHALO (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly then over-raced in the early stages. Had to shift outwards across the heels of GIFT OF POWER to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.

GIFT OF POWER (C Grylls) – Had to be steadied shortly after the start when shifting away from BOMBARD. Also inconvenienced as a result, having to be steadied to avoid the heels of GIFT OF POWER, was MOFARA.

Race 5 VALE BILL SKELTON MBE PREMIER

TEQUILA SUNRISE (S Spratt) – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with ANTONIO. Raced three wide without cover early stages.

ANTONIO (J Parkes) – Bumped with TEQUILA SUNRISE at the start and settled back. Raced keenly early. Held up rounding the final turn and continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

Race 6 HIREMASTER PREMIER

ISHINKTAATLEDO (A Chan) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start and lost ground.

STORMY HABIT (N Teeluck) - Slow away.

MISS NORWAY (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly and was slow away.

NEMESIS (D Turner) – Had to be checked when improving onto the heels of ALMO STREET near the 800 metres.

ALMO STREET (M Cameron) – Steadied when crowded for room near the 200 metres between ISHINKTAATLEDO, which shifted inwards, and SHADOW KING which was taken outwards by CONSTANT BARRAGE. Rider M Cameron advised that the gelding had been reluctant to improve into a run leading up to that point and would in his opinion benefit from the addition of blinkers for its next race day start. J Parkes, the rider of CONSTANT BARRAGE, was advised to exercise greater care.

DEVISE (B Hutton) – shied and ducked inwards near the 100 metres.

D Turner (NEMESIS) - was spoken to regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 7 GAVELHOUSE.COM 3YO PREMIER

DANNY WIZZ BANG (S Spratt) - Crowded leaving the barriers. Shifted outwards abruptly to obtain clear running near the 350 forcing PLATINUM DIVA wider on the track. S Spratt was issued with a warning.

BET YA WOOD (T Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly crowding SHARED SECRETS onto JUST YOU. Commenced to hang outwards shortly after the start then raced very ungenerously rounding the bend before running off near the 600 metres severely hampering PLATINUM DIVA, JUST YOU, SHARED SECRETS and FINE TAYLOR. Also inconvenienced were DESANO and REDEFINE being forced wider on the track. LEADING ROLE had to be steadied as a result of this interference also going back onto OUTSTANDING and CHESTER CARLSON. BET YA WOOD was then not persevered with. Trainer Mr A Campbell was advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards before racing again. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

SHARED SECRETS (M Tanaka) – Crowded start. Severely hampered 600 metres.

JUST YOU (J Riddell) – Crowded start. Severely hampered 600 metres.

PLATINUM DIVA (K McCulloch) – Severely hampered 600 metres. Forced wider 350 metres.

FINE TAYLOR (H Tinsley) – Severely hampered 600 metres.

DESANO (S Wynne) – Inconvenienced 600 metres being forced wider.

REDEFINE (C Lammas) - Inconvenienced 600 metres being forced wider.

LEADING ROLE (C Johnson) – Steadied 600 metres.

CHESTER CARLSON (D Johnson) – Slow away. Hampered 600 metres.

OUTSTANDING (J Parkes) – Hampered 600 metres.

EXHIBIT (R Goldsworthy) - Hung outwards around the final bend.

Race 8 HUTT NEWS PREMIER

COPPER REIGN (L Hemi) and **INCANTATION** (J Parkes) were both hampered leaving the barriers when HUNDYAMONTH (A Chan) began awkwardly and shifted outwards.

PIECE OF KATE (D Johnson) – Was not persevered with from the 300 metres when well beaten. When questioned rider D Johnson advised that the mare had not felt to hit out freely throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

ABBY ROAD (B Hutton) - Commenced to over-race and had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of FRANCOME which shifted inwards near the 1000 metres when not fully clear. Apprentice Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

IN ANOTHER LIFE (C Johnson) - raced wide throughout.

Apprentice **N Teeluck** – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount ITSA TRUE STORY to shift inwards over the concluding stages when not sufficiently clear making solid contact with THE BANDITO which was forced inwards onto SAVANNAH GEM passing the winning post. After hearing all evidence and submissions the JCA imposed a period of suspension from the close of racing on Sunday 4 December 2016 up to and including racing on 24 December (5 days).

Race 9 RYDGES WELLINGTON CAPTAIN COOK STAKES – Gp1

VOLKSTOK'N'BARRELL (M Cameron) – Lost its footing and blundered leaving the barriers being slow away as a result.

EL PESCADO (C Lammas) - Raced wide without cover throughout. When C Lammas questioned advised that the gelding would appreciate some easing of the ground.

NASHVILLE (S Wynne) – Hampered leaving the barriers when SLICE OF CLASS shifted inwards. Held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until near the 150 metres.

SAVARIA (C Grylls) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

RINGO (H Tinsley) – Held up passing the 300 metres, shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 100 metres and making contact with SLICE OF CLASS.

SLICE OF CLASS (K McCulloch) – Bumped at the 100 metres.

AIDE MEMOIRE (R Hannam) – Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.

SCAPOLO (L Hemi) – Unable to obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

BEL SORRISO (C Johnson) – Unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres

BATTLE TIME (S Spratt) – Inconvenienced near the 250 metres when weakening to the inside of AIDE MEMOIRE which shifted inwards slightly under pressure. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that after being taken on in front had been unable to finish the race off in the final straight.

Race 10 HANLY FORMULA PREMIER

MR DARCEE'S GOLD – S Spratt replaced C Lammas who was stood down after aggravating an existing injury with C Lammas now requiring a medical clearance prior to riding next.

BELLA'S DELIGHT (D Hirini) – jumped outwards at the start bumping with BEEFEATER. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BEEFEATER (H Tinsley) – Bumped start.

THE BEAMA (R Goldsbury) – Slow away.

TORBA (C Grylls) – Held up when disappointed for a run passing the 400 metres and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.

VEGA (N Teeluck) – Over raced in the early to middle stages.

HIFLYER (D Johnson) – Had to shift out across heels to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres forcing MR DARCEE'S GOLD and GOODSAV wider.
