RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Stella Artois 1500
	<p>AVANT (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Got its head up when being steadied off heels passing the 1200 metres when the pace eased.</p> <p>DIRECT CAPITAL (D Hain) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>BARABAS (L Innes) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages and then was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.</p>

COAT OF HONOR (E Farr) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres and when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MONRECOUR which steadied, shifting out forcing BOJANGLES across the heels of BARABAS approaching the 700 metres.

BOJANGLES (D Prastiyou) – Forced across heels having to be briefly steadied near the 700 metres.

NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE (A Collett) – Returned to the enclosure with a laceration above the fetlock on the off fore leg which required veterinary attention. The filly lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 2 | **Ellerslie Jewellers & Engravers 1300**

AQUAMOSA (R Norvall) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1100 metres on a moderate pace and continued to until near the 700 metres. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

CHIQUITITA (B Hutton) – Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages when the pace steadied.

VALETINA VITTORIA (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early stages on a moderate pace.

MISS FOXY GAL (M Coleman) – Hung outwards for the majority of the race making the 400 metre bend awkwardly.

O'MARINA (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Riders L Innes & A Collett were shown a video and reminded of their obligations when steadying the pace through the early stages.

Race 3 | **Barfoot & Thompson 1600**

SACRED SHOT (J Nason) – Jumped away awkwardly with its rider becoming unbalanced.

RICHIE MCHORSE (L Innes) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

SWINGING SKIRTS (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

CAPRIKOSA (S Weatherley) – Lay out around the final bend. Inconvenienced 200 metres.

THATSFORSURE (M Coleman) – Held up early in the final straight having to shift out across the heels of TAVIDREAM to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

TAVIDREAM (A Collett) – Lay in under pressure inconveniencing CAPRIKOSA passing the 200 metres.

Race 4 | **Celebrating Start Wondering 1200**

BOLD BACHELOR (T Wenn) – Slow to begin.

ULTIMATE IMAGE (J Nason) – Clipped a heel of HONOUR PRINCESS (S Weatherley) and blundered when HONOUR PRINCESS shifted in when not clear near the 1000 metres. Rider S Weatherley admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 8 April 2017 up to and including racing on 17 April 2017, 5 riding days.

BREEZON (S Spratt) – Got its head up passing the 1000 metres when racing ungenerously and continued to for a distance. Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

MAJIC RULER (D Prastiyou) – Had to be firmly restrained and shift out briefly when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of LORD ASCOT near the 800 metres.

TERRIFIQUE (S McKay) – Lay in passing the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BOLD BACHELOR.

MASABIO (R Norvall) – Lay out under pressure near the 250 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HONOUR PRINCESS.

Race 5 | **Te Akau's Gingernuts, Trans-Tasman Group 1 Winner 1200**

MR KNOWITALL (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

NATUZZI (D Prastiyou) – Jumped away awkwardly.

IRISH MOON (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with FULLY FUNDED and then was further hampered when SEVENTH UP shifted out losing ground as a result.

Race 6 | **Celebrating Chenille 1500**

ZAFRENZY (L Innes) – Slow to begin.

GO NICHOLAS (R Elliot) – Got its head up passing the 1200 metres having to steady when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SULTAN OF SWING.

SIERRA BEEL (J Nason) – When being steadied near the 1100 metres made the bend awkwardly when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of ZAMBEZI WARRIOR.

CLOVELLY PARK (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ZAMBEZI WARRIOR (J Fawcett) – Shifted inwards under pressure in the final straight having to be briefly steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of PRINCE MAMBO passing the 100 metres.

GRAVANO (D Prastiyou) – When questioned into the performance of GRAVANO Rider D Prastiyou advised that he felt that the holding track conditions and the allocated weight the gelding had to carry may have contributed to its performance.

Race 7 | **Auckland Co-op Taxis 2200**

MAGIC CHAI (L Innes) – Slow to begin.

WOODEN RED (A Collett) – Slow to begin.

MODEL AYE (M Coleman) – Got its head up and shifted out when making the bend awkwardly near the 1800 metres.

SHERIDAN (J Nason) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.
