<b>MARKY MARK</b> – Co trainer K Murdoch advised that MARKY MARK had suffered no ill effects after dislodging his rider early in the race and they would now be re assessing his current campaign.	
<b>IWANNADANCELIKEHIM</b> – Trainer S Logan reported that IWANNADANCELIKEHIM had pulled up showing lameness in the hind quarters, and has now been spelled.	
<b>Race 9 - J SWAP CONTRACTORS 2100</b>	
<b>AMPERAGE</b> – Co Trainer S Autridge advised that AMPERAGE had recovered well since returning to the stable and further advised the gelding would be tried as a jumper in the near future.	
<b>HI GORGEOUS</b> – Co trainer P Williams advised that the filly has now been spelled.	

## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BURTON CONSTRUCTION 3YO</b>
<b>PRINCE HAREEM</b> (D Johnson) – Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race for a distance and hung out when being steadied from near the 1200 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MILLS REEF WINERY 1400</b>
<b>DON'T LOOK BACK</b> (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance, Rider C Grylls advised DON'T LOOK BACK had never travelled comfortably throughout. A post-raced veterinary examination found the mare to have a slower than normal recovery and slight lameness in the left foreleg.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>POMARE ELECTRICAL 1230</b>
<b>SHESALLRAAJ</b> (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>NZ FIRST 1230</b>
<p><b>J Jago</b> – Fined \$100.00 under the minor infringement schedule for failing to make the contracted weight for BUBBLEBUBBLE POP. J Jago was replaced by J Waddell</p> <p><b>COLOUR PLUS</b> (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>ST REGIS</b> (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>SAVE THE STARS</b> (S Weatherley) – Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 300 metres having to shift in to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>SALTED CARAMEL</b> (J Nason) – Apprentice rider <b>J Nason</b> was spoken to by Stewards regarding the manner in which he used the whip.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1400</b>
<p><b>RINGLOCK</b> (R Elliot) – Got its head up when being steadied of the heels of IMA WEKA (T Thornton) which shifted out passing the 1100 metres. T Thornton was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p><b>IMA WEKA</b>-shifted out passing the 1100 meters.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA 1400</b>
<p><b>SWEET MOLLY</b> (J Nason) – Late scratched on veterinary advice at 3.11pm after showing signs of lameness when arriving at the barrier.</p> <p><b>BLACKJACKMAN</b> (A Collett) – Began awkwardly, shifting in and crowding EMMUSKA. Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>EMMUSKA</b> (S Weatherley) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.</p> <p><b>ENCHANTING BEAUTY</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly. D Johnson advised the mare had not been entirely happy in the existing track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>JAKKALBERRY 1950</b>
<p><b>GERONIMO</b> (L Satherly)-slow away.</p> <p><b>BIG MEADSY</b>(V Gatu)-slow away then had to be steadied shortly after when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p><b>ALL ABOUT DOOM</b>(S Weatherly)-got its head when being steadied then raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages</p>	

**THE OTHER HALF** (A Jones)-steadied when in restricted room passing the 350meters when OUTSIDER shifted out slightly.

**OUTSIDER** (J Waddell)-shifted out to obtain clear running 350 meters.
