Race 1	MCCLURGS MANUFACTURING JEWELLERS 2000 (2000 metres)
STORMY HABIT (L Hemi) – Slow away.	
HERSCHAL (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly; raced erratically when being restrained passing the 1800 metres.	
SORRELL (S Weatherley) – Had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres. Shifted wide on the point of the home turn forcing LADY FERNER over a little extra ground.	

LADY FERNER (M McNab) – Taken over extra ground on the turn.	
Race 2	PROPERTY BROKERS 2000 (2000 metres)
<p>MIO KIWI (R Hannam) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Bumped early in home straight.</p> <p>D Turner (ZCASTLE) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after he angled his mount inwards near the 1700 metres when not clear of DAL LAUREON, which had to be steadied.</p> <p>DAL LAUREON (S Collett) – Steadied 1700 metres.</p> <p>HIGH SPIRITS (C Lammas) – Held up early in the home straight and when seeking a run bumped MIO KIWI outwards inconveniencing QUEENSLAND. C Lammas was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>QUEENSLAND (D Johnson) – Inconvenienced early in the home straight.</p> <p>CUZZIE CHARLIE (S McKay) – Bumped ZED LEPPELIN when angled out approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>ZED LEPPELIN (J Parkes) – Over-raced early; bumped passing the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 3	BAY FORD / BAY MAZDA HB 3YO (1400 metres)
<p>NO DOUBT A STAR (C Grylls) –Attempted to buck for some distance shortly after the start so was not persevered with. Co-Trainer Mr T Cruz was advised that NO DOUBT A STAR is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to next racing.</p> <p>PINCANTO (S Weatherley) – Briefly tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>THE COSSACK (D Turner) – Raced keenly passing the 1000 metres. Momentarily hampered when in restricted room near the 150 metres.</p> <p>ITZ MY ONE (H Tinsley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 4	ANIMAL HEALTH DIRECT 1200 (1200 metres)
<p>MAGIC CHAI (A Jones) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SIAN (S Weatherley) – Slow away.</p> <p>FEISTY JANE (C Grylls) - Jumped away awkwardly after being fractious in the barriers.</p> <p>JESSICOVA (H Marzuki) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>FIBONACCI (J Riddell) -Checked at the 300 metres when disappointed for a run between DRAGON KINGDOM and FEISTY JANE, making contact with the hind quarters of DRAGON KINGDOM and blundering.</p> <p>DRAGON KINGDOM (D Turner) - Raced ungenerously when wide without cover throughout and received contact to hind quarters near the 300 metres.</p>	
Race 5	DUNSTAN FEEDS RISING STARS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER (1200 metres)
<p>VANILLA MOON (C Grylls) – Knuckled over at the start, settling back.</p> <p>EIGHT POINTS (D Johnson) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres, going back on to MAXSSISTAR which had to be angled outwards off that runners heels; continued to over-race through the middle</p>	

stages. When questioned regarding the mare's performance the rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the mare racing fiercely in the early to middle stages. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality other than superficial abrasions above the right eye where it may have struck its head leaving the barrier.

MAXSSISTAR (L Hemi) - Steadied passing the 1000 metres and after being angled out was then obliged to race three wide for the remainder

ON THE HILL (S McKay) – Steadied off heels near the 800 metres. Held up near the 200 metres prior to being angled out to improve.

SPLURGE (M McNab) - Had to be steadied when the pace ahead eased passing the 900 metres.

CHIC (J Parkes) – Awkwardly away.

DAL AMORE (M Tanaka) – Slow away.

IN ANOTHER LIFE (H Tinsley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Rider H Tinsley advised the gelding over-raced throughout after the re-application of blinkers and had little left at the finish.

SAM'S READY – bled from both nostrils so is subject to the mandatory three month stand-down with a veterinary clearance then required prior to trialing or racing.

Race 7	AMP SOLUTIONS 1300 (1300 metres)

PROFICIENT (C Lammas) - Jumped inwards at the start bumping TRINOVANTES. Over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

TRINOVANTES (J Riddell) – Bumped at the start.

EVA GODIVA (D Johnson) – Momentarily held up entering the home straight.

DONARDO (H Tinsley) – Three wide without cover throughout.

Race 8	MITRE 10 – GOING THE EXTRA MILE (1600 metres)

RED RAVEN (R Elliot) – Slow away,

FASTNET FIRE (M McNab) – SILVER HIHO shifted outwards shortly after leaving the barriers causing crowding to MIZ OLDFIELDS ROAD, MORAL CODE, HURRICANE LUCY and HILLBILLY, with MORAL CODE and HILLBILLY being checked. Further exacerbating this crowding was inward movement from FASTNET FIRE. Taking into account the contribution of the outward movement from SILVER HIHO, M McNab the rider of FASTNET FIRE was issued with a warning.

MORAL CODE (C Grylls) – Checked when crowded shortly after the start.

HILLBILLY (S McKay) - Checked when crowded shortly after the start.

MIZ OLDFIELDS ROAD (J Bassett) – Crowded shortly after the start.

HURRICANE LUCY (L Hemi) – Crowded shortly after the start.

PENANCE (M Tanaka) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight when inclined to lay in.
