MARQUATEER (M McNelis) – was awkwardly away

THE OYSTERMAN (H McNeill) – slow away

H McNeill - was issued with a warning for his whip use on a horse which was out of contention

STORMIN NORMAN (S Karnicnik) – raced ungenerously early when being restrained and raced in restricted room over the concluding stages

NOM DU BEEL (C Studd) – very wide into the first turn and was allowed to roll forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1,000 metres

OOEE (A Kuru) – raced three wide without cover throughout

M Cropp – (MR MOR) was issued with a warning for his whip use on a horse which was out of contention

WHEELER FORTUNE (N Quinn) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages and had to check off heels approaching the 1,600 metres

Race 2 LISA LATTA RACING STABLES 2040M

SHOCKTILLYOUDROP (S Weatherley) - crowded at the start by runners either side then raced three-wide without cover throughout

KING OF STING (J Parkes) – Jumped outwards abruptly at the start. Was bumped and forced outwards passing the 350 metres when **GO TO MAN (S McKay)** angled out abruptly to gain clear running. **Rider S McKay** was issued with a warning and advised to use greater care when angling his mount for a run.

HIGH SPIRITS (S Collett) – was slow away then raced keenly approaching the 1,700 metres having to be checked

GO TO MAN (S McKay) – Was slow away. Was angled across heels bumping KING OF STING passing the 350 metres.

ESKIMO KISS (K McCulloch) – raced keenly approaching the 1,700 metres

BATTLE KAT (M Tanaka) – had to be angled off heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

MAGIC WONDER (D Turner) – inconvenienced inside the final 100 metres when ESKIMO KISS ran out under pressure.

Race 3 IG & RJ HACKETT FARRIER AND RACING MDN 1200M

MYSTIGAN (L Allpress) – the rider reported that the mare had held its breath and she had recommended to connections that a tongue tie be applied for its next start and it may be better ridden more quietly early.

HILLBILLY (S McKay) - Had to steady passing the 1,000 metres to avoid heels of MISS CONTESSA which shifted away from MYSTIGAN. **Rider L Allpress** was advised to exercise care when in similar situations.

MISS CONTESSA (J Parkes) and HOW'S THAT GIRL (M McNab) - bumped at the start

EXCEPTIONAL (S Weatherley) - raced greenly under pressure in the home straight

GARMENT (R Hannam) – Was slow away. Raced keenly approaching the 800 metres.

BOY SOLDIER (M McNelis) - ran up on to the heels of **EXCEPTIONAL (S Weatherley)** having to be steadied for a distance when the pace was eased. **Apprentice S Weatherley** was spoken to and advised to exercise care in the manner he steadied the pace.

Race 4 COOKSON RACING 1200M

HUNDYAMONTH (K Cowan) – was cleared by the veterinary surgeons to start after the gelding was kicked behind the barriers

VATICAN NEWS (H Tinsley) - jumped away awkwardly

RINGMASTER (J Parkes) – slow to begin then further hampered when bumped by ARCTURUS

KATIE'S SO KOOL (S Weatherley) - Over-raced in the lead in the early and middle stages, faded from approaching the 600 metres. The rider advised that the mare raced keenly throughout and had nothing left.

THATZ LOUIE (N Teeluck) - lay in under pressure in the home straight

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1340M

SHRIMP COCKTAIL (R Goldsbury) – began awkwardly

LA BELLA ROSA (L Hemi) – raced wide without cover throughout

VOLEUSE (K McCulloch) – was briefly steadied passing the 1,100 metres when ROYAL SAV was dictated inwards by **YODELAY (J Riddell).** J Riddell was advised to exercise care.

PRINCESS RAAJ (R Elliot) - Hung rounding the turn from the 600 metres. Ran outwards approaching the 200 metres.

SOPHIA MAGIA (M McNab) - Approaching the 200 metres had to be steadied to avoid heels of **PRINCESS RAAJ (R Elliot)** which shifted outwards when not fully clear. **R Elliot** was issued with a warning.

DARSCAPE PRINCESS (J Parkes) – Stopped quickly from inside the 600 metres and hung in the home straight. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the filly to be lame in the right fore. A veterinary clearance is required prior to starting next.

Race 6 TINA EGAN RACING MDN 3YO 1340M

DIAMOND BELT (H Andrew) - bumped at the start

POURALITA (M McNab) - bumped at the start, raced ungenerously when being restrained early in the race

THAT'S AMORE (M Tanaka) – began awkwardly

OPHELIA LEE (J Parkes) – slow away and raced ungenerously when being restrained early in the race

SAINT CROIX (J Riddell) – Had to check off heels when TINY TOT lay in and CHOUX MANIA ran out approaching the 250 metres. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

TINY TOT (L Singh) – sat three wide without cover throughout and lay in under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions

CHOUX MANIA (R Goldsbury) - Ran out under pressure in the home straight and bumped approaching the 100 metres when **STRADA ROCCIA (D Hirini)** ran out. Rider D Hirini was issued with a warning.

DIAMOND BELT (H Andrew) - lay in under pressure in the home straight

STRADA ROCCIA (D Hirini) - ran out approaching the 100 metres bumping CHOUX MANIA

Race 7 MAKARAKA STABLES MDN 1340M

DA JIN SHAN (L Allpress) – Slow away. Rider L Allpress reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

TOBY'S CHOICE (H Andrew) – Raced keenly when being restrained early. Commenced to hang out approaching the 600 metres running wide on to the track in to the home straight. Continued to lay out under pressure in the home straight.

WHOSHOTMYMATE (S McKay) – was slow away

Race 8 RIVER CITY CABS MDN 1600M

THE IMP (E Farr) – was slow away

OFF WITH HER HEAD (S McKay) - was slow away

SUMMERFLY (L Hemi) – raced ungenerously passing the 1,200 metres ducking in checking ZEDAC approaching the 1,000 metres. The rider did not persevere over the final stages advising that the filly felt indifferent in her action. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

AMNESTYS CHILD (S Weatherley) –had to be steadied when weakening in restricted room to the inside of OUR BANDIT which was taken in slightly by **GRINNER (J Riddell)** near the 600 metres. **J Riddell** was advised to exercise care.

MOCCA (S Collett) – started to hang out from the 600 metres. The rider advised the filly may not have appreciated the tongue tie.
